2. DATE AND PLACE

DATE:	21 st -22 nd of September 2019
PLACE, REGISTRATION, OFFICE:	Torwar Sports Center Łazienkowska 6A Street, Warsaw, Poland

3. CONTESTANTS

CATEGORIES:	Seniors Male and Female, Juniors Male and Female, Cadets Male and Female.
AGE:	Cadets born in 2007, 2006, 2005 Juniors born in 2004, 2003, 2002 Seniors born in 2002 and older <u>An athlete who was born in 2002 can compete as a junior or as a senior. Competing in both categories is not allowed.</u>
GRADUATION:	All senior and junior competitors must hold at least 2nd Geup, cadets must hold at least 4th Geup
WEIGHT DIVISIONS:	World Taekwondo weight classes
QUALIFICATIONS:	The WT Global Licence (WT Global Athlete Licence & Global Official Licence) is required by all athletes and officials participating in this tournament. WT Global Licence registrations & renewals can only be made through the WT recognized Member National Associations and application should be made at least 2 months before the tournament starts to ensure the WT licence can be processed and approved on time. There will be "NO" WT Global Licence registration onsite. The WT licence must be valid for 2019 or renewed to be used for 2019 - entry fees apply. The WT licence is the responsibility of all participants (competitors and officials) participating at the 26th Polish Open – 22nd Warsaw Cup Taekwondo Championships and must be registered and approved through their respective WT Member National Association.

4. RULES

COMPETITION RULES:	WT Competition rules
IVR SYSTEM:	Will be used on all courts
SEEDING:	Seeding of Senior Athletes will be based on the September 2019 Rankings (including events until the end of August 2019).
MODE:	Single elimination tournament system. The organization committee and WT Technical Delegate can decide to adjust the competition.
DRAW SHEETS:	The draw sheets will be published daily, one (1) day before the start of competition on the following websites: www.tpss.eu , https://www.facebook.com/polishopentkd/
RANDOM WEIGH-IN:	The names of the athletes selected for the random weigh-in will be published on Saturday and Sunday at 07:00 am on the following websites: www.tpss.eu https://www.facebook.com/polishopentkd/
DOPING CONTROL:	Some contestants chosen at random will be tested.
AWARDS:	1 st , 2 nd and two 3 rd places will be awarded.
HALL RULES:	Only the competitors and their coaches will have the admittance with valid accreditations to the contest areas.
EQUIPMENT:	WT-recognized PSS Daedo Gen 2 + E-helmet shall be provided for all competition areas and all weight divisions (cadet, junior and senior). Only WT-recognized Equipment: groin-, forearm-, shin-, mouthpiece and gloves will be brought by the contestants, which is compulsory. Sensor socks <u>will not</u> be provided by the organization team and must be purchased by each competitor.
PROTEST:	Only the official coach can protest to the LSC, immediately after the end of the contest. An amount of €100 will have to be paid for each protest. The protest amount will not be refunded in any case.
LIABILITY:	All competitors are considered to participate at their own risk. Polish Taekwondo Federation and the organizer assume no responsibility for any damages, injuries or losses, and specifically note that they also take no responsibility for any damages, losses, injuries or other consequences due to (direct or indirect) acts of terrorism or terrorist threats. All contestants must bring their own documents and forms for any medical treatment in Poland. If not, this will have to be paid in cash. By registering, Club takes responsibility for application form in accordance with real data and with the consent of legal guardians (underage players) and accepts the competition rules.
IDENTIFICATION:	According to Polish law all competitors and visitors need to have a valid identification by means of a valid passport or other official identification document

5. ENTRY

REGISTRATION:

Registration is only accepted through the World Taekwondo Event Registration system <https://worldtkd.simplycompete.com/> and registration is only possible with a valid 2019 WT Global License.

DEADLINE:

7th of September at 11:59pm Warsaw time, or after reaching 1200 competitors. (500 seniors / 700 juniors, cadets)

ACCREDITATIONS:

National teams can have accreditations for 2 officials, 2 coaches, 1 official doctor (not second coach).

Club teams can only register coach accreditations. All other accreditations are not allowed. One (1) coach for every five (5) competitors has a free admission with a maximum of six (6) coaches per team. The minimum age for a coach must be 18 years. Extra coach passes can be requested separately for € 25,00 euro for each individual coach. Coaches need to have a valid WT and a continental coach licence.

Please note that only 1 competitor and 1 coach can enter the competition area.

MODIFICATIONS:

Modifications after the deadline 7.09.2019 are possible at the Registration Office for an amount of €25,00 for each modification (only weight changes). After the official weigh-in no further modifications will be made. This means no changes will be made in weight divisions!

If the athlete registered on-line does not take part in the competition, and he/she has not been removed before the date 7th of September his/her team or official must fully (100%) pay his/her entry fee for participation. Entry fee is not refundable at any time after the deadline!

VISA:

If you need a Visa to Poland, you can send official request for assistance with a filled in visa application form (available on website www.warsawcup.com) to warsawcup@wp.pl. It is advised to arrange the Visa on time. Deadline for Visa assistance is 21st of August.

ENTRY FEE & PAYMENT:

€100,00 (Euro) for each contestant (seniors, juniors and cadets)

Application is only valid when payment has been done to the bank account at the same time of registration and when payments of all entry fees have been received within 5 days after registration. If payment is not received within 5 days the application will be removed from the online registration. Entries done 5 days before the deadline must be paid immediately.

All fees must be paid in EUROS and please ensure you pay any additional currency charges.

Payment must be done by TEAM. Individual payment is not allowed.
