- 5. QUALIFICATIONS:**
- CRITERION #1:** Holder of the nationality of the participating team
- CRITERION #2:** An athlete must be nominated by the pertinent national taekwondo association that is recognised by the World Taekwondo.
- CRITERION #3:** Holder of the Kukkiwon Poom or Dan Certificate
(* A copy of the Dan certificate should be enclosed when registering for accreditation. In case a contestant has applied for a Kukkiwon Dan certificate but has not received it yet, a copy of the Dan application form and the remittance certificate sent to the Kukkiwon must be enclosed when registering for accreditation. Please refer to the Kukkiwon Web site (www.kukkiwon.or.kr) for more information.)
- CRITERION #4:** **An athlete must be 17 years old or older.** An athlete who was born in the year of 2003 or before is eligible to participation in the Championships.
- CRITERION #5:** Holder of valid WT Global Athlete License (GAL). * Any questions on the WT GAL please contact your assigned WT GMS Manager

6. COMPETITION RULES

WT Competition Rules as of May 15, 2019 shall be applied.

7. METHOD OF COMPETITION

- i. Single elimination system
- ii. Grade: Not graded.
- iii. Seeding and drawing of lots: **For every weight category, regardless of number of athletes at a minimum of 25% of the athletes will be seeded based on WT Olympic Ranking of February 2020. (Feb 1st).**

8. CONTEST TIME

2 minutes x 3 rounds with 1 minute break

9. WEIGHT DIVISIONS

10. CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATING TEAMS

- i. Round-trip Airfare and Accommodation
Round trip airfare shall be borne by the participating National Association.
Accommodation charges of room and board for all others shall bone by the participating National Association.

11. QUALIFICATION SYSTEM

- i. Any NOC who qualifies a minimum of two (2) male and two (2) female players via the Olympic ranking system will be deemed to have qualified its total quota of places and shall not be permitted to enter the continental qualification events. However, if a nation has not qualified a minimum of two (2) places in male and two (2) places in female via the Olympic Ranking position they shall be allowed to compete for the additional places via the continental qualification events.
- ii. The first two (2) ranked athletes in the weight categories will qualify their NOCs a place each for Olympic games. Total sixteen (16) athletes will qualify their NOCs a place each for Olympic games through African Qualification Tournament.
- iii. The two (2) finalists will qualify their NOCs regardless of the result of the final match. The 3rd place will be determined by the result of final matches.
- iv. If an NOC qualified through the African Qualification Tournament relinquishes a quota place or has not confirmed the use of the qualified place(s) within two (2) weeks from the moment receiving the allocation letter from the WT, it will be reallocated to the NOC of the next highest ranked athlete in the same weight category at the African Continental Qualification Tournament, as long as the NOC does not exceed the quota of two (2) male and two (2) female.
- v. In the event that any of the qualified contestants was found to have committed a doping offence that constitutes a violation of any of the provisions of the Anti-Doping Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency and/or other appropriate anti-doping codes ("Anti-Doping Codes"), next highest ranked athlete in the same weight category at the African Continental Qualification Tournament will qualify his/her NOC a place.

- vi. The NOC of an athlete who has committed an anti-doping rules violation will lose the quota place obtained by the athlete. The maximum number of quota places for that the corresponding number of athletes who committed an offence shall reduce NOC.

12. WT GLOBAL LICENCE & ONLINE REGISTRATION

i. WT Global License Registration

All Athletes and Team officials must FIRST be registered with a WT Global Athlete License (GAL) or Global Official License (GOL).

ii. WT Online Registration

National Team Entry will only be accepted through the WT online registration system and registration is only possible with a valid WT Global License. National Team GMS admins have to register their teams.

13. ENTRY FEES

The OC shall collect the entry fees from the participating national teams. The national team shall pay an entry fee to the Organizing Committee by cash in US\$ only at the Registration Center accreditation center(s) in Rabat, Morocco prior to the start of the Championships. Athletes shall not be allowed to compete without successful payment of entry fee to the Organizing Committee.

- **REGULAR ENTRY FEES:** The national teams completing their registration during this period will be charged the regular registration fee.
- **US \$100 per athlete.**
- Regular entry fee period will begin on **15th December 2019**, 17:00 Local Swiss Time.
- Regular entry fee period will end on **10th January 2020**, 17:00 Local Swiss Time.
- After the Deadline ends (10th of January 2020) entry fees will be counted as **US \$200 per athlete**

14. ENTRY DEADLINES & IMPORTANT DATES

- i. Entry deadline for Registration Period is **January 10th, 2020** 17:00 Local Swiss Time. Entry submission after this date will be not accepted.
- ii. Late replacement due to injury shall be handled case by case.

15. CLASSIFICATION OF RESULTS

Medals will be awarded to the top four athletes in the respective weight category of the pertinent championships:

1st PLACE:	GOLD MEDAL & CERTIFICATE
2nd PLACE:	SILVER MEDAL & CERTIFICATE
3rd PLACE:	BRONZE MEDAL & CERTIFICATE
3rd PLACE:	BRONZE MEDAL & CERTIFICATE

17. INTERNATIONAL REFEREES

The WT will appoint the International Referees. The appointed international referees shall officiate at the African Olympic qualification; the following conditions shall apply:

- i. International Referees are required to pay for their own round-trip airfares.
- ii. The Organizing Committee shall pay for the expenses for four (4) nights' stay of room and board.
Check-in: February 20 / Check-out: February 24
- iii. The Organizing Committee shall pay a per diem of US\$100 to the selected International Referees for competition period (total 2 days; US\$200 per referee).

