D. ACCESS TO THE LOCATION OF THE COMPETITION

The competition will take place in Tehran, Iran, which is one hour away from the Imam Khomeini International Airport

- The cost of travel to and from the host country will be the responsibility of the participating missions
- Teams shall arrive to the Imam Khomeini International Airport. By the host site coordinators and be transported to the site of the competition and accommodations

E. CONDITIONS OF STAY

- Women's participation in these competitions will be subject to the laws and regulations of the Islamic Republic of Iran, and it is mandatory for everyone to observe Islamic dress (Sample images are provided at the end of invitation file).
- Board and lodging will be provided for all participants, as well as transport for all CISM related events.
- Participants will be required to pay extra expenses such as telephone calls, laundry, additional food and beverages.
- Nations arriving before 22Th Nov 2022 and departing after 29th Nov 2022 will be responsible for all expenses incurred during the period outside the official competition dates.
- CISM officials such as the Official CISM Representative (OCR), Taekwondo Sports Committee are authorized to arrive before 22Th Nov 2022.

 In accordance with the Statutes and traditions of CISM, any political or and religious action during the competition, in particular the dissemination of propaganda documents, pictures, clothing, brochures, reviews etc, is strictly forbidden. Any contravention will result in immediate exclusion and deportation of such nation.

Additional persons will not be accepted without official written permission of the Organizers.

 Medical support for the duration of the event will be provided by the host, which will cover costs for basic emergency treatment only. In case of additional treatment, hospitalization and routine medical care, participating nations will be responsible for the payment thereof.

F. REGULATIONS OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP

• Rules. The Taekwondo Regulations of CISM (Edition February 2020), in conjunction with the WT Rules, (Best of three System, Amended in 2022) the CISM Regulations (Edition December 2021) as well as local rules as discussed in the Preliminary Meeting will apply throughout. The latest version of the CISM Taekwondo Sport Regulation can be retrieved from: <u>http://www.milsport.one/sports/taekwondo</u>

"Due to requirements of separation of participants by gender, male and female competitions will be hosted in separate venues or date. Men will be prohibited from entry into the female competition venue, and vice versa women will be prohibited from entry into the male competition venue. Therefore, we request participating nations to bring at least one female referee, if possible."

According to the fact that male and female athletes and coaches will not be allowed to go to the each other hotels and competition halls, so bring a female coach for the women's team and a male coach for the men's team. (Therefore, in order to eliminate the possible problems caused by this restriction, it is possible to bring 4 Kyorugi coaches «2 male and 2 female » and 2 Poomsae «1 male and 1 female » coaches).

The latest player rankings in October 2022, announced by WT, will be included in the drawing(Kyorugi).

• Eligibility. All athletes must be military personnel on full active duty in the Armed Forces of their respective nations (art. 7. 23 of the CISM Regulations). Participation of inactive member nations is not authorized (art. 1.10 of the CISM Regulations). All of the participants are asked to present the following documents upon registration:

- a. Military identification card
- b. Kukkiwon Dan Certification
- c. WT Global Athlete License (GAL)
- d. Born 2005 and before (Kyorugi)
- e. Passport

Note:

- 1. Each mission is authorized only ONE athlete per weight class.
- 2. According to the announced age conditions and WT regulations, athletes can participate in both Kyurogi and **Poomsae sections**.

General rules:

Team ranking in the Kyurogi section:

Each participant has one point, each win or break one point, a gold medal 120 points, a silver medal 50 points and a bronze medal 20 points

In the Kyorugi and Poomsae sections, the men's and women's team rankings will be done separately.

In the Poomsae section, participants must wear white or colored clothing of their age group.

Team ranking in the Poomsae section:

Each participant has one point, ascend to the next stage one point, a gold medal 7 points, a silver medal 3 points and a bronze medal 1 points.

Team rankings in Poomsae :

Includes the total points of individual standard Poomsae, team standard Poomsae and innovative Poomsae

It is mandatory for all athletes to bring standard safety equipment.

Electronic Standard Safety Equipment such as Hugo, hats and socks will be used from the brand of ESTA Electronic.

The electronic socks prepared by the organizing committee will be provided to the teams as a **fiduciary**. If teams want to buy, the price per pair is \$ 20.

