DATE: 17 – 18th September 2016

3.CONTESTANTS

CATEGORIES: Seniors Male and Female,
Juniors Male and Female,
Cadets Male and Female.

AGE: Cadets born in 2004, 2003 and 2002
Juniors born in 2001, 2000, 1999
Seniors born in 1999 and older
An athlete who was born in 1999 can compete as a junior or as a senior. Competing in both categories is not allowed.

GRADUATION: All senior and junior competitors must hold at least 2nd Geup, cadets must hold at least 4th Geup

WEIGHT DIVISIONS: WTF-classes.

QUALIFICATIONS: Participants must be members of a National Taekwondo Federation, affiliated with the WTF. An approved 2016 WTF Global License (WTF Global Athlete License OR Global

Official License) is required of all athletes and officials who wish to register for the 23rd Polish Open - 19th Warsaw Cup Taekwondo Championships. WTF Global License registrations & renewals can only be made through the WTF recognized Member National Associations and application should be made at least 2 months before the Tournament starts to ensure the WTF license can be processed and approved on time. There will be NO WTF Global License registration onsite. Entry fees are obligated at all times.

4. RULES

COMPETITION RULES:

WTF Competition rules with Electronic Body Protector, E-Head Gear, Instant Video Replay, 2 quotas until and including semi-final 1 bonus quota will be given in final when all quotas have been used.

SEEDING:

Seeding of Senior Athletes will be based on the Sep 2016 Rankings (including events until end of August 2016).

MODE:

Single elimination tournament system. Seniors: elimination rounds and finals: 3 x 2 minutes (30 sec break). Juniors and Cadets: elimination rounds and finals: 3 x 1,5 minutes (30 sec break). The organization committee and WTF Technical Delegate can decide to adjust the competition.

DOPING CONTROL:

Some contestants chosen at random will be tested.

AWARDS:

1st, 2nd and two 3rd places will be awarded.

HALL RULES:

Only the competitors and their coaches will have admittance with valid accreditations to the contest areas.

EQUIPMENT:

WTF-recognized PSS + E-helmet shall be provided for all competition areas and all weight divisions (cadet, junior and senior). Only WTF-recognized Equipment groin-, forearm-, shin-, mouthpiece and gloves should be brought by the contestants, it is compulsory. Sensor socks will not be provided by the organization team and must be purchased by each competitor.

PROTEST:

Only the official coach is allowed to protest to the LSC, immediately after the end of the contest. An amount of €100,- will have to be paid for each protest. The protest fee will not be refunded in any case.

LIABILITY:

All competitors are considered to participate at their own risk. Polish Taekwondo Federation and the organizer assume no responsibility for any damages, injuries or losses, and specifically note that they also take no responsibility for any damages, losses, injuries or other consequences due to (directly or indirectly) acts of terrorism or terrorist threats. All contestants must bring their own documents and forms for any medical treatment in Poland. If not, this will have to be paid in cash. By registering, Club takes responsibility for application form in accordance with real data and with the consent of legal guardians (underage players), and accepts the competition rules.

IDENTIFICATION:

According to Polish law all competitors and visitors need to have a valid ID meaning a valid passport or other official identification document

5. ENTRY

REGISTRATION:

Registration is only accepted through the WTF Event Registration system <https://www.hangastar.com/WTF/> and registration is only possible with a valid 2016 WTF Global License.

The following documents are required for all participants to be uploaded and approved by the National Federation and WTF before you are able to register your team through the WTF Event Registration System.

For ALL participants (athletes and officials):

- 1. Valid National ID or Passport of the National Federations you are registering for a WTF Global License.
- 2. WTF Signed Event Liability Waiver (page 3 only) – valid for 5 years.
- 3. Colour Portrait ID picture.
- 4. To register a Doctor – Proof of Medical Doctor/Physio therapist certificate in English

DEADLINE:

31st of August at 11:59 p.m. Warsaw time, or after reaching 350 competitors (senior categories) and 700 (juniors and cadets categories).

ACCREDITATIONS:

Extra coach passes can be requested including WTF GMS number separately for €25,00 euro for each individual coach. Please note that only 1 competitor and 1 coach can enter the competition area. National teams are allowed to have following accreditations: 2 Officials, 1 official doctor (not second coach), 1 coach. Club teams can only register coach accreditations. All other accreditations are not allowed. One (1) coach for every five (5) competitors has free admission with a maximum of six (6) coaches per team. The minimum age for a coach must be 18 years.

MODIFICATIONS:

Modifications are possible at the registration for an amount of €25,00 for each modification (only weight changes), after the official weigh-in no further modifications will be made. This means no changes will be made in weight divisions!

IMPORTANT:

If the athlete registered on-line does not take part in the competition, and he/she has not been replaced by another participant before the date 31st of August his/her team or official must fully (100%) pay his/her entry fee for participation. Entry fee is not refundable at any time after the deadline!

VISA:

If you need a Visa for Poland, You can send official request for assistance with filled in visa application form (available on website www.warsawcup.com) to: warsawcup@wp.pl. It is advised to arrange the VISA on time. Deadline for Visa assistance is July, 31st.

ENTRY FEE & PAYMENT:

€ 75,00 (Euro) for each contestant.

Application is only valid when payment has been done at the same time of Registrations through our bank account. Applications are only valid when payments of all entry fees have been received within 5 days. If payment is not received within 5 day the application will be removed from the online registration. Entries done 5 days before the deadline must be paid immediately. All fees must be paid in EUROS and please ensure you pay any additional currency charges.
