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<b>Condition for participation</b>	<p>Proof of membership by valid National Federation Passport with ETU/WTF membership. <b>Athletes must show their WTF-license at the registration desk.</b></p> <p>All competitors have to prove their age and nationality by presenting their passport or identification card at the weigh-in.</p> <p>Those who are not recognized as adults by law in their own country must submit a passport or identification card together with a written consent (liability declaration) at registration signed by parents or lawful guardians, accepting the participation and all parts of the official invitation.</p>

### 4. COMPETITION RULES

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<b>Competition Rules</b>	WTF competition rules
<b>Practical info</b>	<p>10 competition areas, all with electronic scoring system.          Single elimination tournament system.</p>
<b>Equipment</b>	<p><b>Cadets, Juniors and Seniors: DAEDO</b> protector scoring systems.          Head gear, groin/forearm/shin guards and gloves are compulsory and must be brought by the contestant. <b>Mouth piece is compulsory!</b></p>

All athletes must use their own Daedo socks. There will be the possibility to buy Daedo materials at the competition.

- Protest** Only the official coach is allowed to protest, immediately after the end of the contest. An amount of **€ 100 (Euro)** will have to be paid for each protest.  
**The decision of the referee chairman is final.**
- Video Replay** Video replay will be used for seniors.
- Doping Control** Some contestants chosen at random will be tested.  
The list of prohibited products will be equal to the list of the IOC.

- Entry Fee** **€ 50 (Euro) for each contestant if paid by bank**  
Entry fees must be paid by bank before the deadline of 18 March 2013!

The costs of the bank transfer (non-Euro zone) will be charged.  
There will be no refund if a registered competitor fails to show up for the competition!

NOTE: Registrations are only valid when payments have been received and can be confirmed by the Bank and the Organizer.

**€ 60 (Euro) for each contestant if paid in cash at the registration**

- Modifications** For all modifications that are to be made after the deadline, an administration fee of **€ 20,-** will be charged. This must be paid in cash at the registration.
- Coach** For every 5 contestants within the same team, one coach is granted free admission, with a maximum of 3 coaches.  
Only competitors and coaches have admittance to the competition areas.  
Coaching is only allowed in sports wear (no dobok!). All coaches must be 18 years or older!
- All coaches need to register on [www.tpss.nl](http://www.tpss.nl) and are obliged to upload a photograph. An amount of € 5 (Euro) has to be paid when this is not done or if a photograph of another person was uploaded. In case you didn't upload a photo you can take a photo at the registration desk but it will cost 5 euro.

## 6. INTERNATIONAL REFEREES KYORUGI

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Invitations for International Kyorugi Referees will be made by the Referee Directors. An official invitation will be sent to all the national federations.

Hotel and Full board accommodation will be provided for international referees from 5 until 7 April 2013.

## 7. ACCOMMODATION AND TRANSPORT

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Hotels in Gent are quickly fully booked in this period because this competition is situated in the middle of two weeks holiday (Easter) for children in Belgium! Moreover, Gent is a major sought-after tourist destination and offers a lot of cultural, business and sport possibilities.

We learned from the past that it is necessary to offer cheap hotel accommodation. Therefore, the organization is holding an allocation of rooms in Gent from 5 until 7 April 2013 at very reasonable prices! (National) Teams are encouraged to book their required number of rooms early through the organization of the Flemish Taekwondo Union vzw to guarantee cheap prices and enough hotel rooms.

Note that there is no weigh-in in the morning of the competition day, only in the evening prior to the competition. This means the weigh-in for the competitions on Saturday is on Friday evening, the weigh-in for the competitions on Sunday is on Saturday evening.

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<b>First Aid</b>	Will be provided by the organization and is only to be used in case of an emergency.
<b>Insurance</b>	The organization and supervisor assume no responsibility for teams, any damages, violence, losses and injuries during the stay in Belgium. All contestants must bring their own documents and forms for any medical treatment in Belgium. If not, this must be paid in cash.
<b>Press</b>	Filming and photographing is not allowed on the competition area, unless for press members. Recording from the public stands is only allowed for handy cam-type cameras. If you want to bring a photographer or a journalist, please mention it by email.
