ATHLETE QUALIFICATION

- **1.** Holder of the nationality of the participating team.
- Participants must be nominated by a pertinent club and / or National Taekwondo Association that is recognized by the World Taekwondo and / or by their National Olympic Committee.
- **3.** Taekwondo 1st POOM / DAN or higher certificate required for Cadets, Juniors, Under21, Seniors and Masters.
- **4.** Taekwondo 4th KUP or higher certificate required for Children.
- **5.** Taekwondo 1st Poom / DAN or higher certificate required for Poomsae A Class.
- **6.** Taekwondo 4th KUP up to 1st KUP certificate required for Poomsae B Class.
- **7.** All Athletes who must have a WT Global Athlete License (GAL) & WT Event Pass and Kyorugi or Poomsae Coaches must have Global Official License (GOL) & WT Event Pass.

The WT Event Pass is a mandatory requirement for all athletes and officials (Coaches, Referees, Officials, Doctors, Physiotherapists & Executives) who wish to participate in any World Taekwondo (WT) recognized event.

8. An athlete must be born to be eligible for participation as follows:

The age limits for each division is based on the year, not on the date, when the Championships are held.

All competitors must prove their age by presenting their passport or identification card at the official weigh-in. Membership to an MNA will be checked by the organizer. For those athletes that are not adults, a written consent must be submitted (please find enclosed) at the registration, signed by parents or legal guardians, accepting their participation and all parts of the official invitation.

POOMSAE & FREESTYLE CONTEST

CONTESTANT AGES Age category is based on the year of birth.

Example: if an athlete will be 18 years old in 2018, but on the day of the competition he/she is still 17 years old, then he/she must compete in the category 18-30 years old (U30).

Note: Contestants may compete in maximum four (4) categories (recognized poomsae max. 2 classes / age division and freestyle poomsae max. 2 classes / age division) of competition unless he or she is limited by gender or age.

Music freestyle Athletes must bring their music in MP3 format on USB-stick. Apple audio format is not accepted. The music shall be the choice of the contestant, however any political, social and religious content is not allowed. Compulsory poomsae two (2) poomsae from designated compulsory poomsae, decided for each division must be performed for all the preliminarily, semi-final and final rounds for all competitions.

CONTESTANTS

Each team may enter as many athletes into each Sport Class and age category as they like.

GENERAL INFO

Protests must be made as per competition rules by the official coach within 10 minutes after the end of the pertinent contest to the Technical Delegate. Protest fee is € 200 and non-refundable. The decision on the protest shall be announced after 30 minutes.

QUALIFICATION COACHES

The minimum qualification requirements for coaches are as follows:

- All coaches must be at least 18 years of age.
- All coaches / trainers must be holders of the World Taekwondo Europe Coach License or the respective CU Coach License (granted by participation in a CU Coach Seminar).
- Coaches / Trainers that do not have the CU Coach License shall pay a € 200, (euro paid on spot) penalty at the registration desk.
- Coaching is not allowed wearing dobok.

Dress code coaches during the preliminaries, quarter-finals, coaches shall wear sportswear. During semi-finals and finals coaches must wear a formal outfit. During the Head of Team meeting, more information about the dress code shall be provided to the teams. Coaches that do not follow the dress code cannot enter into the field of play.

REGISTRATION

Entries for A class will only be accepted through the WT online registration system and registration is only possible with a valid WT Global License & WT Event Pass.

Entries for B class will only be accepted through the <u>www.tkd-reg.com</u> online registration system.

forms is set at 25th of October 2018, 23:59 CET. Registration must be done
via TKD Reg System (http://www.tkd-reg.com).

REGISTRATION NOTICE

Any athlete registering online who does not take part in the competition and who has not been removed from the entry list before the deadline (22nd October 2018 for Class A, 25th October for Class B), is liable for paying his/her entry-fee in full.

The entry fee is non-refundable. If a team does not show up at the event and has not requested a participation cancellation before the deadline, it will be requested to settle the payment of the entry fees in full (100%).

For any athlete not presenting at registration, his/her team or official will be liable for ensuring full payment has been received, prior to the team's participation).

PROTECTOR & SCORING SYSTEM

DAEDO 2nd Generation PSS will be used. The Organizing Committee will provide DAEDO trunk protector and DAEDO E-headgear. Participating contestants are required to bring their own groin guards, forearm guards, shin guards, mouthpieces, gloves and sensor socks for their personal use.

Participating contestants are required to wear WT recognized doboks and WT recognized protective equipment, otherwise access to the field of play will be refused. The latest version of WT recognized manufacturers list is available on the WT website:

ANTI-DOPING REGULATIONS

The WT Anti-Doping Rules, and where necessary the Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, shall apply throughout the competitions.

Compulsory anti-doping tests will be carried out for all finalists, while random tests will be conducted among the quarter- and semi-finalists who failed to advance to the (semi-)final.

