2) VENUE : Halla Gymnasium

3) COMPETITIONS (Men's & Women's)

① Senior : born before Dec 31, 2001 (17years old or above) / 8 weight divisions

* For Korean : The participating entities are allowed to prepare only 1 contestant out of their athletes for each division (The Man's & Women's respectively). However, 1 more athlete is allowed to participate in pertinent weight division in case he/she has both WT ranking points and is recommended by Korea Taekwondo Association.

* For non-Koreans : Above restrictions are not applied.

② Junior : born between Jan 1, 2001 and Dec 31, 2003(15~17 years old) / 10 weight divisions

③ Cadet : born between Jan 1, 2004 and Dec 31, 2006(12~14 years old) / 10 weight divisions

4) QUALIFICATIONS : KUKKIWON Black Belt holders only who are registered on the GMS(Global Membership System) : Proof of KUKKIWON black belt certificate

6) METHODS OF COMPETITION : Single elimination tournament system

7) COMPETITION RULES

- ① Competitions follow the WT Rules.
- ② All competitors must wear WT officially-approved Taekwondo uniform (Dobok).
- ③ Contestants for Kyorugi should bring their own Mandatory Safety Equipment such as WT-approved Groin Guard, Forearm Guard, Shin Guard, Foot protector, Gloves, Mouthpiece, etc.

8) DURATION OF CONTEST

- ① Three rounds of two minutes each with a one-minute rest period between rounds.
- ② In case of a tie score after the completion of the 3rd round, a 4th round of one minute will be conducted as the gold-point round, after a one minute rest period following the 3rd round.

9) WEIGH-IN

- ① Weigh-in of the contestants shall be completed on the previous day of the pertinent competition.
- ② During weigh-in, the male contestant shall wear underpants and the female contestant shall wear underpants and a brassiere. However, weigh-in may be conducted in the nude if the contestant wishes to do so.
- ③ Weigh-in shall be made once, however, one more weigh-in is granted within the time limit to any contestant who did not qualify the first time.
- ④ All competitors should bring their ID cards when they weigh.

* The above is subject to change after the representatives' Meeting.

 - Recognized Poomsae(Individual, Team, Pair) : Cut-off system and Single elimination tournament system
- ③ Designation of Compulsory Poomsae and the drawing of lots
 - Two[2] Compulsory Poomsaes shall be assigned to contestants for each division. Compulsory Poomsaes are subject to change after the representative's meeting.
 - Cut-off system : 2 Compulsory Poomsaes shall be determined by drawing lots electronically with the referee present.
 - Tournament system : 2 Compulsory Poomsae shall be determined by drawing lots electronically with the referee present before the pertinent competition.

- In "Children's division", same types of Compulsory Poomsae shall be designated for both individual and team contestants.
- Cut-off system and single elimination tournament system shall be applied to the Poomsae competitions.
- In the case of insufficient number of contestants in each division, consolidation of divisions shall be made..
- Number of contestants : For a team, 3 competitors for Male/Femal respectively. For a pair, 1 male and 1 female.
- Contestants are allowed to wear either recognized uniform[Dobok] or WT Poomsae uniform.
- In "Children's and Cadet's division" of recognized Poomsae, competitions shall be conducted as mixed gender games.
- Individual and Team competitions of recognized Poomsae shall be conducted separately for Koreans and non- Koreans. (Parts of the competitions shall be carried out together.)
- The contest area for Recognized Poomsae : 10m × 10m
- Scoring of Recognized Poomsae (Individual, Team, Pair)
 - Composition of refereeing officials shall be a five-judge system.
 - Final score shall be the average point of the total points summed up except the highest and lowest points.
 - In case of a tied score, the winner shall be the one has higher total points including the highest and lowest point.
 - In case the match is still tied, the winner shall be the one who has scored higher points in order of skills, presentation, and accuracy.
 - If it's still tied, then a rematch shall be conducted to determine the winner.
 - (A Poomsae for a rematch shall be conducted to declare the winner)

- Free Style Poomsae is the performance based on taekwondo techniques with composition of music and choreography.
- Composition of Free Style Poomsae : Yeon-mu line, music, and choreography shall be the choice of contestant.
- Free style poomsae music file has to be ready with USB, not with CD.
- Performed techniques must be within boundary of taekwondo. If not, the techniques are subject to "Gamjeom". The definition of taekwondo techniques shall be determined by Poomsae committee, when contestant submits performance plan of Free Style Poomsae.
- Contestants are allowed to wear either recognized uniform[Dobok] or WT Poomsae uniform.
- Classification of Korean and foreigner will be decided according to the number of participants at representative meeting.

- The contest area for Free Style Poomsae : 12m × 12m
- Scoring of Free Style Poomsae : WT Poomsae scoring criteria and procedures shall be applied.

- Methods of Competition
 - Duration of contest : 80 seconds ~ 120 seconds
 - Competition System : Cut-off system shall be applied for Individual, Pair, Team
 - Designation of Poomsae and the drawing of lots
- One New Poomsae shall be randomly designated for preliminary, semi-final, and final competitions among the four new Poomsae-Himchari, Saebyeol, Bigak, Nareusya. However, the above is subject to change after the representatives' Meeting.
- Classification of Korean and foreigner will be decided according to the number of participants at representative meeting.
- The drawing of lots for cut-off system shall be conducted electronically at the representatives' meeting to determine the order of competition. The competition shall start from preliminary competitions, and 20 contestants(or teams) shall advance to semi-final. If there are 20 or less contestants(or teams) present at the beginning, the semi-final shall be carried out without preliminary competitions.
- Top eight of the contestants(or teams) shall advance to final.
- The finalists shall compete in the order of ranking(lowest to highest).
- Scoring of New Poomsae(Individual, Team, Pair)
 - Composition of refereeing officials shall be either a five-judge system or a seven-judge system.
 - Final score shall be the average point of the total points summed up except the highest and lowest points.
 - In case of a tied score, the winner shall be the one who has higher total points except the highest and the lowest point.
 - If it's still tied then a rematch shall be conducted to determine the winner. One New poomsae shall be randomly designated for the rematch.
 - WT Poomsae scoring criteria and procedures shall be applied.

④ INTERNATIONAL REFEREES

- 1) The required number of International Referees shall be determined in accordance with the WT Rules.
- 2) Round trip airfare shall be the responsibility of each participating International Referee, while the Organizing Committee will cover accommodation of room and board from July 16 to July 25.
- 3) The Organizing Committee will provide the participating referees with daily allowances of US\$100 for the competition days from July 18 to July 24.

- 2) For nations that don't participate in the meeting, the supervisor of the lot carries out drawing as a proxy.
- 3) When draw for senior of each weight division, there will be seeded the top 20% of the World Taekwondo Federation ranking points.
- 4) Order of drawing lots is subject to change at the representatives' meeting.
