Condition for Participation

All contestants must provide proof of membership by presenting a valid national Federation passport with ETU/WT membership. Additionally, they must verify their age and nationality by presenting their passport or identification card during the weigh-in.

All participants must be holders of a valid 2026 WT Global License. For any questions regarding the WT license, please contact your MNA (National Member Association). Onsite registration for the WT license will not be possible. WT ranking points will only be awarded to athletes who have a valid WT license.

Participants who are not recognized as adults by law in their own country must submit a passport or identification card along with a written consent (liability declaration) from their parents or lawful guardian, accepting their participation and all parts of the official invitation.

Visa

To support visa applications, it is necessary to send a correct written application letter to the Austrian Taekwondo Federation, including the names, age, and passport number of all team members, competitors, and officials. If possible, please send this information as a Word file via email attachment.

An invitation letter will then be sent by air mail to the team and to the Austrian Embassy in your home country.

Please allow at least several weeks for the visa processing at the embassies to handle all applications.

Age Categories

Cadets: born in 2012, 2013, 2014. Cadets must hold at least 4th Geup.

Juniors: born in 2009, 2010, 2011. Juniors must hold at least 4th Geup.

Seniors: born in 2009 and older. Seniors must hold at least Black belt

Entry Fee

Regular Payment:

- Amount: 150 € per competitor
- Deadline: Payment must be applied and completed via bank transfer by **30th December 2025**

Late Payment:

- Amount: 180 € per competitor
- Deadline: Payment must be applied and completed via bank transfer by **30th January 2026**

On-Site (Cash) Payment:

- Amount: 200 € per applied competitor
- Payment Method: Cash payment at the event venue

Change of Category:

- Fee: 50 € per competitor for any weight division change
- Requirement: Each contestant must pay the fee upon requesting the change

Additional Accreditation Card:

- Fee: 50 € per request
- Applies to: Replacement and reprinting of accreditation cards

All payments must be completed within the specified deadlines. Late or on-site payments will be subject to increased fees. Ensure accurate and timely payments to avoid additional charges.

If an athlete registered online (<https://worldtkd.simplycompete.com>) does not participate in the competition for any reason but has not been removed from the participant list before the **deadline (30.01.2026)**, their team official must fully (100%) pay the entry fee. The entry fee is **non-refundable** at any time after the deadline.

Qualification

Cadet male/female athletes from 4th Kup and Junior male/female athletes from 4th Kup are eligible to participate.

Senior male/female athletes must hold at least 1st Dan.

All participants, including athletes and officials, must have a WT Global Licence and be a member of a National Taekwondo Federation. This membership must be verified during registration by presenting a valid WT Global Licence.

Anti Doping

The competitor, by submitting the application, agrees to comply with the anti-doping rules of the National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA), the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA), and the World Taekwondo Federation (WT).

Practical Information

The competition will take place on designated areas, all equipped with an electronic scoring system. The tournament will follow a single elimination system.

Equipment

The **KPNP (K2 Series)** Protector and Scoring System (PSS) including Head PSS will be used for the competition. Participating contestants are required to wear WT-recognized competition uniforms or Dobok and WT-recognized protective equipment.

The Organizing Committee will provide the Protector and Scoring System (PSS) for the participating contestants. Participating contestants are required to bring their own groin guards, mouthpieces, sensing socks (**K2 Series**) and shin and forearm guards for their personal use.

KPNP K2 E-gloves will be provided for all categories by KPNP for free.

Recognized brands

Participating contestants are required to wear WT-recognized doboks and WT-recognized protective equipment. The latest version of WT-recognized manufacturers' list is available at the website of WT: <https://www.worldtaekwondo.org/officialsuppliers/Recognition/contents>

Protest

Only the official coach is allowed to protest, immediately after the end of the contest.

An amount of € 200 (Euro) will have to be paid for each protest.

The decision of the referee chairman is final.

Referees

Without exception, all referees will be contacted and invited by the Referee Committee.

Hotel and full-board accommodation will be provided for international referees from February 06th to February 09th 2026.

Ranking

1st place – 120 points
2nd place – 50 points
3rd Place – 20 points Each
passed fight– 1 point

Award presentation

Medals will be awarded for 1st to 3rd place in individual results.
Trophies will be awarded for 1st to 3rd place in team and nation results.

Results


By entering the competition, the contestants agree to the announcement that their first and last name, weight category, nation/organization, and placing in the results will be published on the internet as well as in printed media.
