Qualifications

1. Holder of the nationality of the participating team requirements

Please Consider The Following Important Notes

2. A participant must be nominated by the pertinent National Taekwondo Association that is recognized by the World Taekwondo and by their National Olympic Committee.

3. Holder of Kukkiwon Dan Certificate for senior athletes.

4. Holder of the WT Global Athlete License (GAL)

*All Athletes, Officials and Coaches participating in a WT G Ranked Recognized Tournament must hold <u>a</u> valid 2023 WT Global License to be able to participate in the 12th Asian Club Championships.

* Coaches must be at least 18 years old and holder of Level I WT Coach license.

5. An athlete must be born in 2006 or before to be eligible for participation in senior division. All competitors must prove their age by presenting their passport or identification card at the official weigh-in.

Athletes born in 2006, 2007 and 2008 can participate in junior division.

Athletes born in 2006 can compete as a junior, or as a senior, but competing in both categories is not allowed.



Each team can send male and female athletes to compete Provisions in senior weight divisions but Just Male athletes in junior weight divisions. One athlete cannot participate in more than one (1) weight category or age division.

Teams cannot have foreign athletes from other nationality.

Each country can have more than 1 athlete in each weight category.

6. Coaches must be at least 18 years old and holder of Level I WT Coach licence.

Competition Rules

Classification of competition

Latest WT Competition Rules.

System of competition

Single elimination tournament system. Best of 3 system.

* Senior: 2 minutes x 3 rounds with 1 minute break between each round.

Junior: 3 round of 1 minute 30 seconds with 1 minute break between each round.

The WT Technical Delegate has the authority to adjust the contest time as he sees fit.

Seeding:

Seeding will be made in accordance with WT Taekwondo World Ranking list January 2023 (published in Feb 2023).

(Senior athletes with ranking up to 150 will be seeded).

Awards

The top four (4) male and female athletes will be awarded. 1st place – gold medal and certificate 2nd place – silver medal and certificate Two 3rd places - bronze medal and certificate (Medal winners are not allowed to wear slippers at the medal awarding.) Team Awards: Trophies will be awarded to the top 4 teams for the event. *(Senior Female team, Senior Male team,) Best Referees: Three (3) trophies will be awarded to the best referees. Best Coaches: One (1) trophy will be awarded to the best coach. Best Athletes: One (1) trophy will be awarded to the best male and female athletes. Head of team: One (1) trophy will be awarded to the best head of team. Fair cup: One (1) trophy will be awarded to the best team. All trophies will be awarded to male and female separately.

Sport entry

Team entries will only be accepted through the WT online registration system and registration is only possible with a WT Global License.

Protector & Scoring System

PSS KPNP will be used. The Organizing Committee will provide KPNP trunk protector and KPNP E-headgear. Each athlete has to bring his own KPNP sensor socks.

Groin/Forearm/shin guards and gloves are compulsory and must be brought by the contestants. Mouth piece is compulsory! (Only white or transparent).

Recognized brands

Participating contestants are required to wear WT recognized Doboks and WT-recognized protective equipment. The latest version of WT-recognized manufacturers' list is available at the website of WT: http://www.worldtaekwondofederation.net/recognized



Random weigh- in

The random weigh-in will take place at the competition venue. All contestants must be present for the random weigh-in.

Should a contestant fail to appear for the random weighin, he/she will be disqualified. 20% of the number of athletes for each category shall be randomly selected for the weigh-in. The random weigh-in shall be conducted with +5% of the contestant's weight category.

Anti-doping regulations

The WT Anti-Doping Rules, and where necessary the Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, shall apply throughout the competitions. Compulsory anti-doping tests will be carried out for all finalists, while random tests will be conducted among the quarter- and semi-finalists who failed to advance to the (semi-)final. The WT and/or WADA may carry out random out-of-competition testing prior to the 33rd Fajr Open. Therefore, all participating contestants are required to submit their latest and most accurate Athlete Location (Whereabouts Info) Forms to the WT.

TUE

Athletes who take any substance or medicine listed in the "Prohibited List" of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and WADA Anti-Doping Code for therapeutic purposes are requested to submit TUE applications via ADAMS, together with the required medical information. Otherwise, please

It is the responsibility of each registering team to ensure that their athletes and team officials have filled out the indemnification forms correctly and have duly signed them, thereby indemnifying WT, ATU, the Organizing Committee and all other officials and athletes from any claims of injuries, losses or otherwise arising in the course of participation at the 33rd Fajr Open or any activities linked therewith. It is the responsibility of each registered team to ensure and guarantee that sufficient insurance coverage has been arranged for all athletes, team officials and other participants. Without sufficient insurance coverage, national teams will not be allowed to compete.
