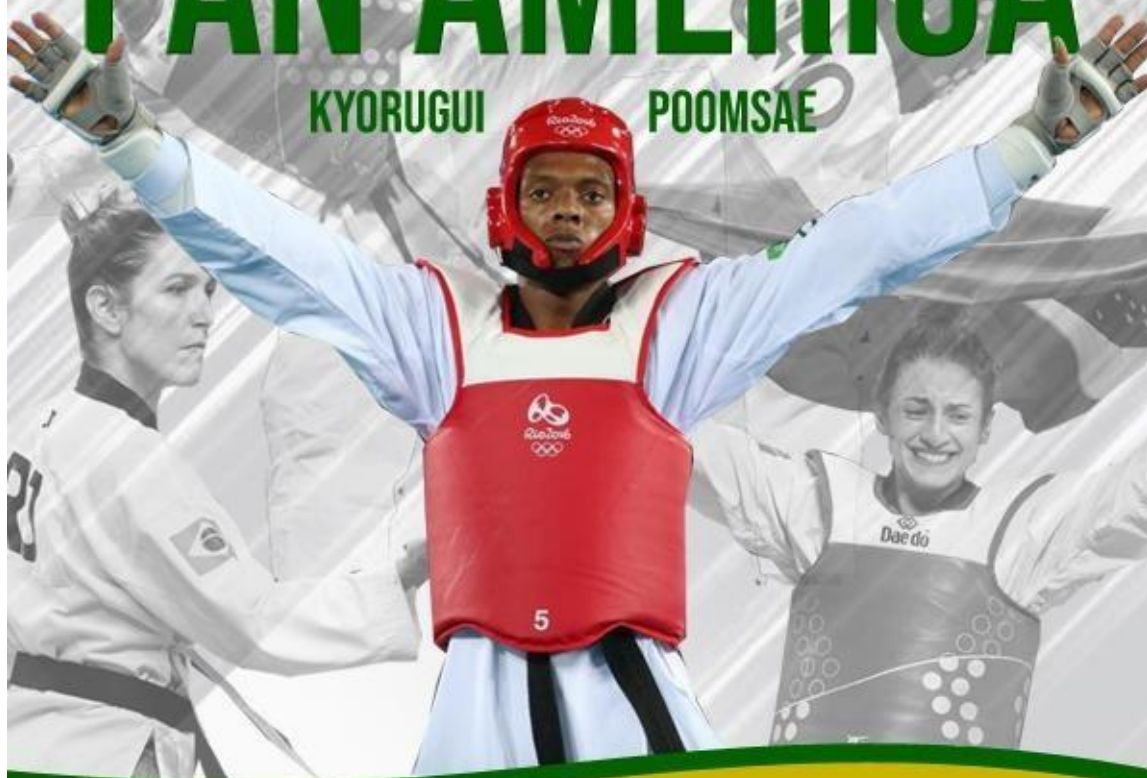

9. Competition Rules:

The latest update of the WT competition rules will be used.

10. Competition Method:

Kyorugi

- Single elimination System, best of 3 rounds;
- There is no limit of entries in each division;
- Times may be adjusted by WT TD (Technical Delegate) ONLY;

Poomsae

- Simple cut and elimination system;
- All Freestyle songs must be submitted before the technical congress;

11. Dispute Time:

Kyorugi

Best of 3 rounds system

Senior (2 minutes x 2 or 3 rounds x 1 minute break)

Junior (2 minutes x 2 or 3 rounds x 1 minute break)

Cadet (1.5 minutes x 2 or 3 rounds x 1 minute break)

Poomsae

Recognized Poomsae: Individual, Pair and Team up to 90 seconds

Freestyle Poomsae: Individual, Doubles and Mixed Team competitions last from 90 to 100 seconds.

The interval between the 1st and 2nd Poomsae is at least 30 seconds.

14. Conditions for participating teams:

Round-trip airfare, accommodation, food and transportation expenses will be paid by the participant or their respective MNA. Accommodation at the official hotels is not mandatory, there will be no internal shuttle service.

15. WT Global License and Online Registration:

I- WT Global License Registration. All athletes and team officials must first be registered with a WT Global Athlete License (GAL) OR Global Official License (GOL).

II- Online registration in the WT. (Simply Compete)

Registration is only possible with a valid WT Global License.

16. Technician Registration:

I- WT Global License Registration. All athletes and team officials must first be registered with a WT Global Athlete License (GAL) OR Global Official License (GOL).

II- WT Online Registration (Simply Compete)

III- All coaches must be at least 18 years old.

IV- All coaches must have WT Coach Level 1.

17. Registration Fees:

The Organizing Committee must collect the registration fees in dollars at the time of registration at the competition site, no other type of payment will be accepted. The registered athletes and coaches will not be allowed to participate in the competition without payment. The Organizing Committee has a NO REFUND policy under any circumstances.

18. International Referees:

The PATU will appoint a total of 30 International Referees, including the PATU Referee Chairman. The appointed international referees shall officiate at the President's Cup 2023; the following conditions shall apply:

- a. International Referees are required to pay for their own round-trip airfares.
- b. The Organizing Committee will cover the expenses of 5 nights' accommodation and board for the kyorugui and poomsae competition. Check-in: 20/09/2023 - Check-out: 25/09/2023.
- c. The Organizing Committee will pay a per diem of US\$ 150 to the International Referees selected for the competition and training period (total 4 days; US\$ 600 per referee, training day and competition).

19. Technical Delegate and Competition Supervisory Board (CSB):

The WT/PATU will appoint 1 (one) Technical Delegate and up to 3 (three) members of the Competition Supervisory Board (CSB). The following conditions will apply:

- The Organizing Committee will provide accommodation and board and pay a per diem of US\$ 200 to the Technical Delegate for 4 days (US\$ 800) and to the CSB members US\$ 150 for the period of the competition (total 4 days; US\$ 600 per person).

20. Head of Team Meeting (Technical Congress):

The head of team meeting shall be conducted one (1) day prior to the start of the activities of each competition mode. See the general schedule for more details.
