Qualifications

1. Holder of the nationality of the participating team requirements

Please Consider the Following Important Notes

- 2. A participant must be nominated by the pertinent National Taekwondo Association that is recognized by the World Taekwondo and by their National Olympic Committee.
- 3. Holder of Kukkiwon Dan Certificate for senior athletes.
- 4. Holder of the WT Global Athlete License (GAL)
- *All Athletes, Officials and Coaches participating in a WT G Ranked Recognized Tournament must hold <u>a valid 2024 WT Global License</u> to be able to participate in the 6th WT President's Cup.
- * Coaches must have Level I WT Coach Certificate or above.
- 5. An athlete must be born in 2007 or before to be eligible for participation in senior division. All competitors must prove their age by presenting their passport or identification card at the official weigh-in.







Each team can send male and female athletes to compete Provisions in senior weight divisions. One athlete cannot participate in more than one (1) weight category or age division.

Teams cannot have foreign athletes from other nationality.

Each country can have more than 1 athlete in each weight category.

Competition Rules

Classification of Competition

Latest WT Competition Rules.

*WILD CARDS QUALIFICATION

All international-level competitions recognized by the WT shall be formed with participation of at least four (4) countries in tournament with no less than four (4) contestants competed in each weight category, and any tournament with less than four (4) countries or weight category with less than 4 competed contestants cannot be recognized in the official results. If a competition is not officially recognized, a Wild Card will not be granted for the next year's ATU tournament.

This is a World Taekwondo G2 ranked tournament offering WILD CARDS to senior top four ranked winners at the Asian Taekwondo Championships in 2025. (Only 1 athlete per weight category per member national association can qualify for the above-mentioned ATU Championships).

Earned ranking points from President's Cup- Asian Region by Asian athletes only will not be affected by 40 points per year limitation of G1 & G2 tournament.







System of Competition

Single elimination tournament system; Best of 3 system

* Senior: 2 minutes x 3 rounds with 1 minute break between each round.

The WT Technical Delegate has the authority to adjust the contest time as he sees fit.

Seeding:

Seeding will be made in accordance with WT Taekwondo World Ranking list January 2024 (published in Feb 2024).

(Percentage will be determined by TD during the head of team meeting.)

Qualifications

- Holder of the nationality of the participating team
- An athlete recommended by a WT recognized Member National Association.
- Holder of a Para Taekwondo Dan issued by the WT/KUKKIWON or a MNA recognized 5-1 Geup.
- Holder of valid WT Global Athlete License (GAL)
 *All Athletes & Officials participating in a WT G
 Ranked Recognized Tournament must hold a valid 2024 WT Global License to be able to participate in the 6th WT President's Cup- Asian region.
- All athletes must have <u>Eligible Sport Class</u> to compete at the 6th President Cup-Asian region;
- There is an International Classification by WT Classifiers for athletes who have not been classified yet (New) and review sport class statutes before the Tournament.

Athletes found Not Eligible (NE) will not be able to compete.

Contestant shall be at least 16 years old in the year of the 2024 World Taekwondo.

Contestants born in 2008 (January 1st 2008- December 31st 2008) & before

There is No limit in the Number of Participants.

Registration and WT Global License

- 1) All Athletes and Team officials must FIRST be registered with a WT Global Athlete License (GAL) or Global Official License (GOL).
- 2) Entry Registration: Entry will only be accepted through the WT online registration system WT GMS.

Competition Rules

Classification of competition Latest version of the WT Para Taekwondo Competition Rules

World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS) is our new online registration for MNAs. MNAs can register their new athletes for classification and add Medical Diagnostic Forms (MDF) and pictures to be seen by our Classification Evaluation Committee to determine if the new athlete is eligible for Para Taekwondo and meets Minimum Impairment Criteria (MIC). All athletes in the WTCS will require a WT License Number (GAL).

^{*}Athletes that have been classified previously can only enter the class where they have been classified.

System of Competition

Single elimination tournament system

The duration of contest shall be one round of five (5) minutes with thirty seconds (30) timeout for each athlete. In the case of a tied score after the completion of the five (5) minute round, round of one (1) minute will be conducted as the Golden round, after a one (1) minute rest period. No timeout can be taken during the Golden Round. Each coach will be allowed to call for one (1) thirty (30) second timeout at any time during the one round contest.

The duration of contest may be adjusted to four (4) minutes or three (3) minutes upon the decision of the Technical Delegate for the pertinent championships.

Seeding

Seeding will be made in accordance with WT Para Taekwondo World Ranking list. (The latest World ranking that will be announced before 6th WT President's Cup Asian Region Para Taekwondo 2024).

Random Weigh -in

The random weigh-in for athletes will take place at the competition venue. All contestants must be present for the random weigh-in. should a contestant fail to appear for the random weigh-in, he will be disqualified. 20% of the number of athletes for each category shall be randomly selected for the weigh-in. The random weigh-in shall be conducted with

+3% of the contestant's weight category.

Protector & Scoring System

PSS KPNP will be used. The Organizing Committee will provide KPNP trunk protector and KPNP E- headgear. Each athlete has to bring his own KPNP sensor socks.

Groin/Forearm/shin guards and gloves are compulsory and must be brought by the contestants. Mouth piece is compulsory! (only white or transparent).







Recognized brands

Participating contestants are required to wear WT recognized Doboks and WT-recognized protective equipment. The latest version of WT-recognized manufacturers' list is available at the website of WT: http://www.worldtaekwondo.org/wtpartners-wt/recognize.html

Random weigh- in

The random weigh-in will take place at the competition venue. All contestants must be present for the random weigh-in.

Should a contestant fail to appear for the random weigh- in, he/she will be disqualified. The rate of selection for the random weigh-in shall be determined by the number of contestants in the weight category as following the criteria and subjects will be randomly selected by computerized system maximum two (2) hours before the start of the competition.

a) More than 32 athletes: 20% of total

b) 17-32 athletes: 6 athletesc) 9-16 athletes: 4 athletesd) 4-8 athletes: 2 athletese) Below 4 athletes: None

The random weigh-in shall be conducted with +5% of the contestant's weight category.

Anti-Doping Regulations

WT Anti-Doping Rules, and where necessary the Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, shall apply throughout the competitions. Compulsory anti-doping tests will be carried out for all finalists, while random tests will be conducted among the quarter- and semi- finalists who failed to advance to the (semi-)final. The WT and/or WADA may carry out random out-of- competition testing prior to the 6th WT President's Cup. Therefore, all participating contestants are required to submit their latest and most accurate Athlete Location Forms (Whereabouts) to the WT.







TUE

Athletes who take any substance or medicine listed in the "Prohibited List" of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and WADA Anti-Doping Code for the rapeutic purposes are requested to submit TUE applications via ADAMS, together with the required medical information. Otherwise, download the TUE Application Form https://ita.sport/TUE), and once duly completed and signed, send it together with the required medical file to tue@ita.sport. Report TUE applications also WT Sport Department antidoping@worldtaekwondo.org by no later than 31 January 2024. International Referees
