
POLISH OPEN G1 TOURNAMENT 19-21 SEPTEMBER 2025

COMPETITION RULES

WT Competition Rules & Interpretation (latest version)

COMPETITION SYSTEM

Single elimination tournament system, best of 3 system.

CONTEST TIME

Senior: 3 rounds of 2 minutes, 1-minute break between each round Junior & Cadet 3 rounds of 1.5 minutes, 1-minute break between each round The WT Technical Delegate has the authority to adjust the contest time as he sees fit.

CONTESTANTS

Cadets: born in 2011, 2012, 2013. Cadets must hold at least 4th Geup. Juniors: born in 2008, 2009, 2010. Juniors must hold at least 4th Geup. Seniors: born in 2008 and older. Seniors must hold Kukkiwon Dan certificate. *Each athlete may only compete in one age category.*

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Holder of a valid 2025 WT Global Athlete License
- 2. Member of the team/club of a World Taekwondo Member National Association.
- 3. All competitors must prove their age and identity by presenting their passport or identification card at the official weigh-in. For those athletes that are not adults, a written consent must be submitted (please find enclosed on the last pages) at the registration, signed by one of the parents or legal guardians, accepting their participation and all parts of the official invitation.

COACH ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Minimum age of 18 years
- 2. Holder of the WT Coach License Level I/ Level II Coach Certification
- 3. Holder of a valid 2025 WT Global Official License
- 4. Coaches are not allowed to wear Dobok.
- 5. One coach for every 4 competitors is granted free admission. Extra coach passes can be purchased for 30 euro for each individual coach. WT Global Coach License and Level I/II Coach Certification are mandatory.

RANDOM WEIGH-IN

Selected athletes must be present at 07:00 hrs on Saturday/08:00 hrs on Sunday sharp. The names of the athletes selected for the Random weigh-in will be published at 06:00 hrs on Saturday/07:00 hrs on Sunday on the organizers media platforms and on the OVR's website.

Random weigh-ins will take place at the competition venue.

DRAW SHEETS

The draw sheets will be published daily one (1) day before the start of competition at 21:00 hrs on the organizers' media platforms and on the OVR's website.

SEEDING

Seniors: All athletes will be seeded according to the WT ranking as per last publication.

Juniors and Cadets: All athletes will be seeded according to the European ranking as per last publication.

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Seniors Male: -54kg, -58kg, -63kg, -68kg, -74kg, -80kg, -87kg, +87kg Seniors Female: -46kg, -49kg, -53kg, -57kg, -62kg, -67kg, -73kg, +73kg

SPORT EQUIPMENT

KPNP scoring system will be used during Polish Open 2025

The OC will provide body protector and head protector for all matches. Athletes must provide their own groin guards, mouth guards, gloves, shin and forearm guards and sensor socks. Only WT recognized brands are allowed.

SPORT ENTRIES - ONLINE REGISTRATION

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

14th September 2025, 23:59 CET or until the limit of 350 seniors and 400 cadets and juniors is reached.

APPLICABLE FEES

EARLY PAYMENT DATE - 125,00€ for each contestant via bank transfer. Entry fee must be transferred to the account below by 1st of August 2025.

REGULAR PAYMENT DATE - 150,00€ for each contestant via bank transfer. Entry fee must be transferred to the account below by the deadline 15th of September 2025.

LATE PAYMENT DATE – 175,00€ for each contestant paid via bank transfer after the deadline 15th of September 2025, or <u>only in cash</u> at the registration office.

PAYMENT MUST BE DONE BY TEAM. INDIVIDUAL PAYMENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED. THE ORGANIZING COMMITTEE DOES NOT REFUND ENTRY FEES PAID.

Any athlete registering on-line who does not take part in the competition and who has not been removed from the entry list before the deadline, is liable for paying his/her entry-fee in full. (For any athlete not presenting at registration, his/her team or official will be liable for ensuring full payment has been received, prior to the team's participation). If a team does not show up at the event and has not requested a participation cancellation before the deadline, it will be requested to settle the payment of the entry fees in full (100%).

On-site change of weight division and/or other modifications

50€ for each amendment, payable at the registration desk. All changes after the registration deadline shall be done on-site.

Protest fee

200€, only the official Coach is allowed to protest. It must be done immediately after the end of the contest. The protest fee will not be refunded in any case.

DOPING CONTROL

Some of the athletes will be randomly chosen to undergo a doping test.
