Youth Olympic Pass samsung

- The Youth Olympic Pass is personal, nontransferable and free of charge for spectators.
- With your Youth Olympic Pass you may enter all the Parks and stand alone venues of the Games during all the competition days from October 7 to October 18, 2018.
- In order to be able to enter the Parks and standalone venues, your Youth Olympic Pass must be visible. For ease of access, we recommend you have it placed in your right hand.
- The Parks and stand alone venues will have a limited capacity. Access will not be allowed once such capacity is reached.
- No Youth Olympic Pass is required for children under 4 years old.
- Children between 4 and 13 years old must be registered under a responsible adult as a family group and they must have their individual Youth

Olympic Pass in order to enter. To get the Youth Olympic Passes for these cases it is necessary to submit a photocopy of the ID (DNI) of the registered individual at one of the official delivery points.

- If at the time of registration, you select the option enabling a third party to get the Youth Olympic Pass, they must submit a photocopy of the registered holder's ID to be able to get it in at the authorised delivery points.
- If you lose your Youth Olympic Pass, you must request it again at any of the authorised registration & delivery points. The replacement of up to 2 Youth Olympic Passes will be allowed.

- Once inside the Park, the staff of the organisation will be willing to provide information and resolve any doubts or concerns you may have regarding the parks.
- You can find the following services at the Information Booths:
 - » Orientation for spectators.
 - » Lost & Found.
 - » Identification for children under 4 years old.
 - » Baby Stroller storage
 - » Wheelchair service.
 - » Meeting point.



Lost & Found

- In the event of losing documentation or any object during the Games, please go to the Information Booth.
- You will also have the chance to send an email to objetosperdidos@buenosaires2018.com and we will contact you shortly.
- Lost objects will be stored until 18/10/2018 at each of the Parks. After that date they will be delivered to the police station in the corresponding jurisdiction.



Seating bowl

- Access to the seating bowl is on a "first come, first served" basis, with no possibility of booking seats.
- Baby trolleys may not enter, they must be stored at the Information Booth.

Medical Service:

• First aid and emergency services will be available at the clinics in the Parks. Upon any emergency or enquiry, contact a member of the Youth Olympic Games Buenos Aires 2018 Organising Committee.

 You will find waste containers colouridentified to separate rubbish in a proper manner in all the Parks. Green containers are for recyclable materials and black ones are for trash.

- Public transport is the most effective and comfortable way to move around the city of Buenos Aires to get to the Parks. The "Parks of this Guide" section provides more information about how to get to each of them.
- We recommend avoiding transport in **private vehicles** (cars and/or motorcycles) given that many streets will be affected by this mega event.
- In the access to the Parks there will be spaces to park your bike. These spaces will have limited capacity. Remember to bring a lock to keep it safe.

The use of bicycles is always a good and healthy option!

Important Note!

- Plan your trip keeping in mind which public transport takes you to the Park you would like to visit.
- Before going to the Parks, take a look at their maps to learn the main accesses and where you can enter.
- Use public transport: it is easier and more convenient because many streets will be affected by this mega event.
- Take into account that the Parks and venues have limited capacity so be there early enough.

- Bring your own plastic bottle or cup to fill them up at the hydration points in the Parks.
- Try not to bring backpacks, bags or purses because they will be checked, so this may cause delays at the entrance.

NON-allowed elements and behaviours

In order to guarantee the security of the event, spectators will be checked by the security personnel before entering.

- Liquids:
- Alcohol of any kind, cold, hot and alcoholic beverages, fuel, flammable liquids, perfume, among others
- Dangerous and/or sharp items:
- Fire arms, flares, fireworks, explosives, pepper spray, tear gas, knives, penknives, blades, scissors, among others.
- Other items:
- Toxic or illegal substances, medicines, batteries of any kind.
- Insulating tape, any item that make loud noise, screwdrivers, tweezers, hammers.
- Skateboards, roller skates, bicycles, helmets, sport tools.
- **Exceptions:**

The Urban Park allows the entry of sports equipment for the disciplines of Roller Speed Skating and Skate (standard size) in the areas authorised for practice.

