#### 6. QUALIFICATIONS

In accordance with *Article 4: Qualification of Contestant* of the WT Competition Rules, the contestant must be:

CRITERION #1: Holder of the nationality of the participating team
CRITERION #2: Holder of the Kukkiwon Poom or Dan Certificate

(\*A copy of the Dan certificate should be uploaded to GMS prior to registration for event. In case a contestant has applied for a Kukkiwon Dan certificate but has not received it yet, a copy of the Dan application form and the remittance certificate sent to the Kukkiwon must be uploaded to GMS prior to registration for event. information.)

CRITERION #3: An athlete must be 17 years old or older in the year of the 7th WT

President's Cup-Asian Region. Athletes who were born in the year of

2008 or before are eligible for participation in the competition.

CRITERION #4: Holder of the WT Global Athlete License (GAL)

#### 7. COMPETITION RULES

The latest published WT Competition Rules & Interpretation shall be applied.

#### 8. METHOD OF COMPETITION

- i. Single elimination system
- ii. Grade: G3
- iii. Seeding and drawing of lots: For every weight category, regardless of number of athletes all the athletes will be seeded based on WT World Ranking of March 2025 (Published in April 2025).
- iv. Wild Cards Qualification: This is a World Taekwondo G3 ranked tournament offering WILD CARDS to Senior top four ranked winners at the Asian Taekwondo Championships in 2026. (Only 1 athlete per weight category per member national association can qualify for the above-mentioned ATU Championships).

#### 9. CONTEST TIME

Best of 3 system [2 minutes x 2 (3) rounds with 1 minute break]

# 11. WT GLOBAL LICENCE & ONLINE REGISTRATION

WT Global License Registration
 All Athletes and Team officials must FIRST be registered with a WT Global Athlete License (GAL) or Global Official License (GOL).

#### ii. WT Online Registration

Participating Team Entry will only be accepted through the WT online registration system and registration is only possible with a valid WT Global License. Participating Team GMS admins will be notified via email once online registration is open.

# 12. ENTRY FEES: USD 100 per athlete

i. The OC shall collect the entry fees from the participating teams. The participating team shall pay an entry fee to the Organizing Committee with cash in US\$ at the accreditation center(s) in the official team hotel prior to the Head of Team meeting. Athletes shall not be allowed to compete without successful payment of entry fee to the Organizing Committee.

#### 13. ENTRY DEADLINES & IMPORTANT DATES

- i. <u>Entry deadline is April 11th, 12:00 Local Beijing Time (GMT+8)</u>. Entry submissions after this date/time will not be accepted under any circumstances.
- ii. Late replacement due to injury shall be handled case by case.
- iii. The registered athletes or team officials may be replaced without penalty until April 11th.





- iv. Entry fee of US\$100 per athlete will not be charged in case of cancellation of participation until **April 11th.**
- v. Entry fee must be paid in full in case of the notice of cancellation of participating athletes after **April 11th** or no-show.

#### 14. CLASSIFICATION OF RESULTS

i. Medals will be awarded to the top four athletes in the respective weight category of the pertinent championships:

1 <sup>st</sup> PLACE:	GOLD MEDAL & CERTIFICATE	
2 <sup>nd</sup> PLACE:	SILVER MEDAL & CERTIFICATE	
3 <sup>rd</sup> PLACE:	BRONZE MEDAL & CERTIFICATE	
3 <sup>rd</sup> PLACE:	BRONZE MEDAL & CERTIFICATE	

(Article 6.4 of WT Competition Rules & Interpretation (September 30, 2024))

All international-level competitions recognized by the WT shall be formed with participation of at least four (4) countries in tournament with no less than four (4) contestants competed in each weight category, and any tournament with less than four (4) countries or weight category with less than 4 competed contestants cannot be recognized in the official results.

- 2. Best Coaches
- 1 from Male team / 1 from Female team
- 3. Good Fighting Spirit
- 2 regardless of gender
- 4. Best Referees
- 3 regardless of gender

- All medalists should be dressed as follows during the awards ceremony.

