5. METHODS OF COMPETITION

- Men's / Women's: (Respectively) Single elimination tournament system for each weight category.
- The best of three (3) system
- All competitors must wear WT-approved competition uniform and protective equipment.
- Senior division seeded according to the published July 1st 2025 World Taekwondo rankings.
 (30% of contestants shall be seeded.)
- Daedo Protector and Scoring System (PSS) will be used in Kyorugi competition.
 The Organizing Committee will provide Daedo Protector and Scoring System (PSS) to the participating contestants. Participating contestants are required to bring their own groin guards, mouthpieces, gloves, sensing socks and shin and forearm guards for their personal use.

6. COMPETITION RULES

- WT Competition Rules shall be applied (September 30, 2024.)

7. DURATION OF COMPETITION

- Senior: 2 minutes x 3 rounds (1 minute break time)

8. WEIGH-IN

- A. General Weigh-in for the contestants shall be completed one day before their scheduled competition day.
- B. Weigh-in shall be made once, however, in case of under or exceeding, one more chance will be given within the weigh-in time. (approximately two hours)
- C. All contestants should bring their AD cards when they weigh-in, otherwise disqualification.
- D. The random weigh-in will take place at the venue in the morning of the competition. All contestants who pass the general weigh-in must be present for random weigh-in maximum two (2) hours before the start of the competition. Should a contestant fail to appear for the random weigh-in, he/she will be disqualified. The random weigh-in must be completed maximum thirty (30) minutes before the start of the competition each day.
- E. The list of athletes selected for the random weigh-in will be announced on the O.C Website on the morning of the competition day.

9. OTHERS

- A. The regulation articles above are subject to change in the Head of Team meeting.
- B. All officials including Head and coaches of each team must complete the registration as officials and hold an AD card to enter the stadium. And must have completed WT Coach Certification Course LV1.
- C. If the competitor is called 3 times 30 minutes before the start of the game and do not participate after declaring the participation, the competitor will be disqualified.
- D. Matters not specified in the regulation shall be decided after deliberation by the Organizing Committee of Chuncheon Leisure Taekwondo.

2. QUALIFICATIONS

- * (COMMON) Holder of Taekwondo Dan certificate issued by Kukkiwon.
 - A. Recognized Poomsae: Competitor who participates in the **individual categories**UNDER 30 (Senior I) and UNDER 40 (Senior II) should be registered on the GMS.

 (Global Membership System)
 - B. Free Style Poomsae: Competitor who participates in the Individual, Pair and Mixed Team divisions of OVER 17 (18 years old or older) should be registered on the GMS. (Global Memberships System)
- 3. COMPETITIONS (Men's & Women's)
- * (COMMON) Ages of Competitors are based on the year of the Championships, not the date of the pertinent competition.
 - A. Recognized Poomsae(Senior)
 - 1) Senior I: Born between 1 January 1995 ~ 31 December 2007 (18 ~ 30 years old)
 - 2) Senior II: Born between 1 January 1985 ~ 31 December 1994 (31 ~ 40 years old)
 - B. Free Style Poomsae: Born in 2007 or before (18 years old or older)

4. DURATION OF CONTEST

- A. Recognized Poomsae: up to 90 seconds
- B. Free Style Poomsae: 90 seconds to 100 seconds
- Break time: within 30sec to 60sec / Exceeding the time, deduction shall be applied.

5. COMPETITION RULES

- WT Competition Rules shall be applied (September 30, 2024.)

1) Methods Of Competition

- Individual event Competitors for Recognized Poomsae of Senior I and Senior II shall be awarded 20 WT ranking points(G2) for gold medal.
- Single elimination tournament System shall be applied to the Recognized Poomsae Competition.
- In case of an insufficient number of Competitors in each category, a demonstration shall be carried out.
- Competitors should be wearing WT-recognized Poomsae uniform(Dobok).
- 2) The competition area for Recognized Poomsae: 10m×10m

3) Scoring of Recognized Poomsae

- Poomsae(Individual)
- · Composition of refereeing official shall be a five-judge system.
- · Final score shall be the average point of the total points summed up except the highest and lowest points scored by 5 judges.
- · In case of a tied score, the winner shall be the one who has scored higher points in order of Presentation, and total points(total points of all judges including highest and lowest points).
- · If it is still tied in Presentation, and total points, then a rematch shall be conducted to determine the winner.
- · In case of a tied score after the rematch, the winner shall be the contestant who is awarded more points in total, including the highest and lowest scores that were not included in collection of scores.
- 4) Designation of Recognized Poomsae and the drawing of lots
 - Two (2) Poomsae from the designated Compulsory Poomsae decided by Technical Delegate for each division must be performed for all the preliminary, semi final and final rounds for all competitions.
- * The regulation articles above are subject to change in the Head of Team meeting.

1) Methods Of Competition

- Cut-off System shall be applied to the Free Style Poomsae Competition.
- Free Style Poomsae is the performance based on Taekwondo techniques with composition of music and choreography.
- Composition of Free Style Poomsae
- · Yeon-mu line shall choice of contestant.
- · Music and choreography shall be the choice of contestants.
- · Performed techniques must be within boundary of Taekwondo. The definition of Taekwondo techniques shall be determined by WT Poomsae Committee, when contestant submits performance plan.
- Competitors should be wearing WT-recognized Poomsae uniform(Dobok).
- 2) The competition area for Free Style Poomsae
 - Individual/Pair 10m × 10m
- Mixed Team 12m x 12m
- 3) Scoring of Free Style Poomsae
- Allotted Scoring Chart for Free Style Poomsae: WT Poomsae scoring criteria and procedures shall be applied.
- * Freestyle music should be submitted at the Competition Headquarters by July 16, 18:00 on a USB with the following details. (On the USB, each digital file should contain)
 - Name of the country
 - Name of the category
 - Name of the athlete / athletes
- * The USB itself should be marked with the name of the country and should be submitted in an envelope or a bag, with a list of contents of the USB in the same way as described above. Please see the attached picture below.
- * All music should be submitted in USB (CD is not acceptable) and will be returned.



* Note: Music in USB (Music without lyrics) and choreography shall be choice of a contestant, it should NOT contain any political, social, and religiousand any contents that may harm, discriminate or offend other.

7. OTHERS

- A. The regulation articles above are subject to change in the Head of Team meeting.
- B. All officials including Head and coaches of each team must complete the registration as officials and hold an AD card to enter the stadium. And All Poomsae Coaches participating in WT recognized/promoted competitions must hold the valid WT Poomsae Coach Certificate.
- C. If the competitor is called 3 times 30 minutes before the start of the game and do not participate after declaring the participation, the competitor will be disqualified.
- D. Matters not specified in the regulation shall be decided after deliberation by the Organizing Committee of Chuncheon Leisure·Taekwondo.

INTERNATIONAL REFEREES

- 1. The required number of International Referees shall be determined in accordance with the WT Rules.
- 2. Round trip airfare shall be the responsibility of each participating International Referee, while the Organizing Committee will cover accommodations with full board from July 13-20, 2025.
- 3. The Organizing Committee will pay a per diem of US \$150 to participating referees for each competition day from July 15-20, 2025.