- Aerosols of any kind, drones, balloons and kites
- Selfie sticks, umbrellas, parasols, lounge chairs, chairs and benches.
- Film, recording and/or photographic professional equipment.
- Pets, except guide or assistance dogs.
- Thermos, bags, backpacks, suitcases of any kind and handbags larger than a seat.
- Skateboards, remote control cars, cars for children.



Food and Beverages:

- No food or liquids of any kind are allowed in the parks.
- Empty plastic bottles are allowed and may be filled inside in the hydration points located within the Parks.

Exceptions:

Milk or milk powder for babies as long as they are in a closed and sealed package with a current expiry date.

It will be permitted to bring a reasonable amount of noneperishable food in original factory packaging for personal consumption (packet of biscuits, cereal bars, etc).

NOT-permitted behaviours:

- The access of unauthorised sellers and promoters is not allowed.
- Betting or taking bets within the venues.
- Fighting, shouting or any other type of behaviour which may make the attendees feel uncomfortable.
- Taking off clothing items to be naked or with a bare chest or wearing only underwear.
- Taking pictures with flash in the field of play.
- Entering the field of play without authorisation.
- Performing acts which infringe on moral and ethical standards and which constitute a contravention or violation to national acts.
- Behaviours or actions which constitute an act of religious, gender, racial or of any other type discrimination.
- Smoking in the Youth Olympic Games competition venues. The premises are free of smoke.

- Hand out or show any kind of advertising material (flyers, posters, etc).
- Hang or show flags or banners from countries that are not participating in the Youth Olympic Games Buenos Aires 2018 and/or that have any kind of commercial or offensive message.
- Show/exhibit any kind of merchandising that can be used for ambush marketing (any kind of marketing not duly authorised by the Youth Olympic Games Buenos Aires 2018 Organising Committee).
- Exhibitions or actions that carry political, racial or religious messages that may cause offense or incite violence.

General Terms and Conditions of Acquisition and Use of the Youth Olympic Pass for the Buenos Aires Youth Olympic Games 2018

This is the Buenos Aires 2018 Youth Olympic Games – Terms and Conditions for the Use of the Youth Olympic Pass to the different sport sessions (hereinafter "Terms and Conditions"), available on www.buenosaires2018.com. Please read this complete version carefully. Anyone who books, holds or uses a Youth Olympic Pass shall be deemed as having read, understood and accepted all Terms and Conditions.

1. Definitions

"AOC" means the Argentine Olympic Committee;

"BAYOGOC" means the Buenos Aires Youth Olympic Games Organizing Committee composed by the Argentine Olympic Committee and the Government of the City of Buenos Aires;

"City" means the city of Buenos Aires;

"IOC" means the International Olympic Committee being the leader of the Olympic Movement which is an international non-governmental not-for-profit organization constituted in the form of Swiss-law association.

"NOC(s)" means the National Olympic Committee(s) recognised by the IOC;

"Parks and other sport venues of the Buenos Aires Youth Olympic Games 2018" means any locations where the YOG are to be held, access to which may require a Youth Olympic Pass and any adjacent areas that are under the control of BAYOGOC for so long as they are under its control;

"Pick-up Points" means places where users pick up their Youth Olympic Pass on the days before the start of the YOG;

"YOG" means the third summer edition of the Youth Olympic Games due to be held in the city of Buenos Aires, Argentina during the period between 6 October 2018 and 18 October 2018, being the period between and including the opening ceremony and the closing ceremony of the Youth Olympic Games;

"Youth Olympic Pass" means the pass to enter the Parks and other sport venues of the Buenos Aires Youth Olympic Games 2018;

"Youth Olympic Pass holder" means a person who is in possession of a valid Youth Olympic Pass and, for the avoidance of doubt, includes a registered person and/ or any other Person who registers, holds or uses a Youth Olympic Pass, regardless of nationality;

"Session" means a period of time or meeting arranged for a particular activity (sport activity) at the YOG.

