

Any contravention shall result in the exclusion of the mission from further competition.
- **4.** The Chief of Mission is reminded that athletes and other team members must comply with CISM Regulations. Instances of indiscipline or poor sportsmanship will be handled by Championship officials and may result in the disqualification of individual athletes or teams.