Team officials: Participating team can register online for maximum one (1) Head of team per team, one (1) manager per team, three (3) coaches per team, three (3) team medical staffs per team, two (2) trainers per team and three (3) guests per country.

In case of exceeding this number, **US\$100** will be charged per person before issuance of the accreditation card. **US\$100** will be charged per team official registered <u>onsite and per change made</u> to the registered team.

Any WT Global Licence registration completed onsite will be charged a \$50 extra onsite processing fee for each WT Global Licence.

#### **16. INTERNATIONAL REFEREES**

The ATU will appoint total of 40 International Referees. The appointed international referees shall officiate at the 7th WT President's Cup-Asian Region; the following conditions shall apply:

- i. International Referees are required to pay for their own round-trip airfares.
- ii. The Organizing Committee shall pay for the expenses for four (4) nights' stay of room and board for International Referees during the competition period; Check-in date is April 21st and check-out date is April 25th;
- iii. The Organizing Committee shall pay a per diem of US\$150 per day, which will be calculated according to the number of actual competition days.
- iv. The OC will facilitate local transportation between the airport, designated hotel and competition venue.

#### 17. TECHNICAL DELEGATE AND COMPETITION SUPERVISORY BOARD

The WT will appoint one (1) Technical Delegate and ATU will appoint four (4) members of the Competition Supervisory Board. The following conditions shall apply:

- The Organizing Committee shall pay for the expenses for four (4) nights' stay of room and board during the competition period; Check-in date is April 21st and check-out date is April 25th;
- ii. The Organizing Committee shall pay a per diem of U\$\$200 to the Technical Delegate and U\$\$150 to the members of the Competition Supervisory Board for competition period, which will be calculated according to the number of actual competition days.

#### 18. WT-RECOGNIZED TAEKWONDO COMPETITION UNIFORM AND PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

- i. WAYCHAMP Protector and Scoring System (PSS) including PSS Headgear will be used for the Championships. During the event, Waychamp company will provide the use of sensing socks for the participating athletes for free.
- ii. Participating contestants are required to wear WT-recognized competition uniform and WT-recognized protective equipment. The latest version of WT recognized manufacturers' list is available at the website of WT <a href="http://www.worldtaekwondo.org/wtpartners-wt/recognize.html">http://www.worldtaekwondo.org/wtpartners-wt/recognize.html</a>
- iii. The Organizing Committee will provide Protector and Scoring System (PSS) to the participating contestants. Participating contestants are required to bring their own groin guards, mouthpieces, gloves, sensing socks and shin and forearm guards for their personal use.
- iv. Before entering the field of play, all contestants will proceed to the inspection desk for inspection of their competition uniforms and protective equipment. <u>Any contestant who</u> <u>wears unofficial competition uniforms or protective equipment will not be permitted to compete.</u>





- v. The top has to cover completely the buttocks. However, the bottom of top should be more than 15cm above the knee cap.
- vi. Instant Video Replay (IVR) System will be used.

#### 19. SPONSOR'S IDENTIFICATION

- i. ONE sponsor's identification (logo) is allowed to each of competition uniform's top and bottoms.
- ii. The sponsor's identification shall be located within  $50cm^2$  except the location of WT logo, manufacturer's identification, national flag, and NOC code.

#### 20. MEDICAL CONTROL

- i. The WT Anti-Doping Rules, and where necessary the Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, shall apply throughout the competitions.
- ii. Compulsory anti-doping tests will be carried out for selected medalists, while random tests will be conducted to the rest of the athletes. The WT and/or WADA may carry out random out of competition testing prior to the championships.
- iii. TUE (Therapeutic Use Exemption)
  - Athletes who take any substance or medicine listed in the "Prohibited List" of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and Anti-Doping Code of World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) for therapeutic purposes are requested to submit TUE applications via ADAMS, together with the required medical information. If you do not have an ADAMS account yet, please contact <a href="mailto:tue@ita.sport">tue@ita.sport</a> to have it set up.
  - Otherwise, please download the TUE Application Form <u>HERE</u> and once duly completed and signed, send it together with the required medical file to <u>tue@ita.sport</u> with copy to <u>antidoping@worldtaekwondo.org</u> by at least 30 days before the first competition day. #### 21. HEAD OF TEAM MEETING & DRAWING OF LOTS

