WTF-recognized Taekwondo Uniform (dobok) and Protective Equipment:	 Participating contestants shall wear WTF-recognized taekwondo uniforms (dobok) and WTF-recognized protective equipment, including the head protectors, trunk protectors, shin and forearm guards, gloves (hand protectors) and groin guards. The Organizing Committee will provide head protectors and trunk protectors for the participating contestants, while contestants are required to bring their
	own groin guard, gloves (hand protectors) and shin and forearm guards for their personal use.3) All contestants are required to proceed to the inspection desk for officials to check their doboks and protective equipment before entering the competition area. Any contestant wearing unofficial doboks or protective equipment will not be permitted to compete.
	4) The list of companies for the WTF-recognized dobok and protective equipment is enclosed herein for purchase in advance.
15. Medical Control:	1) The WTF is in strict compliance with the Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, and will apply the appropriate sanctions against athletes who are found to have committed doping offences.
	2) Use of drugs or any other doping offences by chemical substances is strictly prohibited, as prescribed in the WTF Regulation for Doping Control.
	3) The WTF will carry out medical doping test among the participating athletes at random sampling and any athlete who refuses to undergo testing or who proves to have committed a breach of this regulation shall be removed from the final standings, and shall be subject to a disciplinary action.
	4) For the therapeutic use of a prohibited substance on the WADA List of Prohibited Substances and Prohibited Methods, concerned national associations are required to send the WTF application form of therapeutic use attached herewith to the WTF Secretariat by no later than April 15, 2007.