2. Registration, Pick-Up and Use of the Youth Olympic Pass

a) Principle

The access to the Parks and other sport venues of the Buenos Aires Youth Olympic Games 2018 is limited to Youth Olympic Pass holders. Therefore, anyone who is interested in attending sports competition of the YOG must first obtain a Youth Olympic Pass. Persons who wish to obtain a Youth Olympic Pass shall register for a Youth Olympic Pass and pick up the Youth Olympic Pass in accordance with the present Terms and Conditions.

b) Registration process

Registration for Youth Olympic Pass is available on BAYOGOC's website www.buenosaires2018.com/ticketing.

Registration for a Youth Olympic Pass requires that the applicant provides certain personal information, such as first name, last name, email address, passport, date of birth, gender, country, province/state, Pick-up Point to BAYOGOC (mandatory), and other optional fields, in accordance to Section 10. Registration also requires acceptance of the present Terms and Conditions and of BAYOGOC's privacy policy.

One applicant can only apply for 1 (one) Youth Olympic Pass. The application for

more than one Youth Olympic Pass will only be allowed for families (applied only by a parent or legal guardian).

The Youth Olympic Pass applicants will receive a confirmation by e-mail after registration. BAYOGOC may also contact applicant or Youth Olympic Pass holders via e-mail to communicate important information about a Session, security at the YOG or other matters.

c) Pick up of Youth Olympic Pass

Youth Olympic Pass can be picked up at the Pick-up Point indicated during the registration process which can be at the different Pick-Up Points located in the city of Buenos Aires from August 24th, 2018, until October 5th, 2018; and from that same date until the last day of competition, at the Register & Pick-Up Points that will be located at the entrance of the Parks and other sport venues. Dates of pick-up may be subject to change and any related information will be posted on the website www.buenosaires2018.com. Pick up of more than one Youth Olympic Pass applied can be done by the same person with the only requirement of showing identification of all Youth Olympic Pass applicants.

The issuance of the Youth Olympic Pass to applicants is subject to availability in stock

The location of the different Pick-Up points will be listed in the confirmation email every spectator will receive. The complete list will also be published in the FAQs part of the website www.buenosaires2018.com. Pick-Up points will be delivering Youth Olympic Pass during the YOG for those who don't reside in Buenos Aires and couldn't pick up their Youth Olympic Pass at the Pick-Up Points before the beginning of the YOG.

d) Age limitations

Only the Youth Olympic Pass holders who have reached the age of 14 years old are eligible to register as holders of the Youth Olympic Pass. For those people who have not reached the age of 14 years old, the registration shall be made by a parent or legal guardian.

Persons under 14 years of age must attend accompanied by an adult (over the age of eighteen), otherwise they will not be allowed to enter the Parks and other sport venues.

Persons under the age of 4 do not need a Youth Olympic Pass when accompanied by an adult companion (over the age of eighteen) in possession of a valid Youth Olympic Pass.

3. Replacement of Youth Olympic Pass

In case of loss, theft of the Youth Olympic Pass or in case of damage which may prevent its reading by the Youth Olympic Pass readers, and subject to the provision of sufficient evidence on the loss, theft or damage of the Youth Olympic Pass, the Youth Olympic Pass holder can obtain a second Youth Olympic Pass. The initial Youth Olympic Pass which has been lost, stolen or damaged will be cancelled.

The second Youth Olympic Pass shall grant the Youth Olympic Pass holder the same rights as the first one, that is, the possibility of having access to all Parks and other sport venues during the YOG, subject to their capacity and availability.

There will be no replacement offered in case of loss, theft or damage of the second Youth Olympic Pass or in the absence of sufficient evidence of the loss, theft or damage.

