Qualification Coaches

Dress Code Coaches

During all the competition all coaches are obliged to wear a formal suit. Coaches that do not follow the dress code cannot be entered into the field of play during finals and semifinals.

At the PanAm Open Tournament DAEDO is being used as PSS. The Organizing Committee will provide DAEDO trunk protector. Each athlete has to bring his own DAEDO sensor socks and headgear.

Official Uniform and Equipment

All contestants are required to use white taekwondo uniform (dobok) with "V" neck. Patches, embroidery, logos, team names, countries, athletes' names and strikes are allowed. No tape is allowed in part of the uniform.

All athletes must use recognized protection equipment, as well as recognized headgears (Hong in red and Chung in blue), oral protector, groin guard, forearm shin and in-step protectors by the time of entering the competition area.

Groin guard, forearm and shin protections must be inside of the Taekwondo uniform.

It is prohibited any extra object on the head additional to the headgear. Any religious article must be prior approved and must be used under the headgear, inside the dobok and must not cause any type of obstruction or lack of visibility for the opponent.



Indemnities

It is the responsibility of each Member National Association to ensure that their athletes and team officials have filled out the indemnification forms correctly and have duly signed them, thereby indemnifying WTF, PATU, the Organizing Committee and all other officials and athletes from any claims of injuries, losses or otherwise arising in the course of participation at the Pan-American Open or any activities linked therewith.

It is the responsibility of each Member National Association to ensure and guarantee that sufficient insurance coverage has been arranged for all athletes, team officials and other participants. Without sufficient insurance coverage, national teams will not be allowed to compete.

Please fill out the Personal Indemnity Forms and return them to the Organization Committee before June 9th, 2016. Each participant (athletes, team officials, etc.) has to fill out the indemnification form.

International Referees

The WTF will appoint total thirty (30) International Referees from outside the PATU territory. The following conditions shall apply:

- International Referees are required to pay for their own round-trip airfares to Queretaro, México.
- The Organizing Committee shall pay for the expenses for five (5) nights' stay of room and board.
- Check-in: June 8th / Check-out: June 13th
- The Organizing Committee shall pay a per diem of US\$100 to the selected International Referees for competition period (total 3 days; US\$300 per referee).



Local Transportation

Organizing Committee will not provide local transportation for the participating teams, each team is responsible of their own accurate transportation. Organizing Committee will only provide this service to Referees, VIPs, and PATU Officials.

Head of Team Meeting

The Head of Team meeting shall be conducted by PATU officials on Wednesday June 9th, 2016 at 18:00 hrs. Exact location shall be communicated forthwith.

Draw of lots

All athletes will be seeded according to the WTF Olympic Ranking as per June 01, 2016. The draw sheets and brackets will be available one (1) day before the start of the competition of the respective weight category.

Weigh-in

The weigh-in of the athletes takes place one (1) day prior to the start of the respective weight category they compete in. During the weigh-in, the male athlete shall wear underpants and the female athlete shall wear underpants and brassiere. However, the athlete may weigh in nude if he/she wishes to do so.

Each athlete shall have one (1) attempt to pass the weigh in. However, one (1) extra attempt is allowed for those athletes who did not qualify the first time. This extra attempt shall be done within the time limit of the official weigh-in.

Medical Services

Visa

Organizing Committee will only provide medical services for emergencies during competition if any injury is suffered.

- Contestants are responsible for further injury and hospitalization expenses.
- Organizing Committee recommends to all contestants to have an updated medical insurance and have all the information available at any time.

The Committee Organizing can provide recommendation letters for visa applications. However, MNA's are required to check the Mexican entry visa application waiting times in their own countries and submit requests for recommendation letters (ri@mextkd.org) to the Organizing Committee if necessary. The Organizing Committee cannot guarantee entry into Mexico and can only offer assistance. It is the responsibility of each athlete and MNA to apply for and secure the correct entry visa for Mexico.
