## **COMPETITION RULES:**

WT Competition Rules & Interpretation as of June 2024 shall be applied.

### **METHOD OF COMPETITION:**

A single elimination tournament according to the regulations of the PSS and Video Replay. Best of 3 system.

### **CONTEST TIME:**

- Senior divisions: 3 rounds of 2 minutes, 1-minute break between each round.
- ✓ Junior divisions: 3 rounds of 1 minute 30 seconds, 30 seconds break between each round.
- ✓ Cadet and Children divisions: 3 rounds of 1 minute 30 seconds, 30 seconds break between each round.

The WT Technical Delegate has the authority to adjust the contest time as he sees fit.

## **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

- 1. Holder of a valid 2025 WT Global Athlete License.
- 2. Asian Taekwondo Union or World Taekwondo.
- 3. Holder of:
  - ✓ Seniors: Kukkiwon Dan certificate.
  - ✓ Juniors: 2nd Kup and above.
  - ✓ Cadets: 5th Kup and above.
- 4. An athlete in order to be eligible for participation must be born in:
  - ✓ Seniors: 2007 or before.
  - ✓ Juniors: 2008, 2009, 2010.
  - ✓ Cadets: 2011, 2012, 2013.
  - ✓ Children: 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017.













## **COACH ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

- 1. Minimum age of 18 years.
- 2. WT Coach Certificate Level I or above is required.
- 3. Holder of a valid 2025 WT Global Official License.
- 4. All coaches are required to wear formal suit such as tie, jacket, dress shirt (long or short), and trousers, and sport shoes during Semi-Finals and Finals.

## **Regular entry fee:**

- \$100 per registered individual athlete if paid via bank transfer (Who registered through WT GMS online registration before 01/NOV/2025).
- \$120 per registered individual athlete if paid cash onsite. (Who registered through WT GMS online registration before 01/NOV/2025).

## Change of weight division:

✓ \$25 for each change of medal event made after deadline.

## **Onsite Registration:**

- ✓ \$150 per registered athlete if the registration will be made onsite.
- ✓ Any WT Global Licence registration completed onsite will be charged a \$50 extra onsite processing fee for each WT Global Licence.

## **SPORT EQUIPMENT:**

## **PSS** – system:

Daedo Gen 2, with electronic headgear will be provided by the OC.

## **Dobok and protective equipment:**

Athletes can only use WT recognized products while participating at the event. See a list of recognized products at:

Only WT-recognized Equipment is allowed. Groin, Forearm, Shin guards, Mouthguard (only white or transparent), Gloves and Daedo sensor socks are compulsory and must be brought by the contestants. In case of necessity the sensor socks will also be for sale at the Sport Hall.

## FIELD OF PLAY REGULATIONS:

By accepting an accreditation card, all accredited persons agree to comply with the Field of Play regulations applicable at Taekwondo events. Only the competitors and their coaches will have admittance with valid accreditations to the contest areas.

#### **AWARDS:**

#### **Individual** awards

- ✓ 1<sup>st</sup> place gold medal.
- ✓ 2<sup>nd</sup> place silver medal.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> place bronze medal.
- ✓ 3<sup>rd</sup> place bronze medal.

### **Team awards**

Best female team award: 1st, 2nd and 3rd place trophies (seniors, juniors, cadets).

Best male team award: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place trophies (seniors, juniors, cadets).













### ACCOMMODATION & TRANSPORTATION:

The Organizing Committee shall provide transportation between the airport and hotel and vice versa and between the hotel and the competition venue for those teams that have booked their hotel via the Organizing Committee. For making hotel reservation, please fill in the Booking Form on WT GMS Simply Compete website and send it back no later than **01 November 2025.** 

### MEDICAL AND ANTI-DOPING:

#### **ANTI-DOPING**

Compulsory anti-doping tests will be carried out for selected medalists, while random tests will be conducted to the rest of the athletes. The WT and/or WADA may carry out random out of competition testing prior to the championships.

## **Therapeutic Use Exemption**

TUE (Therapeutic Use Exemption) Athletes who take any substance or medicine listed in the "Prohibited List" of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and Anti-Doping Code of World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) for therapeutic purposes are requested to submit TUE applications via ADAMS, together with the required medical information. If you do not have an ADAMS account yet, please contact tue@ita.sport to have it set up.

### VISA:

Qatar Open will provide free Visa for all teams registered & Paid Through Simply compete and book their hotel through the OC. You can find the visa request form on WT GMS Simply Compete site.

## **IMPORTANT**:

Your visa applications will not be processed until full payment is received for entry fee online or by bank transfer and the hotel reservation is confirmed. Participants who will not book the hotel through OC will have to manage their own visas.
