COMPETITION RULES

WT Competition Rules & Interpretation, in force as of October, 2020

COMPETITION SYSTEM

Single elimination tournament system.

SEEDING

Seniors: All athletes will be seeded according to the latest available WT World Ranking.

CONTEST TIME

Senior divisions: 3 rounds of 2 min with 1 min break between each round

Junior divisions: 3 rounds of 1 min 30 sec with 1 min break between each round Cadet divisions: 3 rounds of 1 min 30 sec with 1 min break between each round

Contest times could be adjusted according to WT TD Decisions.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Holder of a valid 2021 WT Global Athlete License;
- 2. Member of the team/club of a pertinent Member National Association, recognized by Taekwondo Europe or World Taekwondo, a letter from the federation may be requested;
- 3. Holder of Taekwondo Dan/Poom certificate for Seniors. For Juniors and Cadets 1st Gup and above.
- 4. An athlete in order to be eligible for participation must be born in:

Seniors: 2004 or before Juniors: 2004, 2005, 2006 Cadets: 2007, 2008, 2009

(Juniors born in 2004 compete as a junior or as a senior. Competing in both categories is not allowed.)

All competitors must prove their age by presenting their passport or identification card at the official weigh-in. For those athletes that are not adults, a written consent must be submitted (please find enclosed on the last pages) at the registration, signed by one of the parents or legal guardians, accepting their participation and all parts of the official invitation.

COACH ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Minimum age of 18 years;
- Holder of the WT Coach Certification Level I (granted by participation in a WT recognized Coach Seminar);
- 3. Holder of a valid 2021 WT Global Official License;
- 4. Coach is not allowed wearing Dobok.

MEDICAL STAFF ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Minimum age of 18 years;
- 2. Holder of the WTE Medical License;
- 3. Holder of a valid 2021 WT Global Official License.

MEDAL EVENTS

The following medal events are applicable:

SENIORS DIVISION

Male: -54kg, -58kg, -63kg, -68kg, -74kg, -80kg, -87kg, +87kg;

Female: -46kg, -49kg, -53kg, -57kg, -62kg, -67kg, -73kg, +73kg;

JUNIORS DIVISION

Male: -45kg, -48kg, -51kg, -55kg, -59kg, -63kg, -68kg, -73kg, -78kg, +78kg; Female: -42kg, -44kg, -46kg, -49kg, -52kg, -55kg, -59kg, -63kg, -68kg, +68 kg;

CADETS DIVISION

Male: -33kg, -37kg, -41kg, -45kg, -49kg, -53kg, -57kg, -61kg, -65kg, +65kg; Female: -29kg, -33kg, -37kg, -41kg, -44kg, -47kg, -51kg, -55kg, -59kg, +59 kg.

SPORT ENTRIES

Team entries will only be accepted through the WT GMS online registration system Simply Compete.

Registration of athletes is only possible with a valid 2021 WT Global License (GAL issued by assigned GMS club, region and MNA Administrators only). Please find below the direct link to the WT GMS platform:

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

16 May 2021, 23:59 CET

This deadline is applicable for all sport entries and admitting all required documents.

APPLICABLE FEES

Regular entry fee

100 euro per registered individual athlete.

Entry Fees should be paid in cash during registration. No refunds.

On-site Change of medal event (weight division)

25 euro for each change of medal event made on-site after deadline.

Protest fee

100 euro. In case of an official protest, a non-refundable 100 euro fee shall be paid.

All fees must be paid in EUROS in cash.

Daedo International Generation 2, with electronic headgear will be provided by the OC.

Dobok and protective equipment

Athletes can only use WT recognized products while participating at the event. See a list of recognized products at: http://www.worldtaekwondo.org/wtf-partners/recognized/

Only WT-recognized Equipment is allowed. Groin, Forearm, Shin guards, Mouthpiece (only white or transparent), Gloves and Daedo sensor socks are compulsory and must be brought by the contestants.

Daedo Sensor socks will NOT be on sell at the sport hall.

FIELD OF PLAY REGULATIONS

By accepting an accreditation card, all accredited persons agree to comply with the Field of Play regulations applicable at Taekwondo events. Only the competitors and their coaches will have admittance with valid accreditations to the contest areas.

ACCREDITATION CARD DISTRIBUTION

Registered teams only receive the athlete and official's accreditation cards if all financial obligations have been fulfilled. For all registered athletes, the entry fee

must be paid before the accreditation cards will be distributed to the respective team. Accreditation cards are personal and cannot be transferred. Misuse may be sanctioned.

AWARDS

Individual awards

1st place – gold medal and certificate

2nd place – silver medal and certificate

3rd place – bronze medal and certificate

3rd place – bronze medal and certificate

Team awards

Best female team award: 1st, 2nd and 3rd place trophies (seniors, juniors, cadets) Best male team award: 1st, 2nd and 3rd place trophies (seniors, juniors, cadets)

ACCOMMODATION & TRANSPORTATION

All teams participating in Ukraine Open Cup shall mandatory book their hotel rooms via Organizing Committee because of Covid-19 pandemic.

For making hotel reservation please fill in the Booking Form and send it back no later than **16 May 2021**.

ANTI-DOPING

Compulsory random doping tests will be conducted among all athletes.

COVID-19 TESTING

Due to the current situation in Europe, and in order to protect all our participants and the safe implementation of the competition, we ask ALL to have a negative PCR test upon arrival not older than 72hrs. Participants that fail to present a negative PCR test will not be allowed access until they are tested.

Participants are NOT allowed to exit or leave the event premises until they complete their play or duties and they depart. Participants that exit or leave the quarantined premises before their departure will be automatically disqualified; them and their team in total.

Wearing a protective mask is mandatory at all times for ALL, except the situations during a meal at the hotel, during the warm-up and during the fights.

Everyone who enters the sport hall or hotel with be subject to body temperature check. If the body temperature is above normal or there are other visible symptoms of COVID, the participant will be required to undergo rapid testing at the site provided by the OC, and before receiving a negative test result will be isolated. If the test will be positive, the participation of above athlete will be cancelled.

In case a team representative or official needs to be PCR tested at any time during the competition or before departure, the OC could arrange the tests within 72 hours' notice at: tkdopenua@gmail.com.

INSURANCE

All participating athletes, coaches and team officials shall have mandatory a medical insurance that covers medical care and in case of emergency repatriation to home country. All relevant documents proving that such insurance is present, including insurance policy papers should be taken to the event in case a medical situation occurs.

INDEMNITIES

The respective national taekwondo associations shall be responsible for ensuring that all officials and participants are covered with effective insurance coverage.

The organization and supervisor assume no responsibility for teams, any damages, violence, loses and injuries during the stay in Ukraine.

VISA

All teams who require a visa invitation should send Visa Detail Form to tkdopenua@gmail.com no later than 16 May 2021.
