APPLICATION & ENTRY FEE

The payment & registration deadline for this event is 12pm Friday 9th June 2023. After this time, the entry portal will close and we will not be able to accept any further registrations.

Standard Entry Fee	€130 euro
Late entry (31st May - 9th June)	€150 euro

Please note we will not accept entry fee payment on arrival. If payment is not made through the payment portal by 9th June 2023 you will be removed from the competition.

The entry fee is payable in euros only via payment link upon entry to this event. Proof of entry fee payment must be attached to your entry form.

If an athlete registered online (https://worldtkd.simplycompete.com) does not withdraw from the competition and/or pay the entry fee in full before the deadline (9th June 2023), they will not receive a refund.

All onsite payments must be made in GBP by card payment ONLY, we will not accept euros, other currencies or cash payments.

REGISTRATION & ACCREDITATION

Registration opening times

All participants and team members must register at the National Cycling Centre. Registration will be open from 11am until 8pm on Friday 30th June 2023. For any international teams arriving on Thursday 29th June, registration will be open until 8pm on Thursday at the hotel (Radisson Park Inn). It is recommended that team coach collects accreditations from the registration desk on behalf of their competing participants.





COMPETITION RULES & PROCEDURES

Coaches can only register/request accreditation as part of a club team.

Please note that for every 4 competitors - 1 coach pass is allocated free of charge. Extra coach passes can be requested separately for £30.00 for each individual coach. Coaches need to have a valid WT coach licence.

Please note that only 1 competitor and 1 coach can enter the field of play for matches and warm up.

ELIGIBILITY

Participant Eligibility:

- **1.** All athletes must hold a valid 2023 Global Athlete License.
- **2.** Participants must be a member of a team or club of pertinent national association recognised by World Taekwondo.
- All Senior division participants must be born in 2006 or before. All Junior division participants must be born in 2006, 2007 or 2008. All Cadet division participants must be born in 2009, 2010 or 2011. Proof of age must be shown at registration and weigh in by producing.

a passport or recognised ID card.

- **4.** If a participant is under 18, written consent must be submitted upon entry to the competition, signed by a parent or legal guardian.
- **5.** All participants must be 2nd Kup and above.

Coach Eligibility:

- **1.** Must be a minimum of 18 years old.
- **2.** All coaches must hold a valid 2023 World Taekwondo Global Official Licence.
- **3.** Coaches are not permitted to wear Doboks.
- **4.** For every 5 paying athletes within the same team, one (1) coach is granted free admission, to a maximum of 3 free coach accreditations. Additional coach accreditations can be purchased at the competition for £25.00.

MATCH INFORMATION

- Single elimination tournament system and best of three system.
- The Organising Committee will provide Protector and Scoring System (PSS) and the head protector to the participating contestants. Participating contestants are required to bring their own groin guards, mouthpieces, gloves, sensing socks and shin and forearm guards for their personal use.
- Before entering the field of play, all contestants will proceed to the inspection desk for inspection of their doboks and protective equipment. Any contestant who wears unofficial doboks or protective equipment will not be permitted to compete.

PROTEST PROCEDURE

Only an official team coach is allowed to protest to the LOC, immediately after the end of the contest. Each protest costs £200.00. The protest fee is non refundable.

WEIGHT DIVISIONS, CATEGORIES & AWARDS

WEIGHT CATEGORIES:

SENIORS: born in 2006 and before. Seniors athletes must hold at least a 2nd Kup.

Juniors: born in 2006 can compete as a junior or as a senior. Competing in both categories is not allowed. Athletes can compete in one category only.

Senior Female: -46kg, -49kg, -53kg, -57kg, -62kg, -67kg, -73kg, +73kg **Senior Male:** -54kg, -58kg, -63kg, -68kg, -74kg, -80kg, -87kg, +87kg

JUNIORS: born in 2006, 2007 or 2008. Minimum grade 2nd Kup. Juniors born in 2006 may compete as a junior or a senior. Competing in both categories is not allowed.

Junior Female: -42kg, -44kg, -46kg, -49kg, -52kg, -55kg, -59kg, -63kg, -68kg, +68kg Junior Male: -45kg, -48kg, -51kg, -55kg, -59kg, -63kg, -68kg, -73kg, -78kg, +78kg

CADETS: born in 2009, 2010 or 2011. Minimum grade 2nd Kup.

Cadet Female: -29kg, -33kg, -37kg, -41kg, -44kg, -47kg, -51kg, -55kg, -59kg, +59kg **Cadet Male:** -33kg, -37kg, -41kg, -45kg, -49kg, -53kg, -57kg, -61kg, -65kg, +65kg

WEIGH-IN:

General weigh in for Saturday and Sunday groups will take place at the competition venue on Friday 30th June 2023 11am-8pm.

General weigh in for Sunday groups ONLY will take place at the competition venue on Saturday 1st July 11am-3pm.

RANDOM WEIGH-IN:

Random weigh-in will be conducted the morning of each competition day for each category.

Random weigh-in will take place at the competition venue at 8am each morning.

The number of participants allocated for random weigh in will be as shown in the table below. A 5% allowance will be given for each weight division except '+' categories.