4. Limitations related to the transfer of Youth Olympic Pass.

The Youth Olympic Pass holder cannot sell, offer, auction, donate or transfer it, since the Youth Olympic Pass is personal and non-transferrable.

5. Conditions of access and permanence in Competitions Venues and Parks.

A Youth Olympic Pass does not guarantee access to the Parks and other sport venues of the Buenos Aires Youth Olympic Games 2018 or to a particular Session. Every Youth Olympic Pass holder acknowledges and accepts that the access to the Parks and other sport venues of the Buenos Aires Youth Olympic Games 2018 and to each Session, activity or competition performed therein, is subject to the availability and capacity of each Park and sport venues. The sole admission criterion to

be used by BAYOGOC will be exclusively the order of arrival of Youth Olympic Pass holders. Access is given on a first-come, first-served basis and it is strictly reserved to Youth Olympic Pass Holders.

The availability and capacity for the different Park activities and/or sport competitions will be communicated to the Youth Olympic Pass holders through informative screens in the Parks and other sport venues. At the same time, the Youth Olympic Pass holders can receive warnings and messages regarding availability and capacity on the Buenos Aires 2018 App.

Youth Olympic Pass holders will be responsible for their own personal safety, and the safety of any accompanying minor. To ensure the attendees' safety and smooth operation of the Parks, activities and competitions of Buenos Aires 2018, Youth Olympic Pass holders must comply with these Terms and Conditions, as well as every warning, notice and instruction provided by BAYOGOC. BAYOGOC shall not be liable for the consequences of any reckless behaviour, negligence or behaviour against the instructions of BAYOGOC or the Argentine laws.

6. Validation of the Youth Olympic Pass and Security Procedures

The first access control shall be carried out upon admission to the Parks and other sport venues of the Buenos Aires Youth Olympic Games 2018. Only Youth Olympic Pass holders shall be admitted and only subject to the capacity of each Park and other sport venue.

A new validation shall be required to access the Sports Venues, in order to control all spectators access and exit. As mentioned in Section 10 below, for crowd management and security reasons, the entry/exit of Youth Olympic Pass holders into/from the Parks and other venues of the Buenos Aires Youth Olympic Games 2018 will be recorded.

For security reasons, every Youth Olympic Pass holder will be subject to security procedures before the access to the Parks and/or during their stay. The above controls are mandatory to access the Parks and other sport venues of the Buenos Aires Youth Olympic Games 2018 and can include, among others, bag search and the inspection of any other objects carried by the Youth Olympic Pass holder or any accompanying minor that accompanies her.

During the stay at the Competitions Venues and Parks, the Youth Olympic Pass holder will be solely responsible for any and all of her belongings.

7. Forbidden items.

All spectators are prohibited from transporting into Parks and other sport venues any solid, liquid or gaseous items that, for security reasons, are considered illegal, dangerous, or can be used for the purpose of causing injuries, damages or behaviours that may impact the smooth and safe operations at the YOG. Any Youth Olympic Pass Holder who is found to be in possession of any of the items considered dangerous (some of them listed below as example, among others), will have the items seized (with no right to have the items returned), shall be removed from Parks and other sport venues. In case of any unlawful act BAYOGOC reserves the right to refer the matter to law enforcement authorities. The list below is non-exhaustive and represents only a summary of forbidden items, and is subject to change at the discretion of BAYOGOC. An updated, detailed list of forbidden items can be found at www.buenosaires2018.com.

- Weapons, ammunition and explosives, or any object with sharp edge.
- Weapon replicas and replicas of any other instrument of similar characteristics.
- Fireworks, fuel, alcohol and other explosive or flammable substances.
- Dangerous chemicals that are toxic or corrosive.
- Radioactive substances and any other dangerous substance.
- Batteries of any kind.
- Duct tapes.
- Medicines.
- Drills, hammers, screwdrivers, pliers, levers, saws and handsaws.
- Illegal drugs.
- Any other item or substance expressly forbidden under the Argentine laws and regulations.
- Breakable items and containers.
- Alcohol of any kind, cold, hot and alcoholic beverages, fuels, flammable liquids, perfumes, among others.
- Food and beverages in general for the spectators, with the exception of baby milk (powder or liquid), provided that it is closed, sealed and not expired, and a reasonable amount of non-perishable food in original factory packaging for personal consumption.

