All of our Pocheon citizens including me will do our best to host it successfully. We promise giving all prospective spectators as well as players unforgettable memories in their lives.

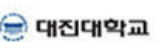
We expect your support to make the event become open competition which combine us into one mind for **Taekwondo** fans and wonderful stage for players that they can follow their dreams and talents.

## ■ CHAMPIONSHIP OUTLINE

The 2012 Pocheon World University Taekwondo Championship ("the Competition") held between May 25 and May 30, 2012 in Pocheon, Korea is hosted by the Pocheon World University Taekwondo Championship Organizing Committee and under the sponsorship of FISU. The rules will follow the 2012 World Taekwondo Federation (WTF) regulations.

### ▣ Qualifications

- An association with member of FISU
- In the case of non-affiliation to FISU:
  - A university sports organization whose country is affiliated to the appropriate an International Sports Federation (FSI)

## ■ Qualifications for Competitors

### ○ Common Requirements

- a) be a national of the country they represent
- b) be at least 17 and less than 28 years of age on January 1st in 2012  
(The competitors must be born between January 1st, 1984 and December 31st, 1994.)

### ○ Optional Requirements [One of the following c), d) or e) should be met.]

- c) Students who are currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at a university or similar institute whose status is recognized by the appropriate national academic authority of their country;
- d) Former students of the institutions mentioned in c) who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the year preceding the event;
- e) In countries with fewer than 2,000,000 inhabitants or fewer than 5,000 university students, students attending technical or secondary schools may participate in FISU championships provided they have been attending their establishments for at least two (2) years. [as an exception to the foregoing c) and d)]

## ■ Application Procedures

Entries must be submitted to the Organizing Committee in accordance with the following procedure and the FISU Regulations.

### ○ Entries

Entry forms must be completed in capital letters (typed or handwritten) in one of the working languages of FISU (English or French) and be submitted according to the procedure laid down by the Organizing Committee and must be received under the following procedure.

- a) General entries (engagement of participation) at least six (6) months before the beginning of the championship. (November 25, 2011)
- b) Quantitative entries (confirmation of participation) with the number of officials and participants in each sports event, and with the payment of the deposit of 25% of the participation fees, at least three (3) months before the beginning of the championship. (February 25, 2012)
- c) Nominative entries (conditions for participation) with the list of and the necessary photographs, one (1) month before the beginning of the championship. (April 25, 2012)

### ○ Entry Procedures

- a) The general and nominative entries may be sent by any electronic ways of communication or telefax in order to meet the required entry deadlines, but they must be confirmed as soon as possible in writing, on the official forms.
- b) Entries arriving after the expiration of the required deadlines will not be taken into consideration, except in the case of circumstances outside one's control, with the agreement of the Executive Committee of FISU and on the advice of the Organizing Committee.
- c) Individual entry forms of athletes from a non-member association must be countersigned by the concerning National Sports Federation (FSN) or by the National Olympic Committee (NOC), and stamped with a seal from the said organization.

### ○ Individual dossier to submit on arrival in Korea

Upon arrival in Korea, competitors must submit the following documents to the International Control Committee (CIC) of FISU:

- a) Passport or another ID, with the following stated:
  - Full name (in capitals)
  - Nationality, date and place of birth
  - A recent photograph
- b) If a student
  - A document proving that s/he has satisfied the conditions normally required in his/her country for entrance to a university or similar institute.
  - A FISU Eligibility Form stamped and signed by National University Sports Federation (NUSF) and university or similar institute or student card or certificate from the appropriate national academic authority certifying that the competitor is currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at a university or similar institute whose status is recognized by the appropriate national academic authority of their country.
- c) If a former student
  - Proof of the date s/he obtained his/her final academic degree or diploma.
- d) If a pupil
  - A certification of study signed, be hand, by the responsible official of the establishment certifying the date of entry into that establishment and that the competitor has been regularly attending that establishment for at least two (2) years.

## Financial conditions

### Travel Costs

The countries shall be responsible for their own cost of travel to the Incheon International Airport near Seoul and return.

### FISU Registration Fees

Participants shall pay the following amount in FISU registration fees to CISCA. CISCA will then issue their ID as participating competitors and officials

- a) Effective member associations of FISU: twenty Euros (20€) per competitor and official
- b) Other associations: forty Euros (40€) per competitor and official

### Participation Fees (sixty Euros (60€) per person per day)

- a) Participants should confirm their participation by paying a sum equal to 25% of the total participating fees to the Organizing Committee by February 25, 2012.
- b) The sum stated in the foregoing a) may be spent for penalties, if any.
- c) Upon arrival in Korea, participants should pay the balance of the participation fees, (i.e. forty five Euros (45€) per person per day to the Organizing Committee).

## Rules: The Competitions will be organized in accordance with the 2012 World Taekwondo Federation (WTF) regulations.

## Participation Rules

1. Each country is authorized to enter Kyorugi competition with a maximum of sixteen (16) competitors (eight (8) men and eight (8) women) and five (5) officials.
2. Each country may enter for Kyorugi competition in each weight category.
3. Each country is authorized to enter Poomsae competition with a maximum of ten (10) competitors (five (5) men and five (5) women) and four (4) officials.
4. Each athlete may compete in both Kyorugi and Poomsae.
5. At the first General Technical Meeting, the Head of Delegation or his/her representative shall confirm and sign the official list of the accredited competitors by the CISCA.

## International Judges

- The countries participating in the Kyorugi competition must bring at their own cost with their delegation the following international judges:
  - of entering five (5) or more competitors: one (1) international WTF Kyorugi referee
- The countries participating in the Poomsae competition must bring at their own cost with their delegation the following international judges:
  - of entering five (5) or more competitors: one (1) international WTF Poomsae referee
- These countries must provide the Organizing Committee, three (3) months before the championship with the names of two (2) international referees (1 effective + 1 non-travelling substitute).