The WT and/or WADA may carry out random out-of-competition testing prior to the championship. Therefore, all participating contestants are required to submit their latest and most accurate Athlete Location (Whereabouts Info) Forms to the WT. TUE (Therapeutic Use Athletes who take any substance or medicine listed Exemption) in the "Prohibited List" of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and Anti-Doping Code of World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) for therapeutic purposes are requested to visit the website of WADA and make online filing of their TUE applications on ADAMS http://www.wadaama.org/en/ADAMS/ and report to the WT Sport Department at marcoienna@wtf.org by no later than1st April 2018. INDEMNITIES

It is the responsibility of each registering team to ensure that their athletes and team officials have filled out the indemnification forms correctly and have duly signed them, thereby indemnifying WT, WT Europe, the Organizing Committee and all other officials and athletes from any claims of injuries, losses or otherwise arising in the course of participation at the DRACULA OPEN 2018 or any activities linked therewith.

It is the responsibility of each registered team to ensure and guarantee that all competitors have an Athletic Insurance (especially for participation in sports events) which has to be presented during the onsite registration. Without sufficient insurance coverage, national teams will not be allowed to compete.

Please fill out the Personal Indemnity Forms and return them to the Organization Committee before 15th of October 2018. Each participant (athletes, team officials, etc.) has to fill out the indemnification form.

HEAD OF TEAM MEETING

The Head of Team meeting shall be conducted by World Taekwondo Europe officials. Exact date, time and place for all divisions & categories will be communicated forthwith.

DRAW OF LOTS

The draw sheets and brackets will be available one (1) day before the start of the competition of the respective category. Published on the official web site of the event (www.draculaopen.ro).

The drawing of lots will be conducted by World Taekwondo Europe officials prior to the competition in the presence of officials and representatives of the participating nations. The draw will be carried out for all weight categories electronically (after the weigh-in is completed).

All athletes recognized as Seniors will be seeded according to the WT Global Ranking as per the 22 October 2018 ranking.

WEIGH IN

The weigh-in of the athletes takes place in accordance with the WT Rules & Regulations and is explained in the first page of this document. During the weigh-in, the male athlete shall wear underpants and the female athlete shall wear underpants and brassiere. However, the athlete may weigh in nude if he/she wishes to do so.

Competitors that will not pass the weigh-in will be moved up in weight category free of charge (if the registration is made before of the last day for registration).

Competitors that will not pass the weigh-in will be moved up in weight category with 10 Euro charge (if the registration is made after the last day of official registration shedules)

INTERNATIONAL REFEREES

Each country must bring at least one (1) international licensed referee. A maximum of three (3) referees per participating nation will be admitted. If is any case the second and third referee must be, national referee class with great experience and knowledge.

International Referees must be licenced by the WT. Those referee should send their application form before the 1st Octomber 2018 to the Organizing Committee at: <u>organizator@taekwondowtf.ro</u>

The OC will provide accommodation and full board from the 1st of November (11:00 AM) until the 5th of November 2018 (11:00 AM) only in the official hotel for referees.

Each international referee will receive an allowance of €50,00 Eur / competition day.

ACCOMMODATION

Trip airfare and Accommodation shall be borne by their own participating teams. The Organizing Committee will arrange transportation from Bucharest airports to the official hotels and back. For any details regarding official hotels please contact the Organizing Committee.

VISA

If your National Team Members need visa to enter Romania, please return the completely filled-in Appendix 3 – Visa Details form to the Organizing Committee (organizator@taekwondowtf.ro) until the 2nd of October 2018 and be sure to inform the OC of the location of the Romanian Embassy to which your team will apply for visa. The Organizing Committee cannot guarantee entry into Romania and can only offer assistance. It is the responsibility of each MNA to apply on term, for and secure the correct entry visa for Romania.

NATIONAL FLAG & ANTHEM

Every participating MNA is required to provide the following items for use during the Opening ceremony:

- 1. Two (2) IOC-recognized national flags Size: 90cm x 130cm
- Stick/CD of the pertinent IOC-recognized national anthem Items mentioned in 1 & 2 must be submitted to the Organizing Committee during registration at the Registration Centre (iphone is not permitted).

HALL RULES

Only the competitors and their coaches have admittance by their registration cards to the contest areas. One (1) coach for every five (5) competitors has free admission with a maximum of four (4) coaches per team in sportswear (no dobok).

AWARDS

Medals will be awarded to the first, second and two third place occupants of each weight and age category.

Trophies will be awarded to the first, second and third place club teams for each age category and for the overall ranking.

All contestants and officials will receive a certificate of participation.

SPECIFICATIONS

Poomsae: This event shall take place on the **2nd of November 2018**.

Kyorugi: The odd weight categories (first, third, fifth, etc.) columns presented in the invitation shall take place on the **3rd of November 2018**.

Kyorugi: The even weight categories (second, fourth, sixth, etc.) columns presented in the invitation shall take place on the **4th of November 2018**.

The Organizing Committee reserves its right to bring changes to this document.