Examples: Crisps, biscuits and nuts

- Thermos.
- Signs and any other propaganda or advertisement item with political, racist, religious or commercial contents.
- Any means of transport other than strollers and wheelchairs.
- Animals (except for guide dogs and other service animals).
- Flags of countries participating in the YOG of a size exceeding 2mts x 2mts when unfolded.
- Professional photography, video recording equipment or live streaming applications.
- Radios, laser devices, megaphones, intercoms and radio equipment, or any article casting electronic and/or cluster signals.
- Fragile articles and containers, such as glasses/cups (Mate)
- Skateboards, roller skates and bicycles.
- Sport tools, lubricants, special wrenches.
- Helmets.
- Aerosols of any kind.
- Drones, balloons and kites.
- Umbrellas, parasols, lounge chairs, chairs and benches.
- Selfie sticks.
- Bags, backpacks, suitcases of any kind and handbags larger than a seat.
- Other items posing a security risk.

BAYOGOC can keep and/or remove any forbidden item found, any other item or object if deemed inappropriate. BAYOGOC can request the person who has the forbidden item to leave.

8. Behaviour

Any behaviour by a Youth Olympic Pass Holder that, in BAYOGOC's view, creates a dangerous situation, puts at risk an individual's personal security, is against public order, interferes in any way with the orderly execution of a Session or disrupts the enjoyment of a Session is forbidden and may result in a refusal of admission to or removal from Parks and other sport venues. BAYOGOC also reserves the right to refer the matter to competent law enforcement authorities.

The following is an illustrative list of prohibited and restricted behaviour within any Park and other sport venues, and is subject to change at the discretion of BAYO-GOC:

- Watching competitions from a forbidden area, not authorised for the access of Youth Olympic Pass holders.
- Smoking in any area of the Parks.
- Any type of behaviour that disrupts public order of the place or violates Argentine laws and regulations.
- The Youth Olympic Pass holder cannot participate in any activity that creates a false or unauthorised association with the YOG.
- Display trademarks or symbols in clothing or accessories; or product or services in a manner that implies any association between a third-party or products or services of a third-party and the YOG.
- Unauthorised activities of publicity, promotion, display or fund raising (including without limitation, trade, religion, politics, military conflicts, territory conflicts, etc.); distribution of promotional products or items with a corporate brand or logotype thereon; no TV broadcasting if it is not authorised, or use of professional photography, video recording equipment or live streaming applications on the site. The description is merely exemplative, and BAYOGOC can consider another type of behaviour as inappropriate.

9. Image rights and conditions for taking photographs or recording in the

The Youth Olympic Pass holder agrees: (i) that the YOG are a public event, and that his/her appearance and actions inside and in the perimeter of the Parks and other sport venues of the Buenos Aires Youth Olympic Games 2018 are public in nature, and that he/she shall have no expectation of privacy with regard to his/her actions or conduct at the event; and (ii) to being photographed, filmed, identified and/or otherwise recorded by BAYOGOC, the City, the AOC, the IOC and its affiliated entities or third parties authorised by the IOC, including without limitation broadcasters, news media organizations, social media networks, International Sports Federations, National Olympic Committees, Organising Committees for the Olympic Games or the Youth Olympic Games; who, without payment, shall have the right to use any such photographs, films or recordings during and after the YOG, for the maximum duration permitted under the applicable laws and when applicable at least until they are in the public domain, in any content format and through any media or technology whether now existing or created in the future

and whether such use is commercial or non-commercial, in relation to the celebration and direct or indirect promotion of the Youth Olympic Games, the Olympic Games, the Olympic Movement and/or the IOC.

