Olympic Park, Rio de Janeiro, March 24 – 26, 2023

PARTICIPANT REQUIREMENTS:

1. The athlete must have the nationality of the country he represents.
2. The athlete must have the endorsement of the National Federation
3. The athlete must have the WT 2023 Global Athlete License (GAL)
4. The trainer must be a WT Level 1 trainer certificate.

AFFILIATES:

All participating athletes must have citizenship of the country they represent and must carry the letter of endorsement from the federation they represent.

AGE CATEGORIES:

1. Cadets (12-14 years old) 2011-2010-2009
2. Junior (15 -17 years old) 2008-2007-2006
3. Senior (17 years and older) 2006

COMPETITION TIME AND FORMAT:

Best of 3 formats. 2-minute rounds

U30-U40 Single elimination. Freestyle and other divisions, cut-off system.

The WT Technical Delegate has the authority to adjust the timing of the bout as he sees fit.

ELIGIBILITY:

The requirements are:

1. Be at least 21 years old.
2. Have a WT, Global Athlete License 2023 (GAL).
3. Coaches must take the WT Coach certification course.
4. Payment of registration fees

TRAINER'S OUTFIT:

The use of a formal suit is mandatory in the semi-finals and finals.

COMPETITION GEAR:

The Organizing Committee will provide protective equipment (electronic chest protector and helmet).

Athlete must wear their own electronic socks to compete, and athletes are responsible for using shin and forearm protection to compete.

All competitors must enter the competition area in WT-approved combat equipment and uniforms. Groin, shin and forearm protectors must be worn inside the uniform.

Non-religious items are not allowed on the head; however, they must be previously reviewed and approved and used inside the helmet and uniform.

Likewise, it must not cause injury or obstruct the opponent's actions.

**PSS DAEDO:**

PSS Daedo systems will be used for all black belt categories.

OFFICIAL UNIFORMS:

All athletes must wear white uniforms with a black collar and belt. Those under 15 years of age must wear a white uniform with a red and black collar and a red and black band or a white uniform with a black collar and black band.

Uniforms must be in good condition. Logos, country, or team name will be allowed per WT uniform rules. Only brands homologated by WT will be allowed.

Poomsae: The uniform for the Poomsae modality must be of competition type "Y" collar according to the athlete's category.

PAN AM SERIES WILDCARDS:

All winners from all divisions and categories will receive a wildcard for the next Pan-American championships. Wildcards can be dragged only through the same category. If not, they disappear. Wildcards cannot be transferred. Only if the winning athlete belongs to PATU region, the wildcard remains.

Pan Am Series being a tournament eligible for international ranking points as follows:

Senior – Kyorugui – G1 WT World Ranking

Junior – Kyorugui – P4 Panamerican Ranking

Cadet – Kyorugui – P4 Panamerican Ranking

At this point Pan-American ranking is only available for Kyorugui divisions.

REFEREES:

1. The Pan American Taekwondo Union (PATU) will appoint the necessary referees for the Series Pan Am II.
2. Each international arbitrator (IR) must cover his/her airline ticket.
3. The OC will cover 4 nights, PAN AM SERIES, accommodation, food, and transportation
4. The OC will pay US\$100 per day for 3 days of competition.

WEIGHING:

- I. Athletes must be weighed the day before the competition.
(Arena Carioca 2), Olympic Park, Rio de Janeiro.
- II. During the weigh-in, the male contestant must wear underwear, and the female contestant must wear underwear and a bra. However, SENIOR players cannot wear these clothes to the weigh-in.
- III. Cadets and juniors must weigh themselves in underwear, and 100 grams will be allowed to compensate.
- IV. Under no circumstances may underage athletes weigh in fully nude.

MEDICAL SERVICE:

1. The CO will only provide medical services in emergency situations where a participant is injured.
2. Participants will be responsible for all injuries and/or hospitalization expenses.
3. The CO recommends that the participant has health insurance and has the documents at hand.

VISA INFORMATION:

All participants will be responsible for obtaining a visa to enter the country. The invitation letter will be available upon written request to suporte.internacional@cbtkd.org.br until February 28, 2023.

METHOD OF PAYMENT:

Payment of participants will be made in cash only (dollar) upon registration.
Entries registration will be made on the WT website.

1. All athletes will receive a Certificate of Participation.

 - Best male and female athlete in Poomsae.
 - Best male and female poomsae trainer.

 - Best male and female athlete in Kyrougi.
 - Best male and female trainer Kyrougi.
 - To Kyrougi's 1st, 2nd and 3rd overall.

The Medical Diagnosis Form (MDF) must be completed in English by the athlete's physician or physical therapist. The completed form must be submitted by the end of the application before the athlete is submitted for athlete evaluation. This applies to all physically challenged athletes competing in the WT.

Depending on the athlete's health condition and disability, additional medical information must be attached to this form (see page 2). See WT Classification rules for a list of eligible disabilities and underlying health conditions for Kyorugi.

NOTE – Failure to submit the MDF and medical information may result in your athlete not being able to be classified and receiving a “Classification Not Complete”, “CNC”.
The athlete will then not be able to compete in the event.

The athlete must be wearing athletic (training) clothing. The athlete also needs to bring his uniform (dobok) and all personal protective equipment. The athlete must also bring any medical information relevant to classification.

Teams must have a translator who understands English well.

The athlete must always do his best in the tests and exercises requested by the International Classifiers. More information can be found in the World Para Taekwondo Athlete Classification