In addition to the standard compitition clothes, women are also required to wear a veil. (See the photos at the end of this invitation)

Medals and certificates will be awarded to participants if they are less than 4 nations in each age group of **Poomsae** or **Kyorugi** weights, but will not be calculated in the team ranking.

- One day before the competition the Taegeuk/Poomsae will be selected during the Drawing of Lots Meeting.
- For each round: 2"Taeguek/Poomsae" with 30 second pause. For each Taegeuk/Poomsae 2 points will be given (each Taegeuk/Poomsae is judged separately) and the points will be announced immediately after the Taegeuk/Poomsae).

WT Free Style Poomsae for 18-30 year old: The Free Style competition will be started Below an overview of the rules which should be followed:

(1) Composition of Free style Poomsae:

a. Music & choreography shall be the choice of the contestant. However, it should not contain any political, social and religious contents.

b. You may only bring the USB stick and then report to head of the table before the start competition (Apple audio format is not supported)

c. Performed techniques must be within the boundaries of Taekwondo.

(2) Division(Recognized or Free Style Poomsae)

a. Recognized Poomsae- Individual: Male or Female (age 18-30 years old) (1992-2004)

- b. Recognized Poomsae- Individual: Male or Female (age 31 under 40 years old) (1991-1982)
- c. Recognized Poomsae- Team: 3 Male or 3 Female (age 18 30 years old) (1992–2004)
- d. Free Style Poomsae- Individual: (age 18 30 years old) (1992–2004)

Note:

- + The competition in the men's and women's sections will be held in two separate dates.
- Competitions in team divisions will not be a combination of men and women.(PCSC officially concurs with elimination of Pairs for Poomsae)
- 4 In this event, pair competitions will not be held in the Poomsae section.
- Duration of Contest: Individual and Team competition from 60 seconds to 70 seconds. (less than 60 or more than 70 seconds: -0, 1 deduction for 71–75 seconds and -0, 2 deduction for 76–80 seconds).
- Scoring Criteria:
- a. Scoring shall be made in accordance with the rules of the WT.
- b. The types of foot techniques designated are as follows in sequence:

i. Heights of jump: jumping side-kick (in case of team division, entire team members must perform this technique).

ii. Number of kicks in a jump: jumping front-kick (at least one member of the team must perform this technique).

iii. Gradient of spins in a spin kick: spinning hook-kick or turning kick (at least one member of the team must perform this technique).

iv. Performance level of consecutive kicks – kyorugi style kick shall be limited to five (5) (at least one member of the team must perform this technique) *3–5 bouncing steps in a spot is mandatory before execute the kyorugi style kicks.

v. Acrobatic actions: Based on the technical difficulty of all acrobatic actions (with taekwondo kick) performed in gymnastics.(at least one member of the team must perform this technique).

- c. Each foot technique shall be less than 3 step run-up.(exceeded each step run-up -0, 1 deduction point)
- d. One of the following stances must be included in the performance at least once:
- Dwitkubi (Backward inflection stance)
- 🖊 Beom-sogi(Tiger stance)
- ♣ Hakdari-sogi(Crane stance)
- ✤ WT Method of competition Attention: edition February 2020
- Single Elimination Tournament System for individual (U30 and U40).
- Cut off system for teams for all age divisions + for Freestyle.
- Combi-system (=cut off system in the preliminaries and semi-finals single elimination tournament system in the finals) for individual competition all age categories, except (U30 and U40).

- a) Poomsae Divisions will consist of WT and Free Style.
- b) Uniform for Poomsae Competition is the WT Regulations Poomsae Uniform.
- c) Scoring will be done in accordance with WT Poomsae guidelines using Computer Scoring system.
- d) Each player can participate, maximum in two positions.
- e) Poomsae Awards:
- WT Poomsae Individual: 1 gold, 1 silver, 2 bronze awarded in the male and one female categories.
 Each medal counts toward team standings in Poomsae.
- WT Team Poomsae: Maximum of 3 gold, 3 silver, 6 bronze awarded in the male and one female Team categories. One medal per country will count toward overall Poomsae standings.
- Free Style Poomsae Individual: 1 gold, 1 silver, 2 bronze awarded in the male and one female categories.
- Recognized Poomsae Individual: 1 gold, 1 silver, 2 bronze awarded in the male and one female categories.
- Poomsae medals awarded will determine the Individual and Team, Poomsae medalists and, except as noted above, the final Poomsae Team Standings ONLY.
- They will not count toward Kyorugi team standings.