- i. The head of team meeting shall be conducted one (1) day prior to the start of the 1st day of competition, in the presence of the ATU officials and the representatives of the participating teams.
- ii. At least one representative from each team must attend the head of team meeting. In case no representative can attend the meeting, the team must designate a proxy and inform the technical delegate or ATU before the meeting.
- iii. Drawing of lots will take place each day following the completion of General Weigh-in. The draw will be published on the official ATU/OC website.
- iv. Every participating team is required to bring along the following items for use at the Opening and/or Closing, and Awarding ceremonies:
  - + Two (2) IOC-recognized national flags, Size: 90cm x 130cm
  - + USB of the pertinent IOC-recognized national anthem

# Additional Notes:

- -Participating teams are responsible for confirming their entries before the head of team meeting.
- -A certain number of contestants shall be seeded based on the WT Ranking, and it will be announced at the head of the team meeting.





#### 22. WEIGH-IN

- i. General weigh-in of the contestants shall take place on the day before their respective weight category.
- ii. Random weigh-in of the contestants shall take place in the morning on the competition day of their respective weight category except M+87 & W+73.
- iii. Random weigh-in shall apply to following number of athletes with 5% allowance as below tables.

iv. During the weigh-in, male contestants shall wear underpants and female contestants shall wear underpants and brassieres. However, contestants may weigh-in in the nude if they want to do so.

#### 23. INDEMNITIES

- i. Participants without proper insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete in the championships.
- ii. The Organizing Committee will acquire general Public Liability event insurance.

#### 24. ACCOMMODATION & TRANSPORTATION

Relevant information is attached with this outline.

The participating teams are required to submit their hotel reservation forms directly to to the Organizing Committee no later than April 14th, 2025. Please refer to the accommodation guide for more details.

Additionally, for ground transport arrangements between the airport and the hotel, flight information should be provided to the Organizing Committee by request form provided separately. Transport will be provided only for teams that have made hotel reservations with the Organizing Committee.

#### 25. VISA INFORMATION

The Organizing Committee can provide invitation letters for visa applications. However, teams are required to check the China entry visa application waiting times in their own countries and submit requests for invitation letters to the organizing committee.

The Organizing Committee cannot guarantee entry into China and can only offer assistance. The Organizing Committee will issue visa support letters and provide maximum assistance only until the





visa application deadline. However, please note that obtaining a visa remains the sole responsibility of the participant's country.

Teams are requested to complete the attached visa application form at least one week before the waiting time deadline in their own country.

The visa invitation letter from OC will be sent within 3 working days after request(except for those with bar code issued by Chinese Government), please apply for the Chinese Visa as early as possible. These countries have been applied with visa-free policy: ALB, BEL, BIH, BLR, BUL, CRO, ECU, ESP, EST, FIJ, FRA, GEO, GER, HUN, IRL, ITA, JPN, KOR, LAT, LUX, MKD, MLT, MNE, NED, NOR, POR, QAT, ROU, SIN, SRB, SUI, SVK, THA, UAE (\*FYI, please consult your Chinese Embassy for double confirmation).

#### **26. ATHLETE REPLACEMENT**

In the event that the registered athletes should be replaced by another due to injuries, the participants can officially request to the ATU for the replacement by **no later than April 14th** by submitting 'Athlete Late Replacement Form' together with certification from the medical doctor in the language of the pertinent country and also in English to <u>admin@asiantu.org</u> and <u>gm office@waychamp.vip</u> (cc. <u>chinacta@chinacta.org.cn</u>). The decision on the acceptance will be made after evaluation of the submitted documents.

#### 27. COACH'S REQUIREMENTS

All coaches are required to hold WT Coach Certificate Level I(1). Coaches those do not hold Level I coach certificate will be deleted from the registration and not allowed to coach at the Championships.

All coaches are required to wear formal suit such as tie, jacket, dress shirt (long or short), and trousers, and sport shoes during Semi-Finals and Finals. Any type of cap/hat is not allowed. If any coach refuses to wear abovementioned attire, he or she will not be allowed to coaching for this championship.
