1. DATE

A. Recognized Poomsae: August 8 (Tue) (1 day) 09:00 ~ 12:00

B. Free Style Poomsae: August 8 (Tue) (1 day) 13:00 ~ 18:00

2. QUALIFICATIONS

- A. (COMMON) Holder of Taekwondo Dan certificate issued by the Kukkiwon.
- B. Recognized Poomsae: Competitor who participates in the **individual categories**UNDER 30 (Senior I) and UNDER 40 (Senior II) should be registered on the
 GMS(Global Membership System).
- C. Free Style Poomsae : Competitor who participates in the Individual, Pair and Mixed Team divisions of OVER 17(18 years old or older) should be registered on the GMS(Global Memberships System)

3. COMPETITIONS (Men's & Women's)

- ** (COMMON) Ages of Competitors are based on the year of the Championships, not the date of the pertinent competition.
- A. Recognized Poomsae(Senior)
- 1) Senior I: Born between Jan. 1 1993 ~ Dec. 31 2005 (18 ~ 30 years old)
- 2) Senior II: Born between Jan. 1 1983 ~ Dec. 31 1992 (31 ~ 40 years old)
- B. Free Style Poomsae: Born in 2005 or before (18 years old or older)

4. DURATION OF COMPETITION:

A. Recognized Poomsae: up to 90 seconds

B. Free Style Poomsae: 90 seconds to 100 seconds

* Break time: within 30sec to 60sec / Exceeding the time, deduction shall be applied.

5. DETAILS OF EACH COMPETITIONS

A. Recognized Poomsae(G2) *The age limits for each category are based on the year of competition.

1) METHODS OF COMPETITION

- Individual event Competitors for Recognized Poomsae of Senior I and Senior II shall be awarded 20 WT ranking points(G2) for gold medal.
- Single elimination tournament System shall be applied to the Recognized Poomsae Competition.
- In case of an insufficient number of Competitors in each category, a demonstration shall be carried out.
- Competitors should be wearing WT-recognized Poomsae uniform(Dobok).
- 2) The competition area for Recognized Poomsae: 10m×10m

3) Scoring of Recognized Poomsae

- Poomsae(Individual)
- · Composition of refereeing official shall be a five-judge system.
- · Final score shall be the average point of the total points summed up except the highest and lowest points scored by 5judges
- · In case of a tied score, the winner shall be the one who has scored higher points in order of Presentation, and total points(total points of all judges including highest and lowest points).
- · If it is still tied in Presentation, and total points, then a rematch shall be conducted to determine the winner
- · In case of a tied score after the rematch, the winner shall be the contestant who is awarded more points in total, including the highest and lowest scores that were not included in collection of scores.
- 4) Designation of Recognized Poomsae and the drawing of lots
- Two (2) Poomsae from the designated Compulsory Poomsae decided by Technical Delegate for each division must be performed for all the preliminary, semi final and final rounds for all competitions.

1) METHODS OF COMPETITION

- Cut-off System shall be applied to the Free Style Poomsae Competition.
- Free Style Poomsae is the performance based on Taekwondo techniques with composition of music and choreography.
- Composition of Free Style Poomsae
- · Yeon-mu line shall choice of contestant
- · Performed techniques must be within boundary of Taekwondo. The definition of Taekwondo techniques shall be determined by WT Poomsae Committee, when contestant submits performance plan.
- · Music and choreography shall be the choice of contestants
- Competitors should be wearing WT-recognized Poomsae uniform(Dobok).
- ** Music in USB (sound without words) should NOT contain any political, social and religious and any contents that may harm, discriminate or offend others.
- 2) The competition area for Free Style Poomsae
- Individual/Pair 10m × 10m
- Mixed Team 12m x 12m
- 3) Scoring of Free Style Poomsae
- Allotted Scoring Chart for Free Style Poomsae: WT Poomsae scoring criteria and procedures shall be applied.
- * All music should be submitted in USB (CD is not acceptable) and will be returned.
- To the Competition Headquarters by August 7th, 16:00

6. OTHERS

- A. The above is subject to change in the Head of Team meeting.
- B. All officials including Head and coaches of each team must complete the registration as officials and hold an AD card to enter the stadium.
- C. If the competitor is called 3 times 30 minutes before the start of the game and do not participate after declaring the participation, the competitor will be disqualified.

1. DATE (2days)

A. Senior: August 11 (Fri) 09:00 ~ 18:00 August 12 (Sat) 09:00 ~ 18:00

2. COMPETITIONS (Men's & Women's)

- Born in 2006 or before (17 years and over) / 8 weight categories
- For Korean: The maximum entry of 8 males and 8 female competitors, one per weight category.
- However, all competitors with WT ranking points are allowed to participate in pertinent weight.