G. Anti-doping

- Anti-Doping tests will be conducted in accordance with the CISM Regulations, (Uploaded on 17/06/2020) Chapter IX, CISM Anti-Doping Rules, the concerned CISM Sports Regulations, the concerned International Federation Rules, and all WADA rules, mainly the World Anti-Doping Code, and the International Standard for Testing.
- The number and type of tests, as well the athletes to be tested shall be determined by the CISM Anti-Doping Commission. These procedures will follow the concerned CISM Test Distribution Plan (TDP).
- In case an athlete has a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE), the Chief of Delegation should send this TUE to the CISM GS until 30 days before the Opening Ceremony. This TUE will be submitted to the TUE Commission to analysis and further approval.

b. Participating Missions are required to bring your nations flag and their respective national anthem in a CD version.

I. CUSTOMS AND VISA PROCEDURES.

It is highly recommended that each participating nation contacts the embassy of I.R Iran in their respective country for specific information regarding to entry procedures and VISA information into the Iran. Failure to do so may cause refused entry into I.R Iran.

b. Any special dietary needs should be conveyed in advance in order to ensure that it is catered for.

c. Water bottles are not necessary as the water from taps is safe for consumption.

14. DEADLINES FOR AGREEMENTS.

Please note and comply with the following deadlines:

a. Preliminary agreement of participation. Annex 1 a to be submitted before 1st August 2022.

b. Final agreement of participation Annex 2a, b, c, to be submitted not later than 1st October 2021. Late submissions may result in denied participation.

c. Any nation withdrawing from participation after submitting Annex 2a and Annex b, c and fails to notify the Organizing Committee accordingly will be held responsible for all related costs incurred by the Organizers.

15. COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS AND PREVENTION.

Please note that the World Military Championship will be organized following the World Taekwondo COVID –19 Guidelines, as well as the I.R of Iran regulations from the Iran health authorities. The following guidelines have been issued by CISM Iran using the collective feedback of different stakeholders in the all sport and have been reviewed by the World Taekwondo Technical Committee. The guidelines will be updated continuously according to the latest information from the World Health Organization and the research/ publications that are released on this topic. The event will look different from what we are all used to. Some of the measures will have an impact on how the event looks like. Here are the measures that will be in affect:

- Pre-travel Health Checks for all personal Staff will be held to ensure exclusion of those with potential additional risks.
- PCR test (72h) and vaccination certificate could be requested by regional authorities on the arrival to Iran. A Pre-event medical Test (Antigen) for COVID 19 will be mandatory. It will be done by CISM Iran medical service. In case a positive Test, the athlete will not be allowed to participate in WMC.
- Temperature checks will be required to access the venue and access will not be allowed to anyone with high temperature, or symptoms of COVID.
- Face mask is mandatory in enclosed areas.
- Due to COVID restrictions, Opening and Closing Ceremonies may be reduced to the minimum required national representatives.

In case of symptoms suggestive of acute respiratory illness before, during or after travel, the athletes are encouraged to seek medical attention and share travel history with CISM Iran.

Individual Responsibility:

- Participants should aim to keep at least two meters distance from other people.
- Frequent hand washing by participants using soap and hot water or alcohol-based (at least 65–70%) hand rub for 20 seconds.
- Avoid shaking hands or hugging.
- Avoid steam rooms or sauna.
- Athletes competing in a Taekwondo event must monitor their health status continuously (including taking their temperature and monitoring for any symptoms) from 14 days before and during the event.

