- Holder of the nationality of the participating team requirements.
- The pertinent National Taekwondo Association that is recognized by the World Taekwondo and by their National Olympic Committee must nominate a participant.
- Holder of Taekwondo Dan Certificate issued by Kukkiwon for Seniors. For Juniors from National Black Belts or Kukkiwon Poom and above.
- Holder of the WT Global Athlete License (GAL). All
  Athletes & Officials participating in a WT G Ranked
  Recognized Tournament must hold a valid 2023 WT Global
  License to be able to participate in the 5th WT President's
  Cup- Asian region.

- All competitors must prove their age by presenting their passport or identification card at the official weigh-in.
- Each team can send male and female athletes to compete Provisions in Senior weight divisions. One athlete cannot participate in more than one (1) weight category.
- WT Coach Certificate Level I or above is required Holder of a valid 2023 WT Global Official License
- **6. Method of Competition:** WT Competition Rules & Interpretation (September 1, 2023) Single elimination tournament system / Best of 3 system
- 7. Competition Rules (Classification of Competition):

WT New Competition Rules.









### 8. Wild Cards Qualification:

This is a World Taekwondo G2 ranked tournament offering WILD CARDS to Senior top four ranked winners at the Asian Taekwondo Championships in 2024. (Only 1 athlete per weight category per member national association can qualify for the above-mentioned ATU Championships).

Earned ranking points from President's Cup- Asian Region by Asian athletes only will not be affected by 40 points per year limitation of G1 & G2 tournament

### 9. System of Competition:

Senior divisions: 3 rounds of 2 minutes, 1-minute break between each round.

Junior divisions: 3 rounds of 1 minute 30 seconds, 1-minute break between each round.

The WT Technical Delegate has the authority to adjust the contest time as he sees fit.

The time will be officially decided at the Head of the Team's meeting.

### 10. Seeding:

Seeding will be made in accordance with WT World Ranking list for October 2023 (published in November 2023)

Percentage will be determined by TD during the head of team meeting.

- Holder of a Para Taekwondo Dan issued by the WT/KUKKIWON or a MNA recognized 5-1 Geup.
- Holder of the WT Global Athlete License (GAL). All Athletes & Officials participating in a WT G Ranked Recognized Tournament must hold a valid 2023 WT Global License to be able to participate in the WT President's Cup-Asian region for Para-Taekwondo.
- All athletes must have <u>Eligible Sport Class</u> to compete. At the 5<sup>th</sup> President's Cup-Asian region.









- There is an International Classification by WT Classifiers for athletes who have not been classified yet (New) and review sport class statutes before the Tournament. <u>Athletes found Not Eligible (NE) will not be able to compete</u>
- Contestant shall be at least 16 years old in the year of the 2023. Contestants born in 2007 (January 1<sup>st</sup> 2007- December 31<sup>st</sup> 2007) & before.
- There is No limit in the Number of Participants.

The respective National Taekwondo Associations shall be responsible for ensuring that all officials and participants are covered with effective insurance coverage.

Participants without proper participation entry forms and effective insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete at the championships.

The Organizing Committee will acquire general insurance, at its own expense, for all participants of the tournament, including but not limited to contestants and staff, in the event of any injury and/or damages that may arise during the course of the championship.

### **30. ANTI-DOPING:**

- Use of drugs or any other doping is strictly prohibited.
- The OC would carry out random medical doping tests among the participating athletes.
- Any athletes who refuse to undergo the tests or who are proven to have committed a breach of the regulation, shall be removed from the final standing and shall be subject to disciplinary actions.
- The Anti-Doping Rules of the World Taekwondo and/or the World Anti-Doping Code shall apply.