3. QUALIFICATIONS

- A. Holder of Taekwondo Dan(Poom) certificate issued by the Kukkiwon.
- B. Competitors who registered on the GMS(Global Membership System).

5. METHODS OF COMPETITION

- Men's / Women's : (Respectively) Single elimination tournament system for each weight category

6. COMPETITION RULES

- A. Competitions shall abide by the WT Competition Rules & Interpretation in force as of January 27, 2023.
- B. The best of three (3) system shall be applied.
- C. All competitors must wear WT-approved competition uniform and protective equipment.
- D. Protector and Scoring System (PSS, TBD) will be used in Kyorugi competition. The OC will provide trunk PSS, head PSS and related items and equipment to the participating contestants. And All competitors should bring their own Safety Equipment. (Groin Guard, Forearm Guard, Sensing Socks, Gloves, Mouthpiece, etc.)
- * The PSS will be informed later.

7. DURATION OF COMPETITION

- Senior: 2 minutes x 3 rounds

8. WEIGH-IN

- A. Weigh-in of the Competitors shall be completed on the previous day of the pertinent competition.
- B. During weigh-in the Male contestant shall wear underpants and the female contestant shall wear underpants and a brassiere. However, weigh-in may be conducted in the nude if the contestant wishes to do so.
- C. Weigh-in shall be made once, however, in case of under or exceeding, one more chance will be given within the weigh-in time.
- D. All contestants should bring their AD cards when they weigh-in, otherwise disgualification.
- E. The random weigh-in will take place at the venue in the morning of the competition. All contestants who pass the general weigh-in must be present for random weigh-in maximum two (2) hours before the start of the competition. Should a contestant fail to appear for the random weigh-in, he/she will be disqualified. The random weigh-in must be completed maximum thirty (30) minutes before the start of the competition each day.

9. OTHERS

- A. The above is subject to change in the Head of Team meeting.
- B. All officials including Head and coaches of each team must complete the registration as officials and hold an AD card to enter the stadium. And must have completed WT Coach Certification Course LV1.
- C. If the competitor is called 3 times 30 minutes before the start of the game and do not participate after declaring the participation, the competitor will be disqualified.
- D. Matters not specified in the regulation shall be decided after deliberation by the Organizing Committee of CHUNCHEON KOREA OPEN.

INTERNATIONAL REFEREES

- 1. The required number of International Referees shall be determined in accordance with the WT Rules.
- 2. Round trip airfare shall be the responsibility of each participating International Referee, while the Organizing Committee will cover accommodation of room and board from August 6-15.
- 3. The Organizing Committee will pay a per diem of US \$150 to participating referees for each competition day from August 8-14.

- W During the correction period, you must check the omission of participating players, participating divisions, weight categories, payment matters, etc. Any corrections can not be made after the correction period, and responsibility for all matters caused by not checking lies on the relevant team, not the Organizing Committee.

- W Organizing Committee will review the registration status on July 15-18, and athletes/teams whose payment was not made during the registration period can make payment in this given period.
- No Payment will be accepted after July 18, the rule applies to every athlete/team without exception.
- No refund will be issued after July 18 and any addition/change of athletes and/or teams by any means, regardless of any reason

1. AWARD PRESENTATION: The top three competitors in each division per competition.

2. INDEMNITY

- A. Organizing Committee effects accident insurance for all competitors during the competition only.
- B. Only first-aid treatment is available for wounds from the competition.

3. PARTICIPATION SUPPORT

- A. Only the teams that apply for 7 or more days of on-site training in Chuncheon before or after the Championships period shall be provided with training facilities and assistance.
- B. GROUND TRANSPORTATION: The O.C. will provide ground transportation between Incheon airport and Chuncheon.
- Arrival: August 6 (Sun) ~ 9 (Wed), 2023 (3 days)
- Departure: August 14 (Mon) ~ 15 (Tue), 2023 (2 days)
- The O.C. will also provide shuttle bus between accommodations and venue during the Championships.
- * Except for those who participating through other travel agencies or regions.
- ** All officials and competitors should inform the O.C. of their flight schedule by July 21st(Fri) at the latest.

4. NOTICE

- A. All competitors must wear WT approved Taekwondo equipment.
- B. All the registration process including the payment of entry fees must be completed before the competition by July 17, 2023 17:00 (Korean Standard Time)
- C. For matters not specified in the regulation, all participants should follow the decision of Organizing Committee of CHUNCHEON KOREA OPEN
- D. Round trip airfare and accommodation expenses(room and board) shall be the sole responsibility of the participants.