ANNEX c

FINAL ENTRY - COMMITMENT BY THE CHIEF OF MISSION

NATION:

The undersigned, Chief of Mission declare that he has read the CISM Regulations and moreover understood the following prescriptions:

Article 7.21. PARTICIPATION - MILITARY STATUS

A. Only military personnel on active duty in Armed Forces may take part in competitions organized by CISM.

B. No one may be recalled to active duty in the Armed Forces for the purpose of participating in a CISM competition. In the case of an intermittent military service, the athletes regularly recalled may not take part in CISM competitions, under any circumstances, if more than 18 months have elapsed between this recall and the end of their last call to arms.

C. Exceptions to the above may be authorized by the General Assembly, upon recommendation of the Board of Directors.

D. All military participants in a CISM event shall be in possession of proper documentation which signifies active military service of the member nation he represents. The documentation can be:

1. A valid military identity card for those athletes who are authorized to present their military identity cards abroad,

2. A form of verification (in English and/or French) of military status accompanied by a passport.

E. By signing the final entry, the Chief of Delegation confirms the military status of the participating athletes. If there are last minute changes in the participation of the athletes, the verification file may be signed by the Chief of Mission, but shall be confirmed by the Chief of Delegation by official letter.

F. If one of these documents is not available, participation is refused.

Article 7.30. CHIEF OF MISSION

A. Chief of Mission

1. Chiefs of Mission shall be familiar with CISM regulations.

2. Missions must not only participate or be present at sports events, they are also required to participate in information conferences on CISM, study days, commemorative and cultural events and ceremonies organized by the host nation.

B. Conduct of a mission

1. The Chief of Mission is responsible for the behavior of his team in sports and general discipline. He shall ensure that members of his mission respect the rules and directives prescribed by CISM and organizers of the championship. The respect of schedules is particularly important as they form the basis for the effective conduct of competitions and ceremonies. Instances of indiscipline or poor sportsmanship will be handled by Championship officials and may result in the disqualification of individual athletes or teams.

2. The Chief of Mission shall also enforce the rules concerning behavior and dress during the ceremonies. He plays an important role in promoting the CISM spirit among his mission, a spirit represented by friendly attitude towards other missions, courtesy towards organizers and fair-play in competition. The mission, who does not wear military uniforms during the opening ceremony of a Championship, will not be authorised to take part in the Championship. The Official CISM Representative will communicate this decision.

Article 8.6. ABSENCE OF A MISSION WITHOUT NOTIFICATION

Sal)

If a mission which submits a preliminary agreement and/or final entry is absent without notifying the host nation in time, a sanction will be imposed (Regulations Art. 1.12).

Article 8.17. RULES OF STAY

A. General

1. The Chiefs of Mission are responsible for the discipline of their mission. The missions fall under the jurisdiction of the organizing nation. During events, all athletes present on the playing fields are equal before the jury, the referees and to themselves. No one may use his rank to impose his views on sports matters.

2. Civilian members of the missions shall conform to the discipline accepted by all other participants.

B. Military uniforms

1. Unless otherwise approved by the Official CISM Representative, all participants shall wear military uniform during official ceremonies such as the opening and closing ceremonies and medal-awarding ceremonies. Individuals without proper uniform will not be allowed to participate in the championship.

2. The presentation of medals takes place, in principle, during the closing ceremony. The presentation of medals may be done in sports uniform, if for organizational reasons it is not possible to wear military uniforms. This is the case e.g. when the presentation immediately follows a championship sports event. Sports uniforms shall respect the corresponding national criteria (training suit, sports shoes, etc.) Displaying the national flag on the podium by the recipient (athlete or team) at a medal awarding ceremony is forbidden. Individuals failing to respect these prescriptions shall not receive their medal(s) during the official ceremonies.

C. Forbidden actions

1. In conformity with the statutes and traditions of CISM, any political or religious propaganda during a CISM event, in particular the dissemination of documents, pictures, brochures, reviews, etc. is strictly forbidden.

2. Any contravention shall result in the exclusion of the mission from further competition and may result in additional sanctions (Regulations Art. 1.12).

Article 8.19. ACCOMODATIONS

E. All missions, including those of the host nation, shall be accommodated under the same conditions. If the conditions are in accordance with the CISM norms and standards, the missions are expected to accept the accommodation provided by the organizing nation.


Any mission that does not accept the accommodations provided by the organizing nation and judged as adequate by the Official CISM Representative will not be allowed to participate in the championship. DATE:
