  - 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners in the Korean and Non-Korean parts will compete in the Champion's Match.

- 4) Seeding (Senior )
  - a. Medalists from Olympic Games and World Championships will have priority seeding.
  - b. Competitors from the same national association will be seeded on the opposite side of the bracket in the next priority of the (a) case above.
    - ♣ No priority seeding in Senior (Club)
- 5) Competition Rules and Officiating
  - a. The Competition Rules of the WTF will be applied.

#### 3) Competition Format

- Korean and non-Korean parts will proceed separately.
- 1<sup>st</sup> , 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners in the Korean and Non-Korean parts will compete in the Champion's Match

#### 3. Competition Rules and Officiating

- a. The Competition Rules of the WTF will be applied.
- b. The Technical delegate from the WTF will oversee the implementation of the rules and regulations.

#### 4. Awarding

- a. 1st place: Gold medal and certificate
- b. 2<sup>nd</sup> place: Silver medal and certificate
- c. 3<sup>rd</sup> place(2): Bronze medal and certificate
- d. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd(2) in each champion's match: Trophy and certificate

# ♦ Poomsae

#### 1. Method of competitions

- a) Two (2) Poomsae from designated Compulsory Poomsae decided for each division must be performed for all the preliminary, semi-final and final rounds. Compulsory Poomsae to be assigned for each division shall be decided at the time of drawing of lots by Technical Delegate in consultation with the KTA officials.
- b) All divisions are divided into Korea and Non-Korean parts and will proceed separately.
- c) Contestants may compete in more than one category of competitions unless limited by gender or age.
- d) Cut-off system
  - 1) Preliminaries
    - In case 20 or more contestants/pairs/teams are participating, the competition shall start from the preliminary round with division of groups at different courts. After performing two (2) assigned Compulsory Poomsae, the top half of each Group shall advance to the semi-final based on the points.

#### 2) Semi-final

- In case nine (9) to 19 contestants/pairs/teams are participating, the competition shall start from the semi-final. Contestants shall perform two (2) assigned Compulsory Poomsae and top eight (8) of them shall advance to the final based on the points.

#### 3) Final

- When eight (8) or less contestant/pairs/teams are participating, competition shall start from the final round. Contestants shall perform two assigned Compulsory Poomsae and top four(4) contestants/pairs/teams shall be awarded based on the points. Bronze medals shall be given to the 3<sup>rd</sup> and the 4<sup>th</sup> place.

#### 4) Champion's Match

Those who finish first and second place in Korean and Non-Korean parts
 will compete in the Champion's Match (Single elimination system)

- 1) Use of drugs or any other doping offences by chemical substances is strictly prohibited, as prescribed in the WTF Regulation for Doping Control.
- 2) The OC will carry out random medical doping tests among the participating athletes. Any athlete who refuses to undergo the tests or who is proven to have committed a breach of this regulation, shall be removed from the final standings, and shall be subject to disciplinary actions.
