1. ADMISSIONS CONDITIONS

Seniors categories : All participants of 1st Dan can participate

Juniors and cadets categories : All junior and cadet athletes of 3rd keup can participate

All athletes and coaches participating to the French Ecopen must hold a valid 2020 WT Global licence and WT Event pass to be able to participate in this tournament. Participants must be member of a National Taekwondo Federation, affiliated to the W.T (*There will be NO WT Global License registration onsite*).

All the clubs commit themselves to obtain from their competitors juniors and cadets a parental authorization of participation at the French Ecopen

The number of participants per category is limited - The National Team has priority for registration.

- Important Information -

The "Covid 19" epidemic requires the organizing committee to take strict protective measures and to establish a health protocol so that the "French Ecopen" takes place in good conditions. This health protocol will be published in September 2020.

The teams will have to read it and apply it scrupulously throughout the duration of the competition.

2. CATEGORIES

- Senior Male and Female from 1st Dan (Kukkiwon), born in 2003 and before
- Junior Male and Female from 3rd keup, born in 2003, 2004 and 2005
- Cadet Male and Female from 3rd keup, born in 2006, 2007 and 2008
(Competitors born in 2003 must choose to participate in either Juniors or Seniors)

No refunding registration fees after the deadline

All fees must be paid in EURO'S and please ensure you pay any additional currency charges.

If the athlete registered on-line does not take part in the competition, but he/she has not been removed from the list of participants before the deadline his/her team or official must fully (100%) pay his/her Entry fee for participation.

8. VISA

The Organizing Committee recommends that visa application should be done at least one month prior to the entry into the Republic of France. The Organizing Committee will help the participating teams for entry visas if requested. Deadline : **October 23th, 2020**

9. EQUIPMENT

The organizing committee will provide to the participating contestants «**DAE DO GEN II**» PSS body and head electronics protectors. Groin/forearm/shin guards and gloves, mouth piece, DaeDo sensing socks Gen II, are compulsory and must be brought by the contestant for their personal use.

Participating are required to wear W.T. recognized. Competition uniforms (doboks) and WT recognized protective equipment. **Contestants uniforms and protectors, please check on WT competition rules: Article 4-2 to 2.5**

10. LIABILITY

By registering for the FrenchEopen all contestants accept the rules and conditions of participation set by the organizing committee.

All contestants will participate at their own risk. The Organizer could not be responsible for any loss or damage to individuals or equipment under no circumstances.

All the clubs commit themselves to obtain from their competitors Juniors and Cadets a parental authorization of participation at the FrenchEopen.

12. DOPING CONTROL

The W.T. anti-doping rules, and where necessary the code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, shall apply throughout the competition