The Youth Olympic Pass holder may take or record still and moving images and/ or sounds within the perimeter of the Parks and Venues where the events occur and hereby agrees that the IOC shall be sole owner of any intellectual property rights (including copyright) in such content without further authorization from, or payment or compensation to, the Youth Olympic Pass holder of the Youth Olympic Pass or anyone acting on his/her behalf, and hereby assign any rights he/she may have in respect of such content to the IOC, including without limitation the right to make derivative works, and to the extent permitted by applicable laws, waiving all moral rights in the same.

Pursuant to the above, the IOC hereby grants to the Youth Olympic Pass holder with a limited and revocable licence to use the still and moving images and/ or sounds taken or recorded within the perimeter of the Parks and other sport venues of the Buenos Aires Youth Olympic Games 2018, provided that such use is personal, private, non-commercial and non-promotional. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Youth Olympic Pass holder shall not transmit any moving images and/or sounds taken or recorded within the perimeter of the Parks and other sport venues of the Buenos Aires Youth Olympic Games 2018 over the internet, radio, television or any other media now known or hereafter invented (with such prohibition including, without limitation, not posting such content on social media platforms or live-streaming such content through any website or application), without the IOC's prior consent.

The Youth Olympic Pass holder is prohibited from collecting, disseminating, transmitting or publishing any scores, statistics or other information related to the events taking place within the Venues for any commercial, betting or gambling purpose.

10. Collection of personal data

As set forth in Section 2, registration for a Youth Olympic Pass is subject to applicants providing certain personal data about the applicants and, if applicable, the applicant's family members. This information will be processed by, BAYOGOC to process registration and for the issuance and pick up of the Youth Olympic Pass, and to ensure the smooth operations and the safety and security of the YOG.

Through validation of the Youth Olympic Pass at the entrance and exit of the Parks and other sport venues of the Buenos Aires Youth Olympic Games 2018 and relevant venues, BAYOGOC may collect the physical location of Youth Olympic Pass holders. This collection and use of Youth Olympic Pass holders location is necessary in order to for crows management, to manage capacity of the Parks and other sport venues of the Buenos Aires Youth Olympic Games 2018 and to ensure the security of the YOG operations.

For more information about the collection, processing and use of the personal information please see the Privacy Policy at www.buenosaires2018.com.

11. Breach of these Terms

In case of breach of these Terms and Conditions, BAYOGOC can, without any liability, reject the application for a Youth Olympic Pass, deny the access to the Parks and other sport venues of the Buenos Aires Youth Olympic Games 2018 and request a Youth Olympic Pass holder to leave the Parks and other sport venues of the Buenos Aires Youth Olympic Games 2018.

Breach of these Terms and Conditions by the Youth Olympic Pass holder will make this person liable for damages caused to AOC, the City, BAYOGOC and IOC and affiliates, or third parties, by reason of such breach.

To the fullest extent admissible under Argentinean law, BAYOGOC and the IOC are not liable for damages, loss or injury the Youth Olympic Pass holder might suffer when attending the YOG, and the Youth Olympic Pass holder expressly waive bringing any action against them.

Youth Olympic Pass holders will hold harmless and indemnify the AOC, the City and the IOC and affiliates against any claim brought, related or caused by, or of any nature, originated by reason of their actions inside the Parks and other sport venues of the Buenos Aires Youth Olympic Games 2018 and within the context of the activities and competitions developed therein.

For the avoidance of doubt, it is understood and agreed that the breach of these Terms and the application of any of the sanctions and consequences described in this section 11, will not affect in any manner or form the assignment of rights granted to the IOC pursuant to section 9 here above.

12. Miscellaneous

These Terms and Conditions constitute the entire agreement between the Youth Olympic Pass holder and BAYOGOC.

