

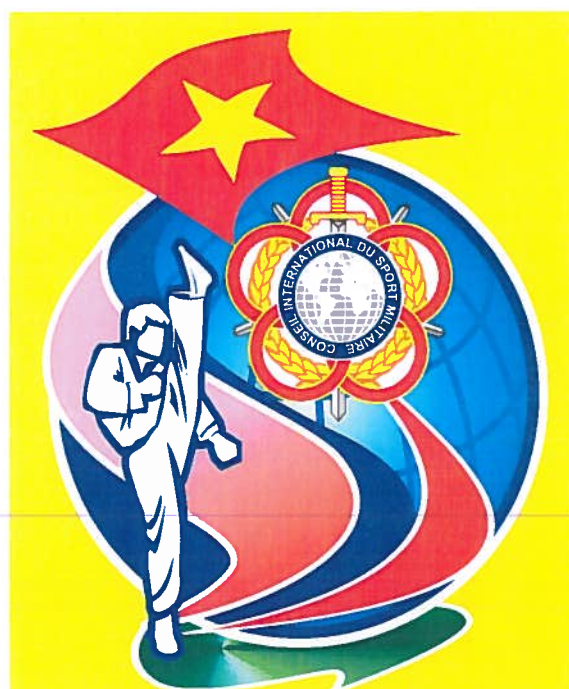

THE 21ST CISM WORLD MILITARY TAEKWONDO CHAMPIONSHIP IN 2012

1. Eligibility: The athletes of the invited countries must be active servicemen in the military. All of the participants are asked to present the following documents:

For the athlete: a military identification card, a passport and Kukkiwon/WMTF Dan Certificate)

The referee: a passport and a certificate from WTF/WMTF

Coaches and other members: passports

2. Competition Content:

a) Sparring content

- There will be two Poomsae Divisions: WTF and Open
- WTF Poomsae Competition will consist only of WTF/Kukkiwon approved Poomsae
- Uniform for WTF Poomsae is the WTF Regulation Poomsae Uniform
- Scoring for WTF Poomsae will be done in accordance with WTF Poomsae International Poomsae Scoring guidelines using Computer Scoring
- 1 Gold, 1 Silver, and 1 Bronze Medal will be awarded in the Men and Women WTF Poomsae Divisions
- Medals awarded **will not count** in determining the overall standing of the CISM Taekwondo Championships Team Winners
- Open Poomsae Division may consist of Creative Poomsae, ITF Poomsae, Musical Poomsae, Poomsae with or without Weapons

- There will be a 2-minute Time Limit for Poomsae in the Open Division
- Uniform for Open Division Poomsae is Optional
- Scoring for Open Division Poomsae will be done by Scorecards from 5.0 – 9.9
- 1 Gold, 1 Silver, and 1 Bronze Medal will be awarded in the Men and Women Open Poomsae Divisions
- Medals awarded **will not count** in determining the overall standing of the CISM Taekwondo Championships Team Winners

c) Military Hosinsul (Self-Defense) Demonstration Event

Notes:

- There will be a maximum of 6 participants per Team Delegation in the Military Hosinsul Demonstration Event
- There will be a 3-minute Time Limit in this event
- Uniform: the Battle Dress Uniform (BDU) of each participating team; may include face paint, etc.
- Military Hosinsul should simulate defense against armed or unarmed opponents using military battle techniques
- Hosinsul Teams may consist of mixed gender or a single gender
- Participation Medals will be awarded to each participating team in this event. There will be no determination of winners in this division. All participants will be recognized.

3. Competition Rules: Applying the regulations of WTF, rules and regulations of CISM that will be all discussed and agreed in the Preliminary Meeting.

The chest protectors used in the competition will be electronic ones (DAEDO)

4. Awards:

The Organising Board will award gold, silver and bronze medals for the winners in each weight class, in accordance with CISM Taekwondo Regulations

5. Accommodation, food and drink for athletes:

Vietnam People's Army will provide accommodation in accordance with the Regulations of the 21st CISM World Military Taekwondo Championship.

The Organising Board provides the meals in three areas; each dining hall meets the standard and is able to serve the number of participants in the area.

Formality: Buffet. The ration and quality are suitable for the athletes with diet food if requested in advance.

- The Organising Board provides free soft drink during meals. For other drinks at bars or mini bars, the users pay by themselves.

*** Note:**

- The participant is responsible to pay for extra services.
- The missions arrive in Vietnam before 19th October 2012 and leave the country after 26th October 2012 will have to pay for extra expenses. The average payment amount is about USD 150 per person per day and this expense must be paid on arrival in Vietnam.

6. Doping test

Doping tests will be done in accordance with the WTF and CISM anti-doping regulations.

Number of doping tests is in accordance with the CISM Taekwondo regulation.

The tests will be done by the process updated by WADA.

