3. CONTESTANTS

Membership



Participants must be member of a National Taekwondo Federation, affiliated to the W.T.F. This membership must be proved by the (GAL) Global Athlete Membership identification from the W.T.F. for **ALL** athletes.

NB: WTF GAL application can **ONLY** be made through the WTF member National Association (MNA) and WTF GAL's will only be approved and cards shipped to the WTF MNA once all required information, documents and payment has being made.

ONSITE registration for **WTF GAL** is **NOT POSSIBLE** and registration must be done **IN ADVANCE**. A Global Athlete Licence check will be done at onsite registration before any individual is allowed to compete. Any questions on the WTF GAL should be directed to your respective WTF Member National Association.

Categories Cadets male and female

Juniors male and female Seniors male and female

Age categories according to ETU/WTF-categories

Cadets: born in 2000, 2001 and 2002 Juniors: born in 1997, 1998 and 1999 Seniors: born in 1997 and older

Athletes born in 1999 may compete as cadet or as junior (not in both). Juniors born in 1997 may compete as a junior or senior (not in both).

All competitors have to prove their age and nationality by presenting

their passport or identification card at the weigh-in.

Those who are not recognized as adults by law in their own country must submit a passport or identification card together with a written consent (liability declaration) at registration signed by parents or lawful guardians, accepting the participation and all parts of the official

invitation.

Graduation Cadets must hold at least 4th Geup (blue belt).

Juniors and Seniors must hold at least 2nd Geup (red belt).

Liability All competitors participate at their own risk. The organizers or the

VTB shall not accept responsibility for any damages, injuries or

losses sustained or incurred.

4. COMPETITION RULES

Competition Rules WTF competition rules

Practical info 10 competition areas, all with electronic scoring system.

Single elimination tournament system.

Equipment Cadets, Juniors and Seniors: DAEDO protector scoring systems.

Head gear, groin/forearm/shin guards and gloves are compulsory and must be brought by the contestant. Mouth piece is compulsory! All athletes must use their own Daedo socks. There will be the

possibility to buy Daedo materials at the competition.

Protest Only the official coach is allowed to protest, immediately after the end

of the contest. An amount of € 150 will have to be paid for each

protest. The decision of the referee chairman is final.

Video Replay Video replay will be used for seniors.

Doping Control Some contestants chosen at random will be tested.

The list of prohibited products will be equal to the list of the IOC.

The costs of the bank transfer (non-Euro zone) will be charged. There will be no refund if a registered competitor fails to show up

for the competition!

NOTE: Registrations are only valid when payments have been received and can be confirmed by the Bank and the Organizer.

Modifications For all modifications that are to be made after the deadline, an

administration fee of € 25 will be charged. This must be paid in cash

at the registration.

Coach For every 5 contestants within the same team, one coach is granted

free admission, with a maximum of 3 coaches.

An extra coach costs € 25.

Only competitors and coaches have admittance to the competition

areas. Coaching is only allowed in sports wear (no dobok!). All

coaches must be 18 years or older!

All coaches need to register on www.tpss.nl and are obliged to upload a photograph. An amount of € 5 has to be paid when this is not done or if a photograph of another person was uploaded. In case you didn't upload a photo you can take a photo at the registration desk but it will

cost 5 euro.

Spectators Up to 7 years old: admission is free


10 years and older: € 10 (2 days)

6. ACCOMMODATION

Hotels are quickly fully booked in this period because this competition is situated in the holiday period (Easter) in Belgium! The organization is holding an allocation of cottages in "Center Parcs De Vossemeren" from April 4th until 7th 2014 at very reasonable prices! Teams are encouraged to book their required number of cottages early through the organization of the Flemish Taekwondo Union vzw to guarantee cheap prices and enough cottages.

unless for press members.

Recording from the public stands is only allowed for handy

cam-type cameras.
