9. ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

- ❖ Holder of a valid 2026 WT athlete Global license;
- ❖ Member of the National team of a pertinent MNAs recognized by the African Taekwondo Union and the WT;
- ❖ Wild card winners from the 2026 African Open Series;
- ❖ Holder of the nationality of the pertinent MNAs;
- ❖ Holder of **Kukkiwon Dan certificate**¹;
- ❖ Athletes must be aged 17 year or older (2009 and before). For athletes under 18 year, a written consent must be submitted (please find enclosed on the last pages) at the registration, signed by one of the parents or legal guardians, accepting their participation and all parts of the official invitation.

If a refugee wishes to compete at the 2026 African championships, he/she individually or the MNA he/she belongs has to send the relevant request to African Taekwondo Union, by submitting the following documents:

- ❖ The eligible refugee athlete must have official refugee status before the entry deadline of the event meaning that an athlete whose status is in process of examination will not be accepted to compete.
- ❖ The refugee certificate issued by either governmental authorities of current residing country or the UNHCR will only be accepted. In addition to the certificate, official endorsement letter from MNA of current residing country must be presented.
- ❖ To register the refugee athlete, the abovementioned required documents shall be submitted to the AFTU technical commission. All such requests are examined, by the relevant AFTU Technical Commission, at a standalone basis per event. After the examines the request, AFTU refers back with the outcome of the Commission and if it is positive, then AFTU registers the athlete at the event under the refugee Team.

10. COACH ELIGIBILITY

- ❖ Minimum age of 18 years;
- ❖ Holder of a valid 2026 GOL;
- ❖ WT Coach Certificate Level 2 is required. Only certified level 2 coach will receive their accreditation card;
- ❖ All coaches are required to wear formal suit such as tie, jacket, dress shirt (long or short), and trouser from semi-final matches. If any coach refuses to wear abovementioned attire, he or she won't be allowing to coach

¹ A copy of the Dan certificate should be uploaded to GMS when registering for the event. In case a contestant has applied for a Kukkiwon Dan certificate but has not received it yet, a copy of the Dan application form and the remittance certificate sent to the Kukkiwon must be uploaded to GMS when registering for the event. II. COMPETITION RULES & METHOD

WT Competition Rules & Interpretation, In Force as of January 1st 2026, shall be applied.

II.1. METHOD OF COMPETITION

- ❖ Best of 3 system; 2 minutes x 2 or x 3 rounds with 1 minute break between all rounds; Video replay;
- ❖ Maximum quota per MNA: one (01) athlete per weigh-category except MNA who won a supplementary quota from the 2025 African Open Series. In that case, maximum quota is maximum two (02) athletes per MNA per division;

II.3. WEIGH-IN & RANDOM WEIGH-IN

- ❖ General weigh-in of the contestants shall take place on the day before their respective weight category (see schedule);
- ❖ During the weigh-in, male contestants shall wear underpants and female contestants shall wear underpants and brassieres. However, contestants may weigh-in in nude if they want;
- ❖ Senior random weigh-in selection shall apply with 5% allowance (all weight category except M+78 & W+68); List of selected athletes for the random weigh-in will be announced on the **WhatsApp channel and AFTU website & social media pages** on the morning of the competition day.

11.4. EQUIPMENT

- ❖ KPNP K2 Protector and Scoring System (PSS) including Head PSS will be used for the competition;
- ❖ **Sensing gloves will not be used at the Championships;**
- ❖ Groin/forearm/shin guards and gloves, mouth piece, PSS sensing socks, are compulsory and must be brought by the contestant for their personal use;
- ❖ Contestant are required to wear **WT recognized Competition uniforms** and WT recognized protective equipment; **Wearing Dobok is not permitted.**

Top

- Specifications for the top of the new competition uniform remain the same as the guideline provided in July, 2019.
- Black V-neck collar with the WT Logo in the front of top where neck bands are met.
- Length of front and back should be the same.
- The top has to cover completely the buttocks. However, the bottom of top should be more than 15cm above the knee cap.
- The sleeves must cover up the full arms. The distance between the end of sleeves and the carpal bone must be less than 3cm.

National Flag Design (Optional)

- National flag design/pattern can be printed on the outer side of the left leg of the trousers.
- National flag design/pattern should be located vertically and 30cm above the bottom edge of the trousers.
- The maximum size of flag design must be within 15cm x 30cm (W x H).



- ❖ Before entering the field of play, all contestants will proceed to the inspection desk for inspection of competition uniform and protective equipment. **Any contestant who wears unofficial competition uniform or protective equipment will not be permitted to compete.**

11.5. MEDICAL & ANTIDOPING RULES

- ❖ Medical insurance

All participating athletes, coaches, team officials, technical officials and participants at AFTU events shall have **mandatorily an international medical insurance** that covers medical care and in case of emergency, repatriation to the country of origin, valid on the days present in the host country of the event. AFTU nor the Organizing Committee shall be responsible to cover any medical costs incurred for medical treatment before, on or during the competition or repatriation in the broadest sense of the word. All relevant documents proving that such an insurance is present, including insurance policy papers, should be taken to the event in case a medical situation occurs. Each MNA Team doctor or team medical staff must ensure their athletes and team officials have valid international health insurance that covers medical and emergency care at the designated hospitals in Rabat before arrival to the venue.

- ❖ General public liability

The Organizing Committee will acquire general Public Liability event insurance.

- ❖ Doping control

The WT Anti-Doping Rules, and where necessary the Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, shall apply throughout the competitions. Compulsory anti-doping tests will be carried out in a random selection basis. The WT and/or WADA may carry out random out-of-competition testing prior to the competition.

TUE (Therapeutic Use Exemption): athletes who take any substance or medicine listed in the “Prohibited List” of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and Anti-Doping Code of World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) for therapeutic purposes are requested to submit TUE applications via ADAMS, together with the required medical information. If you do not have an ADAMS account yet, please contact **tue@ita.sport** to have it set up. Otherwise, please download the TUE Application Form and once duly completed and signed, send it together with the required medical file to **tue@ita.sport** with copy to **antidoping@worldtaekwondo.org**. by at least March 1st 2026. 11.6. PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES

ENTRY FEES:

- ❖ 150 USD per athlete;
- ❖ Regular entry fee period will begin on April 5th and will end on May 5th 2026.

Any changes (athlete or official) that are made to a national team list after the published online registration deadlines will be charged a \$100 USD penalty in addition to the registration fees. This penalty will be considered the onsite fee for approved additions or changes to the national team list.

Any changes or additions made to a team entry list (except for contestants) after the online registration has closed MUST be approved in person by the Head of Team or Manager. If no Head of Team or Manager is registered for the event, then written confirmation from the MNA President, Vice President, Secretary General or GMS Administrator will be required.

11.7. REGISTRATION

Round trip airfare and accommodation charges of room and board shall be borne by the participating athlete or Member National Association. All athletes and officials must be registered under team name “Country Name”, for example: “ZAMBIA NATIONAL TEAM” or “ZAMBIATEAM”.