BAYOGOC reserves the right to change the date, time and any other relevant circumstance regarding the different activities and competitions of the YOG. BAYOGOC and the IOC shall not be liable for any change that may arise, and, whenever feasible, will be able to communicate changes through its different channels of communication. Similarly, BAYOGOC and the IOC shall not be liable in case Youth Olympic Pass cannot be delivered for any reasons (e.g. stock availability) or if a Youth Olympic Pass holder cannot attend a particular session due to high attendance.

In case that any section included in these Terms and Conditions is not enforceable for any reason, this will not affect the other sections of these Terms and Conditions

Any dispute related to the Terms and Conditions will be governed by the laws of Argentina, submitting to the competence of the Administrative and Tax Courts of the City of Buenos Aires, waiving any other jurisdiction.

This Terms and Conditions have been drafted in English and translated to Spanish. In the event of any discrepancy between the English and a translated version of these Terms and Conditions, the English version shall prevail.

All athletes must comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force, including but not limited to, Rule 41 (Nationality of Competitors). Only those athletes who have complied with the Olympic Charter may participate in the Youth Olympic Games.

Age

To be eligible to participate in the Youth Olympic Games, athletes must have been born between 1 January 2001 and 31 December 2002.

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Additional IF Requirements:

To be eligible to participate in the Youth Olympic Games, athletes must:

- Be a Kukkiwon Dan or Poom certificate holder;
- Be a WT Global Athlete License holder;
- Have been nominated by the relevant national taekwondo association that is recognised by the World Taekwondo and by their NOC.

one (1) athlete per weight category. See Host Country Places section.

HOST COUNTRY PLACES

The host country will automatically qualify three (3) male and three (3) female athletes, with a maximum of one (1) athlete per weight category, on the condition that the athletes meet the eligibility requirements described under section C of this document. For the YOG, all the six (6) athletes shall be seeded in fourth place.

UNIVERSALITY PLACES

Ten (10) male Universality Places and ten (10) female Universality Places will be made available to eligible NOCs at the YOG, subject to the athletes meeting the required technical level and the eligibility criteria defined under section C.

The International Olympic Committee will invite all eligible NOCs to submit their requests for Universality Places by 15 January 2017. The Tripartite Commission will confirm, in writing, the allocation of invitation places to the relevant NOCs, in collaboration with WT, as of 13 March 2017. The NOCs will have until 31 March 2017 to confirm the use of their places to the Tripartite Commission.

E. CONFIRMATION PROCESS FOR QUOTA PLACES

CONFIRMATION OF QUALIFICATION PLACES

The WTII confirm NOCs' qualification place(s) immediately following the WT World YOG Qualification Tournament.

The NOCs will then have two (2) weeks to confirm in writing to the WT and BAYOGOC if they wish to use these quota places as detailed in section G. Qualification Timeline.

CONFIRMATION OF HOST COUNTRY PLACES

The host country must confirm in writing to the WT and BAYOGOC by 31 December 2017 the participation of its athletes, specifying the chosen weight categories.

F. REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUOTA PLACES

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUALIFICATION PLACES

If a quota place allocated is not confirmed by the NOC by the confirmation of quota place deadline or is declined by the NOC, the quota place will be reallocated to the next best-ranked NOC not yet qualified in the

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respective weight category at the WT World YOG Qualification Tournament, on condition that the maximum quota per NOC is not exceeded.

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED HOST COUNTRY PLACES

Any unused Host Country Places will be reallocated to the next best-ranked NOC not yet qualified in the respective weight category at the WT World YOG Qualification Tournament, on condition that the maximum quota per NOC is not exceeded.

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED UNIVERSALITY PLACES

Any unused Universality Places, including those returned after the final allocation by YOG Tripartite Commission, will be reallocated to the next best-ranked NOC not yet qualified in the respective weight category at the WT World YOG Qualification Tournament, on condition that the maximum quota per NOC is not exceeded.
