Competition Format

System: Single-elimination K.O. system, Best-of-Three

Match Duration: Seniors 3 x 2 min with 1min break

PSS System: DAEDO GEN-3

Weigh-in

Weigh-in of the contestants shall be completed the day before their scheduled competition.

Each athlete can only use one timeslot for the weigh in. Each timeslot is 2 hours long. It is not necessary to book a timeslot for the weigh in.

Weigh in period could be extended or adjusted by WT TD decision accordingly.

In case of a change of the weight category a fine of 50 CHF / 50 EUR must be paid at the weigh-in in cash.

Random weigh-in will be published on [Martial Events](#) and in WhatsApp Channel. Athletes are required to be on time. If they miss the Random weigh-in, they are disqualified.

During the weigh-in, senior contestants shall wear under pants and female contestants shall wear underpants and brassieres. However, seniors may weigh-in in the nude if they want to do so.

Drawing of Lots

Drawing of lots of sessions shall be conducted one (1) day prior to the start of the championships and it will be published on [Martial Events](#) and in WhatsApp Group.

Please note, that you are applying for the Swiss Open G1/Para and E2.

The following conditions shall apply for the appointed referees:

- International Referees are required to pay for their own round-trip airfares.
- The referee may arrive one day before and may leave the day after the competition.
- The Organizing Committee shall pay the expenses of room and board for the duration of the competition. The OC will also cover the board accommodation of the night before and the first meal after the tournament.
- The Organizing Committee shall pay a per diem of 150€ to the selected International Referees for each working day. Appointed referees for the weigh-in held on Friday shall arrive on time for that duty and will receive an extra 75€ per diem.
- The OC will facilitate local transportation between the airport and the designated hotel.
- The OC will also cover the board accommodation of the night before and the first meal after the tournament.

Weigh-in

Weigh-in of the contestants shall be completed the day before their scheduled competition.

Each athlete can only use one timeslot for the weigh in. Each timeslot is 2 hours long. It is not necessary to book a timeslot for the weigh in.

Weigh in period could be extended or adjusted by WT TD decision accordingly.

In case of a change of the weight category a fine of 50 CHF / 50 EUR must be paid at the weigh-in in cash.

Random weigh-in will be published on [Martial Events](#) and in WhatsApp Channel. Athletes are required to be on time. If they miss the Random weigh-in, they are disqualified.

During the weigh-in, cadets and junior athletes cannot be nude. Male contestants shall wear underpants, and female contestants shall wear underpants and brassieres.
