4. Eligibility Requirements

4.1 GAL: Holder of a valid 2026 WT Global Athlete License.

4.2 MNA: Member of the team/club of a pertinent Member National

Association, recognized by World Taekwondo.

4.3 Graduation: Cadets at least 4th geup.

Juniors at least 2nd geup.

Seniors at least Dan Certificate.

4.4 Age: Cadets: born in 2012, 2013, and 2014.

Juniors: born in 2009, 2010 and 2011.

Seniors: born in 2009 or before.

4.5 Weigh divisions: World Taekwondo weight classes

4.6 Identification: According to Dutch law all competitors and visitors need to

have a valid Identification by means of a valid passport or other official identification document. All competitors must prove their age by presenting their passport or identification

card at the official weigh-in.

4.7 Coaches: Minimum age is 18 years old, must be a holder of a valid WT

Coach License Level 1 or higher and must be a holder of a

valid WT 2026 Global Official License.

Coach is only allowed in sportswear (no dobok).

A valid 2026 and applicable WT Global License is required for all athletes and officials participating in this tournament. There will be "NO" WT Global License registration onsite.















5. Event information

5.1 OVR System: Martial. Events

5.2 IVR System: Taekwondo Replays.

5.3 Competition rules: WT competition rules (latest version)

5.4 Competition mode: Single elimination, Best of Three (3) System.

5.5 Doping Control: Contestants could be chosen at random by the anti doping

authority and will be tested. The WT Anti-Doping Rules and

the WADA Anti-Doping Code are applicable.

5.6 Equipment: **Daedo GEN 3 PSS** shall be provided for all categories.

Contestants must bring their own protectors (groin, forearm, shin, mouthpiece, gloves) and **Daedo GEN 3** sensor socks.

Only WT-recognized equipment is allowed.

5.7 Protest: Only the official coach is allowed to protest. This must be

done immediately after the end of the contest. An amount of € 200,- will have to be paid for each protest. The protest amount will not be refunded in any case. Protest on the outcome of a match is only possible if the WT Competition

Rules allow it (in case IVR system is not applicable)

5.8 Liability: All competitors and officials participate at their own risk. The

organization and promoter shall not accept responsibility for

any damages, violence, injuries or losses.

Specifically note that they also take no responsibility for consequences due to (directly or indirectly) acts or threats

of terrorism and COVID-19 (or likewise).

All competitors and officials must bring their own

documents for any medical treatment in the Netherlands. If

not, this will have to be paid in cash.

5.9 Liability waiver: Those who are not recognized as adults (under aged) by law

in their own country must submit a passport or identification

card together with a declaration of consent (see

attachment) at registration signed by parents or lawful guardians, accepting the participation and all parts of the

official invitation.

Club teams are **only** allowed to register coach

accreditations (1 free of charge for every 4 competitors.

Extra coach passes can be requested separately for € 35,for each individual coach. A valid WT global license and WT

coach license is mandatory.

6.4 Field of play By accepting regulations: agree to contain a second se

By accepting an accreditation card, all accredited persons agree to comply with the Field of Play regulations applicable

at Taekwondo events. Only the competitor and his/her

coach + Doctor will have admittance with valid accreditations to the contest areas in case of direct participation or 1 match before, and only if they pass the

inspection/holding area together as a team.

6.5 Modifications: For each modification (only weight changes), or additional

accreditation a fee of € 35,00 will be charged. **This includes lost accreditations.** After the first official weigh-in attempt no further modifications are allowed. Competitors who started the official weigh-in procedure must complete this, if not completed, the competitor will be disqualified from

the competition. Restitutions will never be made.

















7. Medal Events and Awards

- 7.1 For each medal event one (1) gold medal, one (1) silver medal and two (2) bronze medals will be awarded directly on court after a medal match.
- 7.2 Best referee awards will be awarded to one (1) male and one (1) female referee.

8. Financial

8.1 Payments must be received within 3 days of the registration. If not, Procedure:

the organization has the right to remove the entries. Entries done 3 days before the registration deadline must be paid immediately. Payments must be done by TEAM. Individual payment is not allowed.

Restitution will never be made.

8.2 Entry fee(s): Regular Entry Fee € 150 for each competitor.

> Entry fee must be transferred on indicated bankaccount on or before 21 February 2026.

Late Entry Fee € 175 for each competitor. Entry fee transferred on indicated bankaccount between 21 February and 7 March 2026.

Card payment on site or transferred on indicated bankaccount after the deadline for late entryfee € 200 for each competitor. Cash payment on site € 225 for each competitor.

Please note that the actual deadline for registration is published on simply compete and that this is not the same as the deadline for payment of the regular or late entry fee.

















All fees must be paid in EURO'S and please ensure you pay any additional currency charges. If an athlete who is registered on simply compete does not take part in the competition, but he/she has not been removed from the list of participants before the registration deadline, the team or official must fully (100%) pay his/her entry fee for participation. **Entry fee is not refundable at any time after the registration deadline!**

10.3 VISA:

The ministry of foreign affairs of the Netherlands advises that those participants which need VISA for entry into the Netherlands should apply for visa at the designated consulate / embassy at least 6 weeks before arrival in the Netherlands.

10.4 Recording: Recording within the competition area is not allowed. Recording from the public stands is only allowed with handy type cameras or phones.

















- 10.5 Commercial business is not allowed under any circumstances without a valid written permission of the Taekwondo Federation Netherlands. In the venue and event associated grounds and buildings only contracted business is allowed. A penalty of € 10.000,- shall have to be paid in cash when violating this rule. The organization will have full authority to remove the violators from the venue and event. Please note that you will automatically comply with these rules written in this invitation when accessing the venue or any part of the event.
- 10.6 Due to Dutch Law it is not allowed to show any sponsorship expressions of gambling operators, regardless of whether these parties are licensed in their own country.
- 10.7 Due to safety reasons it is not allowed for press to make pictures inside the field of play. Accreditation for official press can be requested but will not give access inside the field of play.
- 10.8 GDPR: All visitors inside the venue, including athletes and officials, are agreed to be filmed, photographed at any time. All event data will be used for our social channels and exposure of the Dutch Open Taekwondo Championships.
- 10.9 All participants, officials, visitors and other people attending the championships are obliged to comply with the regulations, rules and instructions from the Dutch Government, local authorities, the promoter and the organization committee.