7. Medical Services and Insurance:

a. Medical Services:

Providing fully medical services and medicine during the championship. Medical centres will be available at the living places to be ready to deal with minor health issues. First aids are available at living and training places. The Organising Board will provide medical services fully for every participant. More serious cases will be sent to hospital with available equipment.

Vietnam People's Army will be responsible for paying for expenses in emergency and necessary situations at medical centres and hospitals. Other expenses such as

staying longer in hospitals for treatment or dental services etc. in non-emergency situation will be paid by the missions themselves.

b. Insurance:

The Organising Board is not responsible for any losses, injuries or damages during the Championship.

Participating countries must be responsible for travel and competition insurance for their participants as they are not the responsibility of the Organising Board.

8. Security

The Organising Board will take all responsibilities for security issues relating to the officials, the athletes and the missions as a whole during the Championship.

9. Military uniform:

Summer uniforms are required to use in all main activities of the Championship: Opening and closing ceremonies, press conferences and other activities regulated by the Organising Board.

10. Travel to Ho Chi Minh City and transportation

The missions should travel to Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam by planes.

There are direct flights to Ho Chi Minh City. However, they can also fly to Hanoi, Vietnam and get the connecting flights to Ho Chi Minh City.

All expenses for air traveling to and from Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam will be paid by the missions themselves.

The Organising Board provides transportation means for the missions during their stay in Ho Chi Minh City for the Championship.

Besides the transportation means provided for each mission, there are also public transportation means to connect the living places with the competition places.

Transportation means for officials and VIP guests will also be planned and provided accordingly.

11. Visa application

The missions can contact Vietnamese embassies in their countries to apply for visas. The embassies will give priority for visas for military sports mission. If there is not a Vietnamese embassy in their country, the missions can contact the Organising Board to ask for visa on arrival in Vietnam.

The citizens of countries that have visa exemption agreements with Vietnam can enter Vietnam by their official or diplomat passports without visa (staying in Vietnam less than 30 days).

All of the participants have to conform to all legal procedures when entering into Vietnam. If not, they will be refused to enter into the country. They should also have their passports with them during participating in the activities of the Championship in Vietnam.

12. Advertisement

Advertisement is allowed during competition events and activities required wearing uniform. However, advertisements that relate to politics, alcohol, cigarette, etc. are banned.

13. Banned activities

According to the law of the Socialist Republic of Vietnam, any activities that relate to politics and religion, namely disseminating documents, magazines, books, propaganda efforts etc., during the Championship are banned. Any relating activities can lead to the ban from the Championship of the whole mission and the mission has to leave Vietnam as soon as possible.

14. Press and Communication Support

The missions have the right to report information relating to the 21st CISM World Military Taekwondo Championship.

The Organising Board will provide necessary facility for the media reporting about the 21st CISM World Military Taekwondo Championship (TV, Internet, media room, news and photo services...)

15. Sightseeing and traveling

Ho Chi Minh City and some of its adjacent provinces have diverse and historical culture. The sightseeing programs will be informed to the missions for their choices.

16. Weather:

Average temperature: 27^oC

Highest temperature: 33^oC

Lowest temperature: 22^oC

17. Essential things

The mission is required to bring one CD with record of the national anthem, two national flags (size: 90 cm x 152 cm) and hand them to the Organising Board on their arrival.

FINAL ENTRY - COMMITMENT BY THE CHIEF OF MISSION

NATION :

The undersigned, Chief of Mission declare that he has read the Article 3.28. of the CISM Policy Manual and moreover understood the following prescriptions:

A. Chief of Mission

1. Chiefs of Mission shall be familiar with CISM regulations.
2. Missions must not only participate or be present at sports events, they are also required to participate in information conferences on CISM, study days, commemorative and cultural events and ceremonies organized by the host nation.

B. Conduct of a mission

1. The Chief of Mission is responsible for the behavior of his team in sports and general discipline. He shall ensure that members of his mission respect the rules and directives prescribed by CISM and organizers of the championship. The respect of schedules is particularly important as they form the basis for the effective conduct of competitions and ceremonies. Instances of indiscipline or poor sportsmanship will be handled by Championship officials and may result in the disqualification of individual athletes or teams.
2. The Chief of Mission shall also enforce the rules concerning behavior and dress during the ceremonies. He plays an important role in promoting the CISM spirit among his mission, a spirit represented by friendly attitude towards other missions, courtesy towards organizers and fair-play in competition. The mission, who does not wear military uniforms during the opening ceremony of a Championship, will not be authorised to take part in the Championship. The Official CISM Representative will communicate this decision.
3. In conformity with the Statutes and traditions of CISM, any political or religious action during a CISM event, in particular the dissemination of propaganda documents, pictures, brochures, reviews, etc, is strictly forbidden. Any contravention shall result in the exclusion of the mission from further competition.