18. TECHNICAL DELEGATE AND COMPETITION SUPERVISORY BOARD

The WT will appoint one (1) Technical Delegate and up to two (2) four (4) members of the Competition Supervisory Board. Two (2) other members of the Competition Supervisory Board will be appointed by the Continental Union. The following conditions shall apply:

- i. The Organizing Committee shall pay for the expenses up to four (4) nights of room and board.
Check-in from: February 20 / Check-out: February 24
- ii. The Organizing Committee shall pay a per diem of US\$100 to the Technical Delegate and the members of the Competition Supervisory Board for competition period (total 2 days; US\$200 per person).

19. WT-RECOGNIZED TAEKWONDO UNIFORM (DOBOK) AND PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

- i. **Daedo Protector and Scoring System (PSS) including PSS Headgear** will be used for the Championships.
- ii. Participating contestants are required to wear WT-recognized doboks and WT-recognized protective Equipment. The latest version of WT-recognized manufacturers' list is available at the website of WT
<http://www.worldtaekwondofederation.net/recognized>.
- iii. The Organizing Committee will provide Protector and Scoring System (PSS) to the participating contestants. Participating contestants are required to bring their own groin guards, mouthpieces, gloves, **sensing socks** and shin and forearm guards for their personal use.
- iv. Before entering the field of play, all contestants will proceed to the inspection desk for inspection of their doboks and protective equipment. Any contestant who wears unofficial doboks or protective equipment will not be permitted to compete. Organizing Committee shall prepare white masking tapes to cover up any kind of identification of the manufacturers not recognized by the WT.
- v. Instant Video Replay (IVR) System will be used.
- vi. Wireless communication system between referee and review jury will be used

20. IDENTIFICATION OF NOC CODE AND MANUFACTURER

- i. National flag shall be located between 3cm and 3.4cm below the right shoulder line of upper garment.
- ii. NOC Code is a three-letter National Olympic Committee abbreviation, and it shall be printed at the back in black and centred at 5cm or higher from the bottom line of the upper garment within the size of 30cm width x 12cm height. The font of the letters shall be in bold "Verdana".
- iii. Manufacturer's identification (name, designation trademark, logo or any distinctive sign of the manufacturer) shall be located one per garment within 20 cm² except at the location of the WT logo.

21. MEDICAL CONTROL

- i. The WT Anti-Doping Rules, and where necessary the Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, shall apply throughout the competitions.
 - ii. Compulsory anti-doping tests will be carried out on random selection basis. The WT and/or WADA may carry out random out-of-competition testing prior to the competition. Therefore, all
 - iii. participating contestants are required to submit their latest and most accurate Athlete Location (Whereabouts Info) Forms to the WT.
 - iv. TUE (Therapeutic Use Exemption)
 - v. Athletes who take any substance or medicine listed in the “Prohibited List” of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and Anti-Doping Code of World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) for therapeutic purposes are requested to visit the website of World Taekwondo to download TUE application form at <http://www.worldtaekwondo.org/wp-content/uploads/2019/08/3.-ITA-TUE-Form.pdf> and report & consult with the WT anti-doping coordinator Mr. Marco Ienna at antidoping@worldtaekwondo.org *by no later than November 8th, 2019 in addition please*. 22. HEAD OF TEAM MEETING & DRAWING OF LOTS SESSION

- i. The head of team meeting and the drawing of lots session shall be conducted one (1) day prior to the start of the championships that is February 21, 2020, in the presence of the WT officials and the representatives of the participating nations. **The seeding may be changed after the each day's weigh-in.**
- ii. The method and order of the draw may be changed depending on the decision of the Technical Delegate.
- iii. Depending on the decision of the Technical Delegate, WT officials or Organizing Committee volunteers could be designated to draw lots on behalf of the officials of the participating nations who are not present at the time of the lot drawing session.

23. WEIGH-IN

- i. Weigh-in of the contestants shall take place on the day before their respective weight category.
- ii. During the weigh-in, male contestants shall wear underpants and female contestants shall wear underpants and brassieres. However, contestants may weigh-in in the nude if they wish to do so.

24. INDEMNITIES

- i. The respective national taekwondo associations shall be responsible for ensuring that all officials and participants are covered with effective travel & medical insurance coverage.
- ii. Participants without proper insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete at the championships.
- iii. The Organizing Committee will acquire general Public Liability event insurance.

25. ACCOMMODATION

The participating teams are required to submit the hotel reservation to Organizing Committee by **no later than January 11th, 2020.**

Ground transportation

Ground transportation will be provided for national teams on arrival and departure free of charge, only for teams who book via the official event agent and provided that the Organizing Committee has been informed of the date, time, and flight number of the national team's arrival and departure at the latest by **the designated deadline**.

26. VISA INFORMATION

The Organizing Committee can provide recommendation letters for visa applications. However, MNA's are required to check Morocco entry visa application waiting times in their own countries and submit requests for recommendation letters to the organizing committee. The Organising Committee cannot guarantee entry into Morocco and can only offer assistance. It is the responsibility of each athlete and MNA to apply for and secure the correct entry visa for Morocco.

27. LATE ATHLETE REPLACEMENT

Athletes cannot be replaced after confirmation of the member national association. In the event that a confirmed athlete cannot compete due to injury occurred between January 10th and January 31st, 2020, the pertinent MNA shall Submit the late replacement form together with medical certificate written by medical doctor in English to the WT at sport@Worldtaekwondo.org no later than February 1st, 2020. The request may be accepted by the WT/WTAF upon review of the request provided.

28. COACH'S ATTIRE

All Coaches are required to wear formal suit such as tie, jacket, dress shirt (long or short), and trouser during Semi-Finals and Finals.

29. TEAM DOCTOR'S MEETING

In order to receive accreditation card, all registered team doctors or physicians must attend team doctor's meeting.
