3.3 Age : Age categories according to WTFcategories

3.4 Graduation : All competitors must hold at least 2nd Geup.

3.5 Weight Classes : WTF-classes.

4. RULES

4.1 Competition Rules: WTF-Competition Rules.

4.2 Mode : Single elimination tournament system.

Elimimation rounds and finals: 3 x 2 minutes, (30 sec. break)

There will be 8 competition areas, all with electronic score board system.

4.3 Doping Control: Some contestants chosen at random will be tested.

The list of prohibited products will be equal to the list of the IOC.

4.4 Awards : To all winners of 1st, 2nd and 3rd places cups will be awarded.

4.5 Hall Rules : Only the competitors and their coaches have admittance by the

registration cards to the contest areas.

One (1) coach for every five (5) competitors has free admission with a maximum of four (4) coaches per team. The minimum age for a coach must

be 18 years.

Only in sportswear.

4.6 Equipment : WTF-recognized head gear and groin, forearm shin protectors and trunk

protector (hoogoo) will be brought by the contestants, which is

compulsory.

4.7 Protest : Only the official coach is allowed to protest to the LSC, immediately

after the end of the contest. An amount of € 40,- will have to be paid

for each protest.

4.8 Liability : All competitors are considered to participate at their own risk.
